Series Record.....Jacksonville leads, 12-6

- Davidson is 29-69 (.296) all-time in the PFL.
- Jacksonville holds a 12-6 record against the 'Cats dating back to the first meeting in 1998. The Dolphins have taken seven straight in the series, the last Davidson win came back in 2008, a 38-35 win at Richardson
- Saturday's tilt will break a 4-4 tie between the two squads at Richardson Stadium. JU has won the last two in Davidson. The 'Cats last win at home was that 2008 victory.

- Led by Jared Morris' 93 yards off 19 carries, the Dolphins tied a program-best 433 rushing yards last week at Morehead State.
- Junior Wildcat wide receiver Cam Cheuvront notched his second 100-yard game of the season against Butler, catching five passes for 115 yards that included a career-long 74-yard TD grab on the team's opening play from scrimmage. Davidson has three 100-yard receiving games this season - junior Jaris Scott notched 149 yards in the season opener at Georgetown.-
- · Jacksonville's 61 points last week tied the fourth highest scoring output all-time for the program and was the most since the Dolphins hung 58 on Valparaiso in the 2015 season finale.
 - Wildcat sophomore linebacker Boo Jordan leads the Pioneer Football League with 6.0 sacks.
- Davidson finished off the 2015 campaign with a 20-17 win over Stetson, snapping a 24-game PFL losing streak dating back to Nov. 11, 2012 when the 'Cats downed Valparaiso in overtime, 28-27.
- · Senior linebacker Nate Casey was selected to the 2016 Allstate/AFCA Good Works Team and will be recognized at halftime of the Allstate Sugar Bowl in New Orleans on New Years Day. Casey's brother, Dan, made the 2014 team, while Chris Woods got a nomination for the 'Cats last year.

LAST TIME OUT

Davidson fell behind 14-0 at Marist and never recovered, falling at Tenney Stadium, 31-10. Freshman quarterback Stockton McGuire rushed for a team-high 76 yards off 14 carries, but completed only 8-of-23 pass attempts for 97 yards in the losing effort. Sophomore wide receiver Kahleel Shaw was the only 'Cat to find the end zone, finding the edge and the goal line on a three-yard scoring scamper. Junior Trevor Smith was good from his only field goal try of the day, knocking down a 33-yard kick. Marist used deep-man threat Juston Christian to gouge the thin Davidson secondary for 136 yards on six catches, including an 83-yard TD reception in the third to all but seal the Red Fox victory.

PUT IT AWAY, NOW

The Wildcats have had second-half leads in 3-of-6 losses this season, including fourth quarter leads in losses at Valparaiso and at home to Butler. Davidson's last two losses at home are by a combined seven points.

HONORARY CAPTAIN - JOHN BAZOS '82

John Bazos '82 played football for Davidson for three years before family duties called him away from the game. He received a varsity letter for his efforts in the 1979 season. After leaving Davidson, John earned a degree in dentistry at Temple University and then set up a pediatric dentistry practice in Coral Springs, Florida where he serves generations of families as dentist, mentor, and friend. An adventure lover, John has enjoyed adventure flying, diving with great white sharks, driving a race car across the Baja desert, hiking Victoria Falls, and swimming in the ocean in Antarctica. His greatest adventure, however, has been spent with Jan Krix and their family. John's memories of Davidson include the camaraderie of his friends on the football team, the community built by the Honor Code, and the mentoring provided by Dr. David Grant.

MAKING HIS MARK

Freshman quarterback Stockton McGuire has had a stellar start to his collegiate career. The Douglasville, Ga., native was named to the STATS FCS National Freshman of the Week honorable mention two out of three weeks this season. McGuire threw for a career-high 273 yards off 21-of-34 passing and two touchdowns last wekend against Butler.

ROWELL LANDS ON FOOTBALLGAMEPLAN.COM PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA TEAM

Junior Ben Rowell earned a nod on the FBGP.com Preseason All-America third team as a specialist. Rowell returned 17 kicks last season for an average of 28.4 yards per return. He was named to the All-PFL second team last season as a specialist.

MUELLER NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-PFL TEAM

For the first time in PFL history the league named long snappers to the Preseason All-League team with Davidson junior Conrad Mueller making the grade. Mueller, along with Butler's Connor Aranas, were honored with this distinction back in July's release.

NEW ADDITIONS TO THE STAFF

Head Coach Paul Nichols was busy in the offseason revamping the Wildcat coaching staff, bringing in seven new members to the team. Assistant Head and Defensive Line Coach Ray McCartney (Guilford, '80) returns to North Carolina after spending two seasons at Army West Point. Prior to his tenure with the Black Knights, McCartney roamed the sidelines at Wake Forest for 13 seasons as defensive line coach, helping lead the Demon Deacons to five bowl games. Vinny Marino (Connecticut, '92) enters his first season as offensive coordinator after spending two seasons as assistant director of player personnel at Boston College. Also joining the staff; special teams coordinator and running backs Coach Mario Price (Baylor, '07), offensive line coach Matt Applebaum (Connecticut, '07), Safeties Coach Justin Hood (Ashland, 08), cornerbacks coach Sean Fisher (Mount Union, '08) and tight ends Coach Phil Trautwein (Florida, '07). Trautwein spent time with Marino as a graduate assistant with the Eagles.

PAUL NICHOLS

HEAD COACH

Fourth Season Davidson, 2003

Paul Nichols '03 is in his fourth season as the head coach of his alma mater.

He was named to the post by Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Dec. 21, 2012, and is the program's 27th head coach.

In 2015, the Wildcats finished 2-9 overall and earned their first Pioneer Football League win under Nichols, finishing 1-7 in conference play. The program landed seven All-PFL team members, including standout wide receiver William Morris, who made it back-to-back appearances on the first team.

Morris made his first All-PFL first team in 2014, while Davidson earned its first Allstate Good Works Team honoree since 2010 as linebacker Dan Casey was honored at the 2015 Sugar Bowl.

In his first season, the Wildcats were led by Matt Casey on the All-PFL team, had three representatives on the Academic All-PFL team, and 39 players were named to the PFL Academic Honor Roll. Additionally, wide receiver William Morris ranked ninth in the nation in receiving yards per game and Nichols' punt return defense ranked fourth in the nation.

Nichols, who was a coach at the Football Bowl Subdivision level starting in 2004, is the second youngest head coach in all of NCAA Division I football, born January 25, 1981.

In 2012, Nichols served as the director of player personnel at Illinois. In that position, he coordinated on-campus recruiting efforts and relations with high school coaches, among other duties, for former head coach Tim Beckman and the Fighting Illini staff.

Prior to his time at Illinois, Nichols spent three seasons on Beckman's staff at Toledo as co-defensive coordinator/safeties coach, where he played a vital role in the transformation of the Rockets' defense.

In 2011, Nichols helped guide the Rockets to a 9-4 record and a win over Air Force in the Military Bowl. Toledo was 7-1 in the MAC and shared the West Division title. Defensively, the Rockets forced 30 turnovers on the season (ranking 16th nationally) and ranked third nationally in turnover margin (+1.23). In 2010, UT increased its forced turnovers from 21 to 34, the fifth-highest takeaway total in the nation, as the Rockets made their first bowl appearance in five years.

Before making his way to Toledo, Nichols served as an assistant at Marshall University for three seasons, where he coached All-Conference USA safety Curtis Keyes (2006) and All-Freshman cornerback Zearrick Matthews (2006).

Prior to his tenure at Marshall, Nichols completed two seasons as a graduate assistant at Ohio State from 2004-05 where he assisted with the defensive backs and defensive line.

A native of Dunwoody, Ga., Nichols graduated from Davidson College in 2003 with bachelor's degrees in political science and history. Nichols was a first-team All-Pioneer League and a first-team Pioneer League All-Academic selection as a senior, and was named honorable mention All-America by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

In 2000, he quarterbacked Davidson to its first-andonly undefeated season.

Nichols departed as the school record holder for career passing yards (5,822), completions (465) and touchdown passes (51), and compiled a 22-6 record as a starting quarterback. After seeing limited action as a freshman, Nichols won the starting job prior to his sophomore year and guided the 'Cats to a 10-0 season. His junior year was cut short by a knee injury, but Nichols bounced back as a senior and matched the school record for touchdown passes in a single season with 25.

Nichols now ranks third in passing yards and completions after being surpassed by Ryan Alexander '08 and Jonathan Carkhuff '14. He is also now second to Alexander in career passing touchdowns, with Carkhuff needing just six more touchdown passes to move past Nichols in that category.

Nichols is the first Davidson alumnus to guide the football program on a full-time basis since Dave Fagg '58, who finished his second coaching stint with the Wildcats following the 1992 season. He joins Matt Spear '93 (men's soccer) as the only other Davidson alum currently serving as a head coach at Davidson.

Nichols and his wife, the former Lauran Lightmas, a 2004 graduate of Davidson, have two sons, Drew and Jack.
