THE GAME

• The Wildcats head to Kentucky Wesleyan for the first time ever looking to recapture the magic that led them to a 14-7 overtime victory last season at Richardson Stadium.

• Saturday's clash is the second all-time between the two teams with the Wildcats holding the 1-0 edge. Davidson won the lone matchup between the pair last season with a thrilling 14-7 overtime victory at Richardson Stadium.

• Davidson is 335-356-38 all-time against non-conference opponents.

• The game at KWC will be the first of two games this season against DII programs. The 'Cats are set to host DII Livingstone College next Saturday, Sept. 17 at Richardson Stadium before kicking off Pioneer Football League play the following week at Valparaiso.

QUICK HITS

- Head Coach Paul Nichols (Davidson, '03) enters his fourth season as the program's 27th head coach.
- Davidson welcomed another large freshmen class this season, adding 31 to the 2016 roster. The Wildcats have had a string of large classes, adding 36 in 2014 and 34 in 2015.
- Of the 31 newcomers, 15 are listed on defense, 15 are on offense and there's one specialist.
- Davidson finished off the 2015 campaign with a 20-17 PFL win over Stetson, snapping a 24-game losing streak in conference play dating back to Nov. 11, 2012 when the 'Cats outlasted Valparaiso in overtime, 28-27.
- In addition to its 31 freshmen, Davidson welcomes seven new members to the 2016 coaching staff. Assistant Head and Defensive Line Coach Ray McCartney (Guilford, '80), Offensive Coordinator and Quarterbacks Coach Vinny Marino (Connecticut, '92), Special Teams Coordinator and Running Backs Coach Mario Price (Baylor, '07), Offensive Line Coach Matt Applebaum (Connecticut, '07), Safeties Coach Justin Hood (Ashland, '08), Cornerbacks Coach Sean Fisher (Mount Union, '08) and Tight Ends Coach Phil Trautwein (Florida, '07).

• Davidson also returns junior defensive back and kick returner Ben Rowell to the squad. Rowell, a 2015 All-PFL second team specialist, was named to the FootballGameplan.com Preseason All-America third team.

• Senior linebacker Nate Casey recently became the third consecutive Wildcat nominated for the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. The Good Works Team will be announced later this month. Casey's brother, Dan, made the 2014 team, while Chris Woods got a nomination for the 'Cats last year.

GREAT, SCOTT

Junior wide receiver Jaris Scott had a career day at Georgetown. The Jacksonville, Fla., native hauled in a career-high five catches for 149 yards and notched his second career touchdown. Scott has recorded a TD in each of the last two games dating back to the 2015 season finale at Stetson.

PUT ME IN, COACH

It did not take long before freshman quarterback Stockton McGuire made his collegiate debut - seeing action in the first half of the season opener at Georgetown. In his first series, McGuire quickly went 2-3 with 10 yards rushing and capped it off with a 56-yard scoring strike to Jaris Scott. McGuire finished 9-for-15 for 183 yards and two touchdowns.

ROWELL LANDS ON FOOTBALLGAMEPLAN.COM PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA TEAM

Junior Ben Rowell earned a nod on the FBGP.com Preseason All-America third team as a specialist. Rowell returned 17 kicks last season for an average of 28.4 yards per return. He was named to the All-PFL second team last season as a specialist.

MUELLER NAMED TO PRESEASON ALL-PFL TEAM

For the first time in PFL history the league named long snappers to the Preseason All-League team with Davidson junior Conrad Mueller making the grade. Mueller, along with Butler's Connor Aranas, were honored with this distinction back in July's release.

MISSING MORRIS

William Morris '16 left Davidson as the all-time leader in career reception yards (3,200), career receptions (237) and the single-season receptions yards record set in 2014 (1,224).

DIFFICULT DECADE

In the 13 seasons since Nichols graduated, the Wildcats have tallied more wins than losses just twice, and have been unable to match the 7-3 mark of the 2002 team Nichols quarterbacked as a senior. The last winning record came in the 2007 season, a 6-4 mark, and Davidson has recorded just 19 wins since.

EVERYWHERE A WILDCAT

Given that there are roughly 950 males at the school, about 1-in-10 male students at Davidson plays football. Almost a quarter of Davidson's students are student-athletes.

NEW ADDITIONS TO THE STAFF

Head Coach Paul Nichols was busy in the offseason revamping the Wildcat coaching staff, bringing in seven new members to the team. Assistant Head and Defensive Line Coach Ray McCartney (Guilford, '80) returns to North Carolina after spending two seasons at Army West Point. Prior to his tenure with the Black Knights, McCartney roamed the sidelines at Wake Forest for 13 seasons as defensive line coach, helping lead the Demon Deacons to five bowl games. Vinny Marino (Connecticut, '92) enters his first season as Offensive Coordinator after spending two seasons as Assistant Director of Player Personnel at Boston College. Also joining the staff; Special Teams Coordinator and Running Backs Coach Mario Price (Baylor, '07), Offensive Line Coach Matt Applebaum (Connecticut, '07), Safeties Coach Justin Hood (Ashland, '08), Cornerbacks Coach Sean Fisher (Mount Union, '08) and Tight Ends Coach Phil Trautwein (Florida, '07). Trautwein spent time with Marino as a graduate assistant with the Eagles.

PAUL NICHOLS

HEAD COACH

Fourth Season
Davidson, 2003

Paul Nichols '03 is in his fourth season as the head coach of his alma mater.

He was named to the post by Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Dec. 21, 2012, and is the program's 27th head coach.

In 2015, the Wildcats finished 2-9 overall and earned their first Pioneer Football League win under Nichols, finishing 1-7 in conference play. The program landed seven All-PFL team members, including standout wide receiver William Morris, who made it back-to-back appearances on the first team.

Morris made his first All-PFL first team in 2014, while Davidson earned its first Allstate Good Works Team honoree since 2010 as linebacker Dan Casey was honored at the 2015 Sugar Bowl.

In his first season, the Wildcats were led by Matt Casey on the All-PFL team, had three representatives on the Academic All-PFL team, and 39 players were named to the PFL Academic Honor Roll. Additionally, wide receiver William Morris ranked ninth in the nation in receiving yards per game and Nichols' punt return defense ranked fourth in the nation.

Nichols, who was a coach at the Football Bowl Subdivision level starting in 2004, is the second youngest head coach in all of NCAA Division I football, born January 25, 1981.

In 2012, Nichols served as the director of player personnel at Illinois. In that position, he coordinated on-campus recruiting efforts and relations with high school coaches, among other duties, for former head coach Tim Beckman and the Fighting Illini staff.

Prior to his time at Illinois, Nichols spent three seasons on Beckman's staff at Toledo as co-defensive coordinator/safeties coach, where he played a vital role in the transformation of the Rockets' defense.

In 2011, Nichols helped guide the Rockets to a 9-4 record and a win over Air Force in the Military Bowl. Toledo was 7-1 in the MAC and shared the West Division title. Defensively, the Rockets forced 30 turnovers on the season (ranking 16th nationally) and ranked third nationally in turnover margin (+1.23). In 2010, UT increased its forced turnovers from 21 to 34, the fifth-highest takeaway total in the nation, as the Rockets made their first bowl appearance in five years.

Before making his way to Toledo, Nichols served as an assistant at Marshall University for three seasons, where he coached All-Conference USA safety Curtis Keyes (2006) and All-Freshman cornerback Zearrick Matthews (2006).

Prior to his tenure at Marshall, Nichols completed two seasons as a graduate assistant at Ohio State from 2004-05 where he assisted with the defensive backs and defensive line.

A native of Dunwoody, Ga., Nichols graduated from Davidson College in 2003 with bachelor's degrees in political science and history. Nichols was a first-team

All-Pioneer League and a first-team Pioneer League All-Academic selection as a senior, and was named honorable mention All-America by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

In 2000, he quarterbacked Davidson to its first-and-only undefeated season.

Nichols departed as the school record holder for career passing yards (5,822), completions (465) and touchdown passes (51), and compiled a 22-6 record as a starting quarterback. After seeing limited action as a freshman, Nichols won the starting job prior to his sophomore year and guided the 'Cats to a 10-0 season. His junior year was cut short by a knee injury, but Nichols bounced back as a senior and matched the school record for touchdown passes in a single season with 25.

Nichols now ranks third in passing yards and completions after being surpassed by Ryan Alexander '08 and Jonathan Carkhuff '14. He is also now second to Alexander in career passing touchdowns, with Carkhuff needing just six more touchdown passes to move past Nichols in that category.

Nichols is the first Davidson alumnus to guide the football program on a full-time basis since Dave Fagg '58, who finished his second coaching stint with the Wildcats following the 1992 season. He joins Matt Spear '93 (men's soccer) as the only other Davidson alum currently serving as a head coach at Davidson.

Nichols and his wife, the former Lauran Lightmas, a 2004 graduate of Davidson, have two sons, Drew and Jack.
