HATTER HEADLINES

- After a disappointing loss to Jacksonville, the Hatters open the month of October with their first road trip of the year. Davidson is the only program on the schedule this year that Stetson played prior to disbanding the program following the 1956 season.
- The series between Stetson and Davidson goes all the way back to 1912 when the Hatters posted a 21-6 victory. Davidson won three straight meetings between 1954-56 before the Stetson program was discontinued. Since returning, Stetson is 2-1 against the Wildcats.
- The only Stetson loss to Davidson since restarting the program came at the end of the 2015 season on Senior Day. The Hatters made a furious fourth quarter comeback in that game after trailing 10-0 at halftime, only to have Davidson kick a field goal with 1:24 left to take a 20-17 win.
- That game against Davidson last year had one of the longest halftimes ever. At halftime, thunderstorms with heavy lightning resulted in a five hour delay in play. The game started at 1 p.m., but the second half did not begin until after 7 p.m.
- As was the case in the loss to Jacksonville last week, turnovers had a huge impact in the loss to Davidson last year. The Hatters lost two fumbles and had two interceptions in the loss to the Wildcats last year. Last week, against JU, the Hatters turned the ball over on fumbles four times.
- The Stetson roster has just two players from the state of North Carolina. Junior defensive back Dre Long is from Concord and freshman tight end is from nearby Cornelius. Both attended Hough High.
- The Davidson roster is dotted with players from the Sunshine state. A total of 10 Wildcats come from Florida.
- Long-time DeLand mayor Bob Apgar is a 1969 Davidson graduate.
- In the loss to Jacksonville last week the Hatters failed to throw for at least 200 yards for the first time this year. Sophomore QB Gaven DeFilippo was held to just 13-of-25 passing for 117 yards. He was sacked twice and hurried on four other occasions.
- Despite those struggles, the Hatters scored their only touchdown

against JU through the air. DeFilippo hooked up with senior Jonathan Jerozal for a 20-yard TD strike on the Hatters' first possession of the second half. It was the first career receiving TD for Jerozal, a former quarterback. He now has rushing, passing and receiving TDs in his Stetson career. Jerozal is the 17th player to record a receiving TD since the start of the 2013 season.

- Senior running back Cole Mazza surpassed 100-yards rushing in the game against JU, marking the fifth time in his career he has accomplished that. It was his first 100-plus yard game since the 2014 season, when he had the other four.
- The Hatters tied the modern program record in the win over Warner with four interceptions. Stetson previously had four picks in a game against Jacksonville on October 18, 2014.
- · Jacksonville became the first Stetson opponent this year to successfully convert on a PAT attempt. The Dolphins were a perfect 3-of-3 on PATs. Through two games, the Hatters did not allow a successful PAT. Sacred Heart was 0-for-3 in the opener and Warner was 0-for-2 in week two.
- · When junior LB Jeb Boudreaux recorded 15 tackles in the win over Warner he became the first Stetson player not named Donald Payne to have hit that number in a game. Payne has recorded 15 or more tackles in a game 12 times.
- Boudreaux followed that performance with another 15-tackle effort in Stetson's loss to Jacksonville. He also had three tackles for loss and forced a fumble in that game.
- Boudreaux was credited with four tackles for loss in the Warner game, which tied him with Payne for third most in a game for a Stetson player. Davion Belk holds the record with five TFL against Jacksonville in 2014.
- The Hatters had five freshmen make their collegiate debuts in the win over Warner. That group included DB Cam Adams, DB Reggie Gantt, FB Tony Gilotti, WR Jeremiah Nails and DT Nick Kryvicky.
- The loss to Sacred Heart snapped a threegame win streak in season-openers and was the first season-opening loss for the Hatters since restarting the football program. Stetson is 29-21-2 all-time in season-opening games.
- The loss to Jacksonville dropped the Hatters' record in games at Spec Martin Stadium to 6-14 since restarting the program. The Hatters also fell to 3-9 in September games.
- Stetson had five first-time starters, including two freshmen, in the season-opener.
 Sophomores Gaven DeFilippo (QB), Garrett Mullin (OL) and Dom Coluccio (OL) all made

their first starts on offense while freshmen Shane Parton (DT) and Colby Duncan (LB) made their first starts on defense.

- The Hatters had a total of eight players see action in a varsity contest for the first time. That group included DeFilippo, Coluccio, Parton and Duncan as well as freshmen Peter Katz (DB), Rich Stanzione (DB) and Tony Gilotti (RB) as well as junior linebacker Jacob Boerboom.
- Senior Cole Mazza recorded his 20th career rushing touchdown in the 1st quarter against Sacred Heart. No other Stetson player in the modern era has scored as many as 10 total touchdowns. He added his 21st TD in the win over Warner.
- Mazza's 21 career TDs account for 23.3 percent of the 90 total offensive touchdowns the Hatters have scored since the start of the 2013 season. The next closest Stetson player on the TD list is senior receiver Chris Crawford, who has eight.
- · Sophomore Donald Parham became the 16th player of the modern era to score a receiving touchdown when he made a diving catch of a DeFilippo pass for a 22-yard score late in the first half against Sacred Heart.
- The 2016 Stetson roster has 13 players remaining from the original 108 who reported to campus in August of 2012 to restart the football program. This group of fifth year seniors has been the nucleus of the program for three seasons. Overall, Stetson has 25 seniors on the 2016 roster.
- · The 2016 Stetson roster is the smallest it has been since the program was restarted. The Hatters enter the season with a total of 102 players on the squad. The reduction in numbers was done intentionally in order to begin redshirting more freshmen each year. As a result, there will be no junior varsity games this season. The Hatters are hopeful of redshirting as many as 30 players this fall.
- · Almost half of the players on the squad to open the season come from the state of Florida (50). In addition to the Sunshine State the Hatters hail from 17 other states and one US Territory. Behind Florida, Georgia (18) and California (5) are the most represented states on the roster.
- The Hatters elected six team captains for the 2016 season. Five of those captains OL Patrick Fogarty, WR Jonathan Jerozal, LB Dylan Wydronkowski, DE Davion Belk and DB Donald Payne are among the 13 fifth year seniors. The only non-senior in the group is junior QB Colin McGovern.
- Senior defensive back Donald Payne was one of 22 players named to the STATS FCS Defensive Player of the Year Watch List. Payne,

the two-time defending PFL Defensive Player of the Year, returned as the eighth leading tackler in all NCAA football with 424 career tackles to start the year. He had 10 stops in the opener to run his total of 434. His 248 career solo tackles ranks third among all active players.

- Payne was one of three players from the PFL named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America team. The senior was also named to the Hero Sports Preseason All-America squad.
- Both Payne and DE Davion Belk have been invited to play in Dream Bowl V. The All-Star game is scheduled to be played in Virginia Beach, Va., on January 16, 2017, corresponding with the Martin Luther King Jr. national holiday.
- · McGovern, who earned the starting QB job in spring practice, had his season ended before it ever started. He suffered an injury in the first practice in full pads that will keep him on the sideline for the entire 2016 season.
- · With McGovern out of action, the Hatters opened the season with redshirt sophomore Gaven DeFilippo at the controls of the offense. A native of Tucson, Arizona, DeFilippo saw action in some JV games in 2014 but redshirted last fall. When he took the field against Sacred Heart he was the first player other than Ryan Tentler to start a game at quarterback since the Hatters returned to play in 2013.
- Tentler finished his playing career by throwing for 5,218 yards over three seasons, completing 461 of 811 pass attempts (56.8%). He had 35 TD passes and was also intercepted 35 times and posted a career 116.5 QB rating. In addition, Tentler rushed the ball 295 times in his career for 1,182 yards and seven scores.

- DE Davion Belk is also 3.5 TFL shy of 50 for his career.
- \cdot LB David Lazear is 15 tackles shy of 200 for his career.
- DB Glenn Adesoji recorded the 100th tackle of his career in the win over Warner.
- WR Chris Crawford is 157 receiving yards shy of 1,000 for his career.
- $\,\cdot\,$ FB Mike Yonker is five receiving yards shy of 500 for his career.
- \cdot DB Dre Long is 64 all-purpose yards shy of 1,000 for his career.
- · With 119 all-purpose yards against JU, RB Cole Mazza's moved past Darius McGriff for the modern career record. Mazza has 1,628 career all-purpose yards.
- WR Kegan Moore surpassed 1,000 career receiving yards in the opener against Sacred Heart. He is the only player of the modern era to reach that milestone.

· Stetson was held to less than 100 yards rushing as a team in four of 11 games last season and in the opening game this year. The Hatters have failed to rush for at least 100 yards in a game in 12 of 37 games since restarting the program. Not surprisingly, the Hatters are 0-12 in those games and 11-14 in all other games. Here is a look at the games when the Hatters were held to less than 100 yards on the ground.

• On the flip side, the Hatters have rushed for more than 200 yards in a game five times over the last three seasons. Stetson is just 3-2 in those games.

- Extremes in passing yards in a game does not provide an accurate measure of success for the Hatters. Stetson has failed to throw for at least 100 yards in a game four times, including the loss to Campbell last year, and is 0-4 in those games. The Hatters have passed for more than 200 yards in a game 15 times, but are just 4-11 in those games.
- Over the first three seasons, only four players started all 34 games for the Hatters.

Only two players, OL Patrick Fogarty and LB David Lazear returned this year to keep their streaks alive. Fogarty saw his streak end at 35 games when he missed the Warner game with an injury. Stetson currently has five active players with at least 30 career starts with Davion Belk, Donald Payne and Chris Atkins all in that club. Three other players - DB Glenn Adesoji, WR Chris Crawford and OL Matt Wawrzyniak - have at least 25 career starts.

- · Another player who started every game for Stetson over three seasons has continued his streak this fall. Ryan Powers transferred to East Tennessee State after graduating from Stetson and has started at free safety for the Bucs in their first three games. He is second on the ETSU squad with 21 tackles.
- · So far, 74 different players have made starts on either offense or defense over three-plus seasons. That doesn't count players who have served as starters on various special teams.
- The Hatters failed to record an interception in five games last year. Over three seasons, the Hatters have failed to record an interception in just 11 of 37 games and have a 1-10 record in those games.
- Over 37 games, the Hatters have scored defensive or special teams touchdowns 10 times. Donald Payne has three scores while Chris Atkins has two and Eric Martin one among returning players.
- The 2017 schedule will feature home games against Dartmouth, Campbell, Brown, Davidson, San Diego and Butler with road games against Sacred Heart, Marist, Valparaiso, Morehead State and Jacksonville.

The Coaching Staff

- The 2016 season mark's head coach Roger Hughes' 31st season of college football. He joins linebackers coach Bob Majeski to have reached three decades of college coaching.
- Roger Hughes is the ninth different head

- coach in Stetson football history. He has a career record of 57-78 in 13 seasons as a collegiate head coach.
- · With Stetson's 2013 win over Warner, the nine Hatter head coaches have combined to go 7-2 in their debut contests.
- Before coming to DeLand, Hughes already had 10 years of head coaching experience, posting a 47-52 mark at Princeton from 2000-09.
- Hughes' Tigers shared the 2006 lvy League title, going 9-1 overall and 6-1 in "the ancient eight".
- · Hughes has previously served as an assistant with the Omaha Nighthawks of the UFL and collegiately at Dartmouth, Cameron, Wisconsin-Whitewater, Nebraska and, his alma mater, Doane College in Crete, Nebraska.
- Hughes graduated from Doane in 1982 after playing both football (tight end) and golf.
 His daughter, Maddison, is in her junior season as a member of the women's golf team at Doane.
- · Jacob Behrns is back for his third season with the Hatters. He coached tight ends in 2014, but led the receivers in 2015. A graduate of Wayne State, Behrns also has a degree from the Arizona Culinary Institute.
- · Nolan Behrns returns for his fifth year at Stetson where he serves as the Director of Football Operations and also works with the Hatters kickers. He was the first person hired by Hughes when he agreed to take the job of building the new Stetson program from scratch in 2011.
- · Brian Boerboom came to Stetson in 2015 from Southeast Missouri State, where he had served as offensive line coach for eight seasons. Boerboom played collegiately for Tom Osborne at the University of Nebraska where he was an All-Big Eight selection. His son, Jacob, is a linebacker for the Hatters.
- · Matt Diniak returns for his third year as running backs coach. He played collegiately

at Grand Valley State for current Notre Dame head coach Brian Kelly and got his coaching start as a member of Kelly's staff in 2001. He spent four seasons working for the Tampa Bay Bucs as an offensive scout.

- Bob Majeski is a member of the three-decade club for the Hatters. He returns to coach linebackers while also working to coordinate the Hatters' special teams. Majecki played collegiately at Kansas State and has worked in virtually every capacity possible as a coach, including multiple stops as a head coach at the junior college level, earning Jayhawk Conference Coach of the Year honors in 2010.
- · Kiwaukee Thomas also returns for a second season at Stetson as defensive backs coach. Thomas was a three-time All-Southern Conference player at Georgia Southern, earning All-America honors in 1999 in helping the Eagles to the FCS national title. He spent the next eight years playing in the NFL for the Jaguars, Dolphins and Bills, plus one year in Canada with the Montreal Alouettes
- Defensive coordinator Brian Young was the first on-field coaching hire for Hughes and he has been a steady force on the staff from the very first day. Also a former player at Georgia Southern, Young played in the arena leagues before starting his coaching career and has had stops at Mississippi College and Cornell before joining the Stetson staff.
- The two newest members of the full-time coaching staff this year are tight ends coach Clay Mazza and defensive line coach Jonathan Johnson. Mazza, the older brother of the Hatters running back, has worked as volunteer assistant coach for the last two years but was elevated to the full-time staff when Time Keating stepped away from coaching.
- · Johnson came to Stetson in the spring from Mississippi Gulf Coast Community College where he filled a variety of roles, including equipment manager and facility manager in addition to coaching the offensive line, tight ends and full backs. He took over as defensive line coach for the Hatters, the position he played in college.
- Tim Keating left the Stetson coaching staff over the summer after more than three decades of collegiate coaching to focus on his health. Brandon Wright, another veteran assistant coach for the Hatters, left the program in the offseason to coach in Australia.

Hatters History

- The 2016 season marks the 52nd overall season of play for Stetson football. The Hatters have an all-time record of 166-153-27.
- Stetson began play in 1901, defeating the Florida Agricultural College, 6-0, on Nov. 22 (Thanksgiving Day) at the State fairgrounds in

Jacksonville.

- The Hatters compiled a 155-127-27 (.543) mark in their history prior to discontinuing the program following the 1957 season.
- Stetson participated in the 1951 Tangerine Bowl, defeating Arkansas State, 35-20.
- The Hatters claimed the Florida state championship six times (1901, 1903, 1905, 1906, 1907 and 1909).
- The program had been halted three times before, not competing in 1915, 1917-18 (World War I) and 1941-45 (World War II) in addition to 1957-2012.
- All four times that Stetson has missed a season of play, the Hatters won their first game upon the program's resumption, downing Rollins College in 1916, the Florida Military Academy in 1919, Troy in 1946 and Warner in 2013
- Stetson football has produced 22 coaches and players who have been inducted into the Stetson Athletics Hall of Fame, in addition to the 1927, 1938 and 1951 teams.

Noting The Hatters

- · A trio of Hatters made jersey number changes prior to the Jacksonville game. Kicker Grant Amick switched from 13 to 17 because senior receiver Jonathan Jerozal, who serves as the backup holder, also wears 13. To accommodate that move, freshman defensive back JJ Henderson switched from 17 to 13. Freshman Grant Hodges also made a switch from 73 to 97 in order to switch from offensive line to tight end.
- \cdot Freshman DB Cam Adams made his collegiate debut on special teams in the win over Warner.
- DB Glenn Adesoji had seven tackles in the opener, and three in the win over Warner, giving him exactly 100 in his career. He was credited with two tackles against JU. He also had his second career interception in the win over Warner, returning the pick 41 yards to the Royals' 15, setting up a Stetson touchdown.
- K Grant Amick handles kickoffs and all PAT/field goal duties. Amick has connected on 30 PAT kicks in his career and is 9-of-16 on field goals with a long of 50 yards.
- DB Chris Atkins has started 36 of 37 games in his career and has 13 career interceptions, including one in the win over Warner. He was named team Defensive Player of the Week for his performance against JU, which produced nine tackles, including one for loss. He has 140 career tackles.
- DE Davion Belk has been a captain throughout his Stetson career and is one of the 13 fifth-year seniors. He moved inside to start at nose tackle in the game against

Jacksonville. With three tackles in the win over Warner he became the third Stetson player with at least 200 career tackles. He now stands at 203 and also has 46.5 TFL and 18.5 sacks. He was nominated for the National Football Foundation Post-Graduate Scholarship.

- LB Jacob Boerboom is the son of offensive line coach Brian Boerboom and is one of six children. Boerboom sat out the 2015 season as a transfer. He saw his first playing time in the game against Sacred Heart. He had his first tackle for the Hatters against Warner.
- DB Jeb Boudreaux did not play in 2015 due to chronic hamstring problems. He had a career-high five tackles, including one for loss, in the game against Sacred Heart. He earned the Hatters' "Big Hit" award for the game. He followed that with his first start in the win over Warner, posting an incredible 15 tackles, including four for loss, to earn Defensive Player of the Week honors. He again had 15 tackles, with three for loss and a forced fumble, in the loss to JU. He now has 56 career tackles.
- RB Arkee Brown average 4.1 yards per carry on 53 attempts as a freshman in 2015. He had nine carries for 37 yards in the opening game of this year. He was limited to four carries for 12 yards against Warner before leaving the game with an ankle injury. He did not dress for Jacksonville and is doubtful this week.
- · Sophomore DL James Carey made his season debut in the win over Warner.
- Sophomore OL Dom Coluccio made his first start for the Hatters in the opener against Sacred Heart, opening at right tackle. He moved over to left tackle after Patrick Fogarty went down with an injury and started at left tackle in that game. He will serve as the backup at both tackle positions this week.
- Sophomore LB Jamieson Craske has seen action on special teams in each of the first three games this year.
- · WR Chris Crawford missed all of training camp with a personal issue, but is one of the 13 fifth year seniors. He has 78 career receptions for 843 yards and eight scores, but did not play in the opener. He saw action against Warner and JU, but did not record a reception.
- DE Eddie Curry missed part of training camp with an ankle injury but was ready for the opener, recording three tackles, including one for loss. He started against JU and had six tackles giving him 55 in his career.
- QB Gaven DeFilippo redshirted last fall and entered the 2016 season as the Hatters starter. He is not your average college sophomore, having also gone to prep school for a year in

addition to redshirting. He completed 15 of his first 18 pass attempts, throwing for 189 yards in the first half against Sacred Heart. He finished 22-of-28 for 225 yards and a touchdown and was named the Hatters' Offensive Player of the Week. He followed up by throwing for 229 yards and two touchdowns on 24-of-36 passes against Warner with one interception. He has thrown for 571 yards and four touchdowns this season with one interception.

- · Sophomore DB Cole Dunagan has seen action in each of the first three games.
- Freshman LB Colby Duncan made his first start for the Hatters in the opener against Sacred Heart. He acquitted himself well with six tackles in the game. He came off the bench against Warner, posting three tackles, including one for loss, and he recorded a fourth quarter interception to put the game away.
- DE Jeff Fallabel was a reliable performer for the Hatters last year, posting 23 tackles, including three for loss, in 11 games. He started and had a career-high six tackles in the season-opener against Sacred Heart.
- OL Patrick Fogarty is a team captain and, despite having had major surgery between his freshman and sophomore seasons, had never missed a game before sitting out the Warner game with a shoulder injury, suffered in the opener against Sacred Heart. He is one of the 13 fifth-year seniors for the Hatters this fall. His streak of consecutive starts may have been snapped at 35, but he returned to the lineup for the JU game.
- P/K Eric Fogle averaged 37.5 yards on eight punts in the opener against Sacred Heart. He averaged 44 yards on three punts against Warner, but had one punt blocked. He earned Special Teams Player of the Week for his efforts against JU, averaging 43.2 yards on six punts, with three downed inside the 20. JU managed just one return for 11 yards.
- DB Conrad Fonseca has had two tackles in each of the first three games this year.
- Freshman DB Reggie Gantt made his collegiate debut in the win over Warner. He plays on various special teams.
- · Freshman FB Tony Gilotti saw his first playing time in the win over Warner. He did not have any rush attempts, but he did have a reception.
- LS Gary Gotling is in his third season as the Hatters primary snapper.
- DB Chancellor Jackson, can go back to being Chance year after the Hatters' other Chance Jackson left the program. He can expect to see significant playing time at corner this fall. He played and was credited with a pass breakup in the opening game of the year.

- · WR Jonathan Jerozal was a quarterback for his first two seasons at Stetson but moved outside in 2014 to get more playing time. Another fifth-year senior and team captain, he has 22 career receptions for 215 yards after a career-best five catches against Sacred Heart in the opener. He had three catches for 33 yards against Warner and took home the Big Hit Award for the game. His five receptions against JU included his first career TD catch.
- DB Jackie Jay Johnson was thrust into the starting lineup this fall. One of just two De-Land HS products on the squad, he is one of the Hatters' corners. He had three tackles in the opening game against Sacred Heart. He had a tackle, a pass breakup and his first career interception in the win over Warner.
- Freshman DB Pete Katz has seen action on special teams in each of the first three games.
- · Freshman DL Nick Kryvicky made his col-

legiate debut in the win over Warner.

- LB David Lazear put medical school on hold for one more year to return for a fifth season. He has started every game of his career, and is now the last player to have started every Stetson game since the program restarted in 2013. He has 185 tackles, including 24 TFL. He tied career-highs with 10 tackles and three TFL against Sacred Heart. He followed up with five tackles, including a sack, in the win over Warner. He had nine tackles with three for loss, including a sack, against JU.
- OL JuWuan Livingston moved back to his natural position after playing on the defensive line in 2015. He lost his father during training camp
- DB Dre Long finally found a home last year and will be counted on to contribute at corner this fall. He was a running back as a freshman and a receiver as a sophomore last year before moving to defensive back last year. He struggled with injuries last fall but had

- a healthy camp. He was credited with three tackles and two pass breakups in the opening game. He had four tackles in the win over Warner and three tackles against JU.
- TE Austin Marks has made 28 receptions over three seasons as the pass-catching part of the Hatters' tight end tandem. He suffered an ankle injury early in training camp, but was ready to start the year. He earned the Hatters' Big Hit Award for the game against JU.
- Junior DB Eric Martin made his season debut against JU by recording four tackles. He is expected to start at corner against Davidson.
- RB Cole Mazza battled through a foot injury last year that limited him to just 78 carries. He appears to have returned to the form from his sophomore season in 2014 when he rushed for 922 yards. He had 16 carries for 49 yards and a touchdown in the opening game of the year. He followed up with 17 carries for 59 yards and a score against Warner. He had 112 rushing yards on 16 carries against JU, marking the fifth time in his career he has rushed for more than 100 yards in a game.
- OL Jim McCammon is back as one of three returning starters on the front line this fall.
- QB Colin McGovern won the battle for the starting job during spring practice and was selected as a captain for the 2016 season. Unfortunately, his season ended before it ever started when he suffered an injury in the Hatters first practice in full pads. He is not expected to be available to play all year.
- · WR Kegan Moore had a breakout season in 2014 but missed a good portion of the 2015 season after dislocating his elbow on his first catch of the year. The result left a bad taste in his mouth and brought him back for a fifth year, even though he has already received his degree. He opened the season with four receptions for 70 yards, making him the first Hatter of the modern era with 1,000 career receiving yards. He had a game-high seven receptions for 80 yards in the win over Warner, but had just two receptions for 12 yards against JU. He now has 54 career receptions for 1116 yards, an average of 20.6 yards per catch.
- OL Garrett Mullin stepped into the starting job at center to open the 2016 season.
- TE Donald Parham was the no doubt MVP on the spring game in April with 10 receptions. At 6-foot-8, he will cause mismatches for defensive backs all year. He got off to a strong start this year with five receptions for 72 yards and a touchdown against Sacred Heart. He followed up with four receptions for 42 yards and another score in the win over Warner. He was held to one reception for 12 yards in the loss to JU.

- · Freshman DT Shane Parton made his first career start for the Hatters in the opener against Sacred Heart. He finished with one tackle in the game. He followed up with two tackles, including one for loss, in the win over Warner.
- DB Donald Payne returns to put a cap on his remarkable career as a captain and fifthyear senior. The two-time PFL Defensive Player of the Year is also a two-time All-American and enters 2016 as one of the top 10 returning tacklers in all of college football. He was credited with 10 tackles in the opening game of the season. He was credited with just five tackles, including two for loss, with three QB hurries against Warner. He bounced back with 10 tackles, including 2.5 for loss, against JU. He now has 449 total career stops including 55.5 for loss, and has 19 career QB hurries to go with 11 sacks. He blocked a field goal attempt against Warner after blocking a PAT attempt against Sacred Heart. He also had two punt returns for eight yards against Warner and was selected as the Hatters' Special Teams Player of the Week.
- WR Austin Perlman has played in each of the first three games and had two receptions for 18 yards in the win over Warner.
- LB Delvin Riley has seen action in all three games this fall. He was credited with a tackle in the opening game.
- OL Andrew Rogalski started the final two games of 2015 and, after not starting the opener, he played significant snaps after Patrick Fogarty went down with an injury. He has started at right tackle in the last two games.
- LB Reeves Rogers transferred to Stetson from Furman where he saw action in four games over two seasons. He did most of his damage on special teams last year, a role he continues in this fall. He was credited with one tackle in the win over Warner.
- DL Zane Smith played in each of the last eight games last year after being slowed early by an injury. He was credited with one tackle and a QB hurry in the opener. He had a TFL in the win over Warner.
- · Freshman LB Rich Stanzione has seen action in each of the first three games this year, primarily on special teams. Was credited with a tackle in the win over Warner.
- DL Regis Steighner suffered a broken bone in his ankle during training camp and is headed toward a redshirt season this fall.
- RB Matt Taft saw limited action at fullback last fall, but slimmed down in the off-season and, stepped up late in the win over Warner with eight carries for 49 yards in the second half after Arkee Brown went down with an

ankle injury. He had five carries for 11 yards against JU last week.

- DB Djuan "DJ" Tinsley has a chance to make his mark on special teams as a sophomore this year. He did that in the opener with a big tackle on the punt team, earning Special Teams Player of the Week honors.
- TE Austin Tyrrell is back at his natural position after a flirtation with a move to offensive line. He gives the Hatters a tremendous run and pass blocker. He had his first career reception, picking up a first down in the fourth quarter, in the win over Warner.
- OL Matt Wawrzyniak has been a starter for the Hatters off and on for three years and, next to Fogarty, is the Hatters' most experienced lineman.
- DL Shayne White missed most of the season last year after suffering a season-ending knee injury early in the opener. He received a medical redshirt and still has two years of eligibility. He has started the last two games.
- · WR Darian Wright missed the first five games of the 2015 season while recovering from knee surgery that ended his 2014 season. A dynamic player with the ball in his hands, he was slowed in camp by injuries. When healthy, he will return kicks and punts in addition to giving the Hatters a deep threat. He had two receptions for 36 yards in the opener and two more receptions for 17 yards against Warner.
- LB Dylan Wydronkowski turned in such a great season for the Hatters last year, his first as a starter, that he decided to return for one more year, even though he has graduated. He is one of the 13 fifth year seniors and is a team captain for 2016. He posted a career-high 12 tackles in the opening game of the year, including one for loss, and was named the Hatters Defensive Player of the Week. He had five tackles, including one for loss, and two hurries in the win over Warner. He was credited with 11 tackles against JU, including 1.5 for loss.
- FB Mike Yonker is a blue-collar guy who does a great job as a pass blocker, can run the ball when asked to and is a good receiver out of the backfield. His only problem has been staying healthy enough to get on the field. He spent the summer in Austria as part of a study abroad program. He earned Offensive Player of the Week honors for his efforts against Warner despite only touching the ball five times. He had three rush attempts for eight yards, six coming on a TD run, and he had two receptions for 34 yards, including a 31-yard TD reception. He had three receptions for 29 yards against JU.
