## PLAYERS OF THE WEEK

### OFFENSIVE



**Alex Jeske, Dayton**

Sophomore (RS) | Quarterback

Jeske became just the third FCS quarterback to rush for four touchdowns in a game, leading Dayton to a 59-31 PFL win at Marist, Saturday. He finished the day responsible for six touchdowns, completing 13-of-20 passes for 198 yards and two touchdowns. But it was his ground game that did the biggest damage as he finished with 179 rushing yards on 18 carries. Jeske's first touchdown was a five-yard sprint following a 94-yard kickoff return by Cameron Stubbs that gave Dayton a 7-3 lead it would not relinquish. He would add another five-yard run in the first quarter. Jeske then had a 40-yard touchdown pass, a three-yard TD run, a 28-yard scoring pass and a four-yard touchdown run to cap his day.

Cunningham had a hand in two big turnovers to help Campbell hold on for a 27-21 PFL victory against Morehead State, Saturday. He recovered a fumble on a muffed punt in the third quarter, helping to set up a Campbell scoring drive for a 20-7 lead. Later in the game, Cunningham intercepted a pass on Morehead State's next-to-last drive, returning it 17 yards to setup Campbell inside the MSU red zone. He also had five tackles (four solo) in the contest.

#### STATS FCS NATIONAL SPECIAL TEAMS PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Stubbs posted an FCS season best 234 kickoff return yards in Dayton's 59-31 PFL victory at Marist, Saturday. He began his day with a 94-yard kickoff return that fell five yards shy of a touchdown but set up Dayton's go-ahead touchdown drive. He later found the end zone with a 90-yard kickoff return in the fourth quarter that put Dayton ahead 52-31. Stubbs other two kickoff returns each went for more than 20 yards and he finished with a 58.5 yard per return mark for the game.

## KICKOFF CAPSULES

### ■ San Diego at Campbell, Noon

**Setting the Scene:** San Diego will look to complete an unbeaten run through its PFL slate when it travels cross country for a meeting with Campbell. The Toreros clinched at least a share of the 2016 PFL title with last week's wins against Stetson. Now they set their sights on posting the first unbeaten mark in PFL play since 2010 (Dayton). The Camels will look to play spoiler and bring a two-game win streak into the regular season finale.

**San Diego Story to Watch:** Make a Statement Against the Run. San Diego's pass defense garners a great deal of attention, but its run defense has been just as stout. The Toreros have allowed just 86.1 yards per game and only five touchdowns this season on the ground. Campbell has thrived through its ground game in 2016, leading the PFL with 5.02 yards per rush, ranking second in the lead with 226.6 yards per game and fourth with 20 rushing touchdowns this season.

**Campbell Story to Watch:** Match the Toreros Pass Defense. In a matchup of the PFL's top two passing defenses, can a second-ranked Campbell unit hold the PFL's most efficient passing game in check? San Diego, led by quarterback Anthony Lawrence, has 21 touchdown passes against just six interceptions while completing an astounding 67.8 percent of its passes this season. Meanwhile, the Camels pass defense has forced more interceptions (12) than touchdowns (10) while holding opponents to a 47.6 pass completion rate this season. That held true in the face of facing PFL career passing leader Austin Gahafer to one touchdown pass last week at Morehead State.

### ■ Marist at Jacksonville, Noon

**Video:** ESPN3

**Setting the Scene:** Marist makes its second trip to Florida in three weeks when it meets Jacksonville, Saturday. The Red Foxes last trip to the Sunshine State came after its first PFL loss to San Diego and saw them pull out a late win against Stetson. Their return follows a second PFL loss but will they fare better in a return to Florida? Jacksonville returns home seeking to squelch a two-game PFL losing streak that has seen it lose narrow decision to Drake in Week 10 and Valparaiso in Week 11.

**Marist Story to Watch:** The Mike White Show. In Marist's last three games quarterback Mike White has been called on to shoulder a heavy load, not only passing but running the ball. He has been the Red Foxes leading rusher in these last three games, including back-to-back 100-yard rushing performances entering the finale. All told, he has compiled 992 total offense yards in the last three games, pushing his season average above 300 yards per game.

**Jacksonville Story to Watch:** When Quarterbacks Run Free. Jacksonville quarterback Rylan Wells has rushed for more than 100 yards in three consecutive games entering this week's outing. That includes last week's 135 yards and two touchdowns in a loss to Valparaiso. Can he replicate the feat of Dayton quarterback Alex Jeske, who single-handedly defeated Marist after rushing for 179 yards and four touchdowns last week?

### ■ Drake at Stetson, 1 p.m.

**Video:** ESPN3

**Setting the Scene:** Drake is another team headed to the Sunshine State for its season finale as it heads south to meet Stetson. The Bulldogs have rallied in the season's closing weeks, bringing a three-game win streak into the season's final contest. Drake's two touchdown win against Butler last week was its most convincing of the set. The Hatters are on the other side of the coin, entering Week 12 looking to end a three-game losing streak that is their longest of the season.

**Drake Story to Watch:** Kraemer Keeping On. Bulldogs quarterback Grant Kraemer has found a different mode during the three-game win streak. He entered the bye week with just 10 touchdowns and a 54.1 pass completion rate in the season's first seven games. Since the break, he has completed 62.4 percent of his passes for eight touchdowns in three games. Stetson ranks fourth against the pass this season, allowing just 200 yards per game, but has permitted 20 touchdown passes this season.

**Stetson Story to Watch:** Release the Hatters. After leading the FCS in tackles for loss for 10 weeks, Stetson slid to fourth in the subdivision after a season-low three tackles for loss against a stout San Diego offensive line. Can defensive back Jeb Boudreaux return to form against Drake? The Bulldogs rank 10th against the pass rush this season, allowing 3.0 sacks per game. However, they are fifth in the league in permitting just 5.60 tackles for loss per game.

### ■ Morehead State at Davidson, 1 p.m.

**Setting the Scene:** Two teams looking to end 2016 on a positive note collide when Morehead State travels across the Blue Ridge Mountains to face Davidson. Morehead State returns to the road after a narrow home loss to Campbell last week despite outgaining its foe. Davidson returns to action after its off week and looks to bounce back from its Week 10 shutout at Campbell.

**Morehead State Story to Watch:** All Eyes on Gahafer. Quarterback Austin Gahafer has been the focus of attention during his four years at Morehead State. It will be no different in his final game as an Eagle as he looks to reach the 12,000-career passing yard mark. Gahafer enters the 2016 finale needing 377 yards to reach the mark, but will face an opponent that has not been a willing partner. Davidson has held Gahafer to less than 280 yards in each of their three previous meetings. In addition, the Wildcats have allowed just 251 passing yards per game this season and a 377-yard outing would be a season-high against Davidson.

**Davidson Story to Watch:** Get Back On Track. In its first five games this season, Davidson showed steady improvement. That effort peaked in back-to-back four point losses in Weeks 4 and 5. However, since that Week 5 outing, the Wildcats have not posted more than 17 points in a game, and were held to single-digit outings by the league's top two defenses. Will a week off be the tonic the offense was seeking as Davidson prepares to face a Morehead State defense ranked 10th in the league, allowing 429.1 yards and 4.3 touchdowns per game?

# 2016 PIONEER FOOTBALL LEAGUE WEEKLY REPORT

## NEWS AND NOTES FROM AROUND THE PFL

**SAN DIEGO CLINCHES PFL TITLE SHARE, AUTOMATIC BID** | San Diego has clinched at least a share of its eighth PFL title with its Week 11 victory against Stetson and would claim the crown outright with a win at Campbell. It is San Diego's third consecutive PFL title (or share). In addition, the Toreros clinched the PFL's automatic bid to the NCAA Division I Football Championship, becoming the first PFL program to reach that tournament twice.

**STUBBS NABS STATS NATIONAL HONOR** | Dayton cornerback Cameron Stubbs' FCS best 234 kickoff return yards against Marist earned him the STATS National Special Teams Player of the Week honor, Nov. 14. He finished his 2016 campaign averaging 28.7 yards per kickoff return, fourth best among FCS kick returners.

**LAWRENCE, BEASCHLER ADDED TO STATS WATCH LISTS** | San Diego quarterback Anthony Lawrence and Dayton linebacker Christopher Beaschler were added to the STATS FCS Award Watch Lists, Nov. 9. Lawrence, who enters the regular season's final week as one of the FCS' top passers, was named to the Walter Payton Award Watch List. Beaschler, who is one of the nation's top tacklers, was tapped for the Buck Buchanan Award Watch List.

**GAHAFAER NOW PFL'S MOST PROLIFIC PASSER** | Morehead State quarterback Austin Gahafer became the PFL's career passing yards leader during Week 10, with a 465-yard performance against Butler. He finished the game with 11,623 career passing yards, breaking the record held by Jacksonville's Josh McGregor (2008-11). Gahafer is now 15th on the FCS career passing yards list, and would become only the 13th passer to reach 12,000 yards with a 377-yard performance in his final game.

**RAYMOND TOP PFL RECEIVER** | Joining teammate Gahafer in the PFL record book, Morehead State slot receiver Jake Raymond became the league's career receptions leader in that same Week 10 outing at Butler, finishing the game with 268 career catches. He broke the record held by Butler's Zach Watkins (2008-11). Raymond's receptions total is 16th most in FCS history, he needs 15 receptions to break into the Top 15 all time.

**BEASCHLER A CAMPBELL TROPHY FINALIST** | Dayton linebacker Christopher Beaschler was named one of 12 finalists for the 2016 William V. Campbell Trophy, presented by Fidelity Investments®. One of only six two-time team captains in Dayton history, Beaschler has led the Flyers in tackles the last two seasons and leads the team this season. The Ada, Ohio native maintains a 3.72 GPA in Mechanical Engineering. He was a CoSIDA First Team Academic All-American, Pioneer Football League Co-Scholar-Athlete of the Year and repeated as a First Team All-PFL performer in 2015.

**THIRTEEN NAMED TO COSIDA ACADEMIC ALL-DISTRICT TEAMS** | Thirteen Pioneer Football League student-athletes were named to the 2016 College Sports Information Directors Association Academic All-District™ Teams. Eight of the league's 11 members had one student-athlete recognized on the teams. The 13 PFL student-athletes selected to the first team in their respective districts are placed on the national ballot for Academic All-America™ consideration.

**NO FLY ZONE** | Dayton enters Week 11 tied for the FCS lead in interceptions with 20 picks in 2016. The Flyers have three players – David Leisring, Christian Searles and Cameron Stubbs – ranked among the FCS Top 50 in interceptions per game.

**LIVING IN THE BACKFIELD** | Stetson's defense slipped to No. 3 in the country through 10 weeks, averaging 9.3 team tackles for loss per game this season. The Hatters have posted 10 or tackles for loss in six of their 10 games this season, including 16 tackles for loss against Jacksonville, Sept. 24. Stetson's Jeb Boudreaux is ranked 10th among FCS defenders with a PFL-leading 1.8 tackles for loss per game this season.

**WILL KICKS WAY TO PFL RECORD** | Dayton kicker William Will set the PFL record for career field goals with three conversions at Jacksonville in Week 7, breaking the record held by Drake's Billy Cundiff (49, 1998-01). He ended his career with 55 career field goals made.

**DAYTON'S SCORING STREAK PASSES 450 GAMES** | The nation's longest streak of games without being shutout belongs to PFL-member Dayton, which extended the streak to an impressive 454 games with a 2016-ending victory against Marist. On the FBS side, Florida holds the nation's longest streak of games without being shutout at 355, dating back to the 1988 season. The Flyers streak dates back to 1976 when it suffered a 9-0 loss to Marshall.

### PFL MEDIA RELATIONS CONTACT

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**SAN DIEGO OWNS FCS' STINGIEST DEFENSE** | Entering Week 8, San Diego's defense leads the FCS in fewest points allowed in 2016, permitting just 11.1 points per game. In four of their eight games, the Toreros have permitted just one score by the opposing team. A large part of that effort is due to owning one of the FCS' best defensive units against the pass, leading all FCS squads with its 82.68 pass efficiency defense rating.

**TOREROS PROTECT THEIR OWN** | Keeping true to their mascot, San Diego has not allowed opposing teams to get to their quarterback, permitting just two sacks in nine games this season, ranking second in fewest sacks allowed among FCS teams. Only Southern Conference member The Citadel has done better, allowing only one sack in 2016.

**IN GOOD CRUSADERS HANDS** | Valparaiso now is the FCS's top team in ball security, surrendering only one fumble in 2016. The Crusaders are tied with Lehigh and Maine for the top spot. Drake and Davidson enter the regular season's final week ranked seventh nationally with three fumbles lost.

**DAYTON'S CHAMBERLIN NOTCHES 50TH PFL WIN** | Dayton head coach Rick Chamberlin became only the second PFL coach to record 50 league wins, reaching the milestone in Week 6 against Morehead State. He joins former Dayton head coach and College Football Hall of Fame member Mike Kelley, who amassed a 55-16 career PFL record in 15 seasons, as the only PFL coaches to record 50 league wins.

**HATTERS MAKE SPORTSCENTER TOP 10** | Stetson's overtime blocked field goal return for a touchdown landed the No. 3 spot on SportsCenter's Top 10 plays, Oct. 22. The 87-yard dash was one of the longest in NCAA FCS history, just shy of the record 90-yard blocked field goal return by Delaware against William & Mary in 2012. Senior Donald Payne blocked the field goal try, his FCS leading third blocked kick this season.

**JONES SECOND PFL 200-YARD RUSHER IN '16** | Morehead State freshman running back Trevor Jones became the PFL's second 200-yard rusher this season. His 284-yard outing against Jacksonville in Week 8 was the best rushing performance in the PFL since 2014 (Dayton's Connor Kacsor, 301 yards) and was only 29 yards shy of the PFL record set in 1996.

**EAGLE'S BENNETT TACKLES 20** | Morehead State Ryan Bennett was credited with 20 tackles in the Week 8 contest against Jacksonville, becoming the first PFL defender with 20 tackles since 2015 (Drake's John Hugunin, 20 tackles).

**CHRISTIAN ENDS LONG 200-YARD RECEIVER DROUGHT** | Marist wideout Justin Christian's 212-yard outing against Morehead State ended a long drought between 200-yard receivers in the PFL. The drought had reached 763 days dating back to Davidson's William Morris, who amassed 208 receiving yards on Sept. 13, 2014. It is the second longest drought between 200-yard receiving efforts in the league, reaching just over halfway the 1,477-day drought from 2008-12.

**MOREHEAD STATE'S HUTCHINSON NAMED FCS CHAIRMAN** | Morehead State Director of Athletics Brian Hutchinson will serve as chair of the Division I Football Championship Committee in 2016-17. Hutchinson, who has served as Morehead State's director of athletics since 2004, is in his fourth year on this national committee, and becomes the first Pioneer Football League athletic director to serve as chair.

**THREE PFL ALUMNI BEGIN 2016 ON NFL ACTIVE ROSTERS** | A trio of Pioneer Football League alumni began the 2016 NFL season on active rosters. Marist alumni Terrence Fede (Miami Dolphins) and Jason Myers (Jacksonville Jaguars) and San Diego alumnus Josh Johnson (New York Giants) each continued their professional careers. In addition, Jacksonville alumnus Andy Jones was a member of the Dallas Cowboys practice squad.

**STETSON'S PAYNE NAMED TO STATS FCS DEFENSIVE AWARD WATCH LIST** | Stetson senior defensive back Donald Payne was one of 22 players named to the STATS FCS Defensive Player of the Year Watch List. Payne, the two-time defending PFL Defensive Player of the Year, returns as the eighth leading tackler in all NCAA football with 412 career tackles. His 243 career solo tackles ranks third among all active players entering the 2016 season.

**MOREHEAD STATE'S GAHAFFER TAPPED FOR STATS FCS OFFENSIVE AWARD WATCH LIST** | Morehead State senior quarterback Austin Gahafer has been listed on the STATS FCS National Preseason Offensive Player of the Year Watch List. The Louisville, Ky., native is coming off a prolific 2015 season when he was named Pioneer Football League Offensive Player of the Year. Gahafer needs only 1,738 passing yards to set the Morehead State career record and just 2,717 yards to break the PFL career mark.

**DAYTON'S WILL NAMED TO FRED MITCHELL AWARD WATCH LIST** | Dayton senior placekicker William Will has been named to the Watch List for the Fred Mitchell Award, which goes to the top kicking specialist at the FCS, NCAA Division II, Division III and NAIA levels. It is the third straight season Will has been named to the Mitchell Watch List. A two-time First Team All-PFL pick, Will's 84 points were the most in the PFL last season. He also led the league in field goals per game (1.42), field goal percentage (73.9% (17 of 23) and was one of three kickers in the PFL who was perfect on PAT's (33 of 33).

**THREE NAMED TO STATS FCS PRESEASON ALL-AMERICA SQUADS** | Three Pioneer Football League student athletes were among the 100 named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Team. Drake senior tight end Eric Saubert, Stetson senior defensive back Donald Payne and Dayton junior return specialist Christian Searles were the Pioneer Football League student-athletes named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Teams.

**FIVE PFL ATHLETES NOMINATED FOR 2015 ALLSTATE AFCA GOOD WORKS TEAM** | Five Pioneer Football League student-athletes were among 165 nominees from across the country for the 25th edition of the Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®. Sean Horan (Butler), Nate Casey (Davidson), Taylor Coleman (Drake), Cameron Gibson (Marist) and Devyn Bryant (San Diego) were nominated for the 2016 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team®. In order to meet the criteria set forth by Allstate and the AFCA, each player must be actively involved with a charitable organization or service group while maintaining a strong academic standing.

**2015 PLAYERS OF THE YEAR RETURN** | For the second consecutive season both of the league's Players of the Year return. Stetson safety Donald Payne, a two-time PFL Defensive Player of the Year, returns after finishing second among all PFL defenders in tackles per game (11.5) and tackles for loss per game (1.36). Morehead State quarterback Austin Gahafer, the reigning PFL Offensive Player of the Year, led the league with 291 completed passes for 3,244 yards and 24 touchdowns last season.

**SAN DIEGO PICKED TO WIN PFL** | Defending champion San Diego again received the coaches' nod to win the 2015 PFL title, but the coaches also predicted an exciting race. The top three teams in the preseason poll were separated by just three points. San Diego received seven of a possible 10 first-place votes and 89 of a maximum 100 points as coaches were not allowed to vote for their own team in the poll. Dayton received three first-place votes and was ranked second with 87 points. Drake gained the remaining first-place vote and was third with 86 points.

**PFL's 24th CAMPAIGN** | The 2016 season marks the 24th year for the Pioneer Football League – the nation's only non-scholarship, football-only NCAA Football Championship Subdivision conference. The league will feature 11 teams each playing an eight-game schedule to determine the league champion and recipient of the automatic bid to the 2016 NCAA FCS Championship.
