FIRST DOWN #FINFACTS

- Jacksonville is in its 19th season and first under new Head Coach Ian Shields
- The Dolphins matched a program-best with 433 rushing yards last week at Morehead State
- In @PFLNews games, JU is first in pass defense (174 ypg), and second in rushing offense (231.3 ypg)
- Jacksonville is third in the nation in yards-per-completion (17.40)
- The Dolphins lead the @PFLNews and are sixth in the @FCS_STATS with nine fumble recoveries
- Jacksonville has converted 13 turnovers into 54 points
- Jacksonville is eighth in the nation and second in the @PFLNews in kickoff return defense averaging 16.20 yards-per-return
- **Prince Gray** leads the @FCS_STATS with 21.8 yards-per-punt return

CRADLING THE 'CATS

- Jacksonville leads the series vs. Davidson, 12-6, and has won the last seven meetings since a 27-21 home victory on 10/03/09
- The Dolphins have exploded offensively in the last three contests, scoring 56, 56, and 42 points in those games
- Last season, Rylan Wells completed 18 of 24 passes for 318 yards and four touchdowns in an effort off the bench for injured Kade Bell. Grady Redding paced the defense with 12 solo tackles
- The last game at Davidson on 11/8/14 was a complete Dolphin domination. JU scored 21 points in each of the first two quarters and compiled 702 yards of total offense in a 56-0 shutout

PREVIOUSLY...

A record-tying rushing attack and three second half turnovers by the Jacksonville University defense and lifted the Dolphins to a wild, 61-49 victory against Morehead State Saturday at Jayne Stadium.

Jacksonville tied its program-record with 433 rushing yards, and the 61 points were tied for the fourth-most in Dolphin history. Jared Morris led JU with career-bests in 19 carries for 93 yards and a score. Rylan Wells was 13-21 with 165 yards and two touchdowns, and Prince Gray caught five passes for a score and had a 70-yard punt return for a score. Grady Redding led the Dolphins with 10 tackles and scored on an interception.

CAREER DAYS IN KENTUCKY

- Last week's game at Morehead State was a career day for numerous Dolphins
- Grady Redding had his first pick-six, Prince Gray took his first and longest punt return to the house, marking the first time JU has scored twice on non-offensive touchdowns since 10/22/11 in the same combination. A Lacy McDougald pick-six and D'Andre Randle punt return led to a dominating 56-13 home win vs. Davidson
- Jared Morris (93), Jake Brito (88), and **Pernell Rattray** (74) set career-bests in rushing against the Eagles
- **KJ Jenkins** (8) **Austin Yeloushan** (4) and **Griffin Garland** (4) set personal bests in stops
- **Brian Burnett**'s five receptions matched his career-best

FRESHMEN 15 ... OR 50

- Jacksonville welcomed 46 freshmen, and 50 newcomers in total to its 2016 roster
- 33 hail from Florida, five from Georgia, three from South Carolina, two from Texas, and one each from Alabama, Arkansas, California, Guam, Maryland, North Carolina, and Virginia
- Kicker **Arce-Ramirez** is second amongst PFL freshmen in field goals (4-5)
- **Caysaun Wakeley** is third in PFL freshmen in tackles (3.7 per-game) and sacks (2), and fifth in TFL (3)
- **Jared Morris** is fifth in the frosh with 149 rushing yards

JOB WELLS DONE

- Redshirt-junior quarterback **Rylan Wells** started the final two games of 2015 and went a combined 26-46, 395 yards, and 2 TD
- Threw for 126 yards on an 11-19 day in season opener vs. Liberty, but had two interceptions
- Went 0-5 in first half vs. EWC, but a perfect 4-4 for 187 yards and two TD, including a 78-yarder, in the third quarter
- Started en fuego at Stetson, when he went 8-of-13 for 189 yards and two scores in the first half, and finished 10-16 for 203 yards
- Continued a streak off three-straight games without a pick vs. Duquesne, and his two interceptions are lowest in the PFL
- Int streak came to a close with three against Dayton, but passed for a season-long 78-yarder to Pernell Rattray
- Bounced back with two TD, no picks, and 165 yards on 13 completions at Morehead State. Season-best 62 rushing yards in win, too
- The quarterback brings strong bloodlines to the Dolphins ... his College Football Hall of Fame grandfather is former Tennessee and Florida head coach Doug Dickey

DEFENSE IS GRADYFUL

- Senior middle linebacker **Grady Redding** returns to lead the Dolphin defense and with each tackle, adds to his total as the JU all-time leader
- Has also been named First Team All-PFL in those seasons
- His 2015 season-high was 16 tackles at Campbell, and he had six games of double-digit tackles
- Led Jacksonville with 14 tackles vs. Liberty, and topped the 'fins with eight vs. EWC
- Had seven tackles (five solo) and a fumble recovery at Stetson
- Led the Dolphins with 10 tackles, seven solo, vs. Duquesne
- Again topped JU with 12 tackles against Dayton
- His 10 tackles bested the Dolphins' efforts at Morehead State, and had his first career pick-six

ANDY AND THE 'BOYS

- Former JU wide out Andy Jones ('15) was given the largest signing bonus of an undrafted free agent by the Cowboys this offseason. He made a name for himself in training camp and has been signed to the practice squad as the only active JU alum in the NFL
- In the preseason, Jones caught six passes for 50 yards, played special teams, and made four tackles

GOING BACK TO BACK

- The Dolphins finished +9 in turnovers in 2014, which tied for 14th in the country. JU ended last year +7, good for third in the PFL
- In 2014, the Dolphins led the country in picks with 24 and forced 30 turnovers. JU finished the 2015 regular season tied for the FCS lead with Dayton with 20 picks
- After committing five turnovers and not forcing one against Dayton, the Dolphins ended a streak of six consecutive games with a turnover
- The Dolphins are +1 on the season in turnovers, ranking fifth in the PFL

EFFICIENCY ENGINE

- The Dolphins are averaging one sack allowed-per-game, which is 14th in the nation
- The JU offense second in the PFL in passing efficiency with a 133.34 rating
- Jacksonville has cleaned up its dirty laundry so far this season. After ranking at the bottom of the PFL in penalties the last two seasons, the Dolphins have committed only 40 penalties, ranking third in the conference

HEAD COACH

Tabbed as the third head football coach in Jacksonville University history, Ian Shields began his Dolphin tenure in November of 2015.

As the former head coach at Lenoir-Rhyne, where Shields spent two seasons, he compiled a 17-6 record, won a conference championship, was named the South Atlantic Conference Coach of the Year, and twice had his offense lead the nation in rushing.

In the 2015 season, the Bears finished 6-5 (5-5 SAC), had six players named all-conference, and saw All-American offensive lineman Joe Ray named a finalist for the Gene Upshaw Trophy as the top lineman in Division II. Ray also won the Jacobs Trophy as the top lineman in the South Atlantic Conference.

In the last graded semester, the football team had 50 players achieve a grade point average above a 3.0 with 18 boasting a 3.5 or higher.

Shields' first year at Lenoir-Rhyne featured an 11-1 record. Finishing 7-0 in conference play, the program put together its first perfect conference season in 52 years while also setting an NCAA Division II single-season record for rushing yards (416.2 YPG) behind a spread-option attack.

Ranked as high as third in the country, the Bears won their fourth straight league title, earned the top seed in Super Region No. 2 for the second straight season and garnered a No. 8 final national ranking in the AFCA NCAA Division II Coaches Poll.

Seven Bears earned some form of All-American honors after the 2014 season while Shields was named the SAC Coach of the Year. Shields coached two of Lenoir-Rhyne's most decorated players in school history, Ray and linebacker Tanner Botts, a pair of first-team All-Americans.

Prior to Lenoir-Rhyne, Shields spent five seasons as the associate head coach and offensive coordinator at Army (2009-13).

Under Shields, Army produced one of the most prolific rushing attacks not only in West Point history, but in the nation. Army's offense topped the NCAA Division I rushing list in both 2011 and 2012, the first time the Black Knights led the country in that category in consecutive seasons since Col. Earl "Red" Blaik led the 1944 and 1945 squads.

The 2012 team set Academy records for both total rushing yards (4,438) and rushing yards per game (369.8 ypg). The 2011 squad was the first in Academy history to crack the 4,000-yard mark (4,158).

Under Shields, the 2012 team set an Army record with 5,235 yards of total offense which was the first 5,000-yard season in school history. The Black Knights' 436.2 yards-per-game average ranked fourth on the Army all-time ledger. The 2011 squad also recorded 254 first downs, a short-lived Army record as the 2012 Black Knights moved the chains 283 times.

With Shields' guidance offensively, Army never ranked lower than 16th in the nation in rushing, producing three top-five finishes.

Shields also coached Trent Steelman (2009-12), one of the most prolific players in school history. Steelman set Army records in rushing attempts (772), rushing yards (3,320) and 100-yard rushing games (12) by a quarterback. Steelman also broke the school record for career rushing touchdowns (45) and became the first Black Knight to both rush and pass for 2,000 yards in a career.

Shields was also part of a staff that led Army to its first bowl victory in 25 years in 2010, a win over SMU in the Armed Forces Bowl.

Prior to Army, Shields served as the offensive coordinator and assistant head coach at Cal Poly, Eastern Oregon University and St. Mary's.
