THE MATCH-UP: Marist hosts Davidson as part of Homecoming & Reunion Weekend. The Red Foxes are looking for their fourth straight win. Kickoff is set for 12:05 p.m. EDT.

HOW TO FOLLOW US: Geoff Brault (play-by-play) and Ed Weir (color) will provide the call on Z-93 (93.3 FM) in the Hudson Valley. The pregame show will begin at 11:45 a.m. The game can also be listened to for free on the Red Fox Network and iHeartRadio, and can be seen on the Red Fox Network for a subscription fee. For game updates, please check the official Twitter accounts of Marist Athletics (@MaristAthletics) and Marist Football (@Marist_Football).

MARIST IN THE NFL: Two former Marist football players are currently playing in the NFL. DE **Terrence Fede** (2009-13) was the first former Marist football player taken in the NFL Draft when he was chosen in the seventh round by the Miami Dolphins, and is in his third season with them. K **Jason Myers** (2009-12) was signed as a free agent by the Jacksonville Jaguars in March of 2015, and is in his second season with them.

RECOGNITION: Red-shirt sophomore QB **Mike White** is the reigning PFL Offensive Player of the Week (totals of 6 touchdowns/413 yards at Morehead State), and sophomore WR **Juston Christian** was named Honorable Mention FCS Offensive Player of the Week (6 receptions/217 receiving yards/3 touchdowns at Morehead State).

ABOUT DAVIDSON: Three of the four Wildcats' PFL games have been decided by four points or less. **Boo Jordan** leads the PFL with six sacks. Head coach **Paul Nichols**, a 2003 Davidson graduate, is in his fourth season as the team's head coach.

OUR LEADERS: The Marist football team has four captains for the 2016 season. They are fifth-year senior S **Mike Marston**, red-shirt junior LB **Jimmy Braun**, red-shirt junior RB **Marcellus Calhoun** and senior CB **Cameron Gibson**. All are in their first year as captains.

UP NEXT: Marist hosts San Diego on Saturday, Oct. 29. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m. The first 1,000 fans will receive a bobblehead of Jason Mvers, who will be in attendance.

Head Coach Jim Parady 25th Season Career Record: 127-129-1 Maine/1983

Jim Parady, who has guided the Marist football program through nearly a quarter-century of growth, is in his 25th season as the program's head coach and 26th overall with the Red Foxes.

Entering the 2016 season with 124 victories, Parady is the winningest coach in program history. He has made Marist a force to be reckoned with at the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), formerly known as I-AA, level. During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field. The Red Foxes have made the jump from Division III to FCS status, moved into a newly-renovated stadium, won four league championships and joined the Pioneer Football League on Parady's watch. Three former Marist football players have signed contracts with NFL teams since 2013. In 2014, the Miami Dolphins' Terrence Fede became the first former Marist football player to appear in an NFL game. Former Marist kicker Jason Myers became the Jacksonville Jaguars' kicker in 2015. On Sept. 20, 2015, the first NFL games with Marist graduates on each team took place when Miami played at Jacksonville.

In his tenure as head coach, Parady has posted a 127-129-1 record, including 11 winning seasons. The Red Foxes won the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championship in 1994, 2006 and 2007, and the Pioneer Football League championship in 2013.

The 2015 season included explosive offensive play and a four-game winning streak following a 1-4 start. Sophomore Mike White made his first career start in the season's third game, and finished with 2,564 passing yards (the second-highest single-season total in program history) and 14 touchdowns. Senior wide receiver Matt Tralli broke the program record for career receptions, finishing his career with 202. A total of six Red Foxes were either named First or Second Team All-PFL, and 10 more were named Honorable Mention All-PFL.

A native of Nashua, N.H., Parady attended the University of Maine, earning a bachelor's degree in education in 1983. He was a four-year member of the football team as a quarterback and earned two varsity letters.

Parady and his wife, Kristen, reside in Poughkeepsie with their two children, Sarah Jane and Brett Kenneth. Sarah is a senior at Marist.

Series & Schedule

- This the eighth meeting between Marist and Davidson all-time. The Red Foxes lead the series, 7-1, and have won the last five contests.
- Dating back to last season, Marist has won six straight games in October.
- Marist is 11-3 in October the last four years.

PFL

- Marist was picked sixth in this year's PFL preseason poll, while Davidson was picked 11th. The Red Foxes have never been picked to finish in the PFL's top five, but they have finished fifth or better four times.
- Marist is 31-28 all-time in PFL play (15-15 home, 16-13 road). The Red Foxes have finished at least .500 in the PFL for three straight years, and won a share of the league championship in 2013.

Key Stats/Trends

- This is first time Marist has started 3-0 in the PFL in program history.
- Marist has won 12 straight when scoring over 30 points, a streak that dates back to 2013.
- In its season opener against Bucknell, Marist committed six turnovers and was minus-5 in turnover ratio. In their last five games, the Red Foxes have committed just three turnovers and are plus-6 in turnover ratio.
- Marist has 948 total yards (770 passing, 178 rushing) in its last two games, including a season-high 500 at Morehead State.
- Marist has intercepted a pass in every game this season, and has seven interceptions in its last three games.
- For the season, Marist has committed 19 fewer penalties than its opponents, and has been penalized for 240 fewer yards.

Ten Years at Tenney

- This season marks Marist's 10th at Tenney Stadium. The Red Foxes' first game there took place on Oct. 6, 2007 against Duquesne, a 31-21 defeat.
- Marist is 22-29 at Tenney Stadium. The Red Foxes are 18-19 in day games, and 4-10 at night. They are 16-16 in league games & 6-13 in non-league games.
- Marist has had 11 crowds of 3,000 or larger. The largest is 4,721 for the stadium's first football game vs. Duquesne on Oct. 6, 2007.
- Marist has drawn two crowds of over 3,000 (3,363 vs. Bucknell, 3,171 vs. Campbell) in a season for the first time since 2011.

FCS Rankings

- The Red Foxes are ranked in the top 20 of the FCS in the following categories: pass efficiency defense (6th, 98.95), passes intercepted (7th, 10), yards per completion (10th, 15.23) and passing offense (18th, 281.8).
- Individually, the following Red Foxes rank in the nation's top 20: Mike White, passing yards/completion (5th, 15.4), total offense (10th, 298.5), passing yards/game (13th, 279.8), passing yards (14th, 1,679); Juston Christian, yards/reception (3rd, 22.7), receiving yards/game (8th, 109.8), receiving yards (9th, 659), receiving touchdowns (14th, 6); Mike Maccarone, field goals per game (7th, 1.5); and Wesley Beans and Jordyn Jean-Felix, interceptions per game (T-14th, 0.5),
