

- Davidson (2-5, 0-4 PFL) heads on their penultimate road trip of the season when they travel to Drake University for a battle with the Bulldogs (4-3, 3-1 PFL). Kickoff off from Drake Stadium is slated for 2 p.m.
 - The 'Cats are 29-76 (.276) all-time in PFL play.
- It is the ninth meeting all-time between the two dating back to the first contest in 2005. Drake leads the all-time series 7-1. Davidson is 0-4 all-time in Des Moines.
 - The two last met in 2014 in Des Moines, a 51-14 Bulldog victory.
 - Davidson's lone win over the Bulldogs came 10 years ago at Richardson Stadium, 24-21.
- The last league win for Davidson came over Stetson in the finale of the 2015 season, a 20-17 road victory.

QUICK HITS

Head Coach

- Freshman running back Wesley Dugger was named to the STATS FCS Jerry Rice Award Watch List. Dugger leads the PFL in yards-per-game (103.0) and is second in total yards (721), behind only Dayton senior Tucker Yinger.
- Through seven games the Wildcats have yet to record an interception. Davidson finished third in the PFL in picks a season ago with 11.
- 16 of the Wildcats 18 touchdowns have come from freshman or sophomore's. Senior Kahleel Shaw rushed for a touchdown in the opener
- Senior kicker Trevor Smith made three field goals in a game for the second time in his career last Saturday against Dayton. Smith knocked through kicks of 40, 26, and 18 yards, finishing with 10 points for the game, tying his career high.
- Senior quarterback Taylor Mitchell ranks ninth on the all-time completions list with 286. Mitchell needs just 13 completions to pass David Harper '75, for eighth.
- Mitchell is up for the National Football Foundation National Scholar Athlete Award presented by Fidelity Investments. On Wednesday, Sept. 27 it was released he is one of 181 semifinalists across all divisions (FBS, FCS, DII, DIII and NAIA). The senior economics major is a three-time PFL Academic honor roll recipient.
- Second-year quarterback Stockton McGuire returns as the reigning PFL Freshman Offensive Player of the Year.

LAST TIME OUT

Nearing the end of the opening half down just 14-12 Davidson looked very much in the ballgame, but a late Dayton touchdown swung momentum in the Flyers favor as the Wildcats struggled in the second half of a 48-22 home loss. Freshman quarterback Tyler Phelps completed 18-of-39 passes for 190 yards, throwing and rushing for a touchdown in the losing effort, while also throwing an interception returned for a TD. Freshman running back Wesley Dugger had 19 carries for 86 yards, while sophomore James Story had his best day in the backfield, churning out 76 yards in 14 carries.

#TRENDINGNOW

Freshman running back Wesley Dugger was named to the STATS FCS Jerry Rice Award Watch List Wednesday. Dugger leads the PFL in yards-per-game (103.0) and is second in total yards (721), behind only Dayton senior Tucker Yinger. The Jerry Rice Award is handed out at the end of the season to the most outstanding freshman player in NCAA Division I FCS. Joining Dugger on the watch list from the PFL is fellow running back Daniel Smith of Campbell.

STACKING UP IN THE FCS

Dugger remains sixth in the nation in rushing yards per game (103.0) and eighth in total rushing yards (721). Sophomore defensive tackle Bryce Perry-Martin is tied for 16th in tackles for loss per game (1.6).

HONORARY CAPTAIN

For the second consecutive week a Davidson Hall of Famer stands in as the honorary captain. This week, 2016 Hall of Fame inductee, Dave Fagg '58. Fagg won the Tommy Peters Award as the top athlete in 1958, while captaining both the football and wrestling teams. After serving five seasons as an assistant under Homer Smith including the 1969 Tangerine Bowl season, Fagg became the 20th head coach in program history a year later. Fagg left for jobs at Hawaii, Georgia Tech, South Carolina and Arizona before returning to his alma mater in 1990. Hendrix was given the Hendrix Award in 2009 which goes to the Davidson football letterman who has gone on to achieve outstanding success in his chosen profession.

LAST TIME THEY MET

The Bulldogs jumped out to a 37-0 lead in the third quarter and crusied to a 51-14 home win at Drake Stadium on Oct. 11, 2014. John Cook and Taylor Mitchell combined for 132 passing yards, while Jeffrey Keil rushed and caught a touchdown pass in the losing effort. Drake quarterback Andy Rice completed 11-of-15 passes for 216 yards and three touchdown. Tailback Conley Wilkins rushed for 110 yards on 13 carries and three scores, while two of M. Denning's four catches went for scores as he led the way with 125 receiving yards.

NEW ADDITIONS TO THE STAFF

Paul Nichols added four new coaches to the fold, two on each side of the ball. Hank Hughes (Springfield, '79) boasts an impressive resume having worked at the FBS level for 20 years. He most recently worked as defensive line coach for Nebraska in 2015. With an extended stay at the University of Connecticut from 2001-13, Hughes helped lead the Huskies to five bowl games and the 2012 team to a ninth place rank in the country in total defense and seventh against the run. Jeff McDaniels '14 returns to his alma as cornerbacks coach. McDaniels comes back after spending two seasons with Texas State University working with offensive skill players and special teams.

On the offensive side, Laymarr Marshall (Duke, '98) will coach the running backs. Marshall spent the last 18 seasons at Mt. Tabor High School where he was head coach since 2008. While at Duke, Marshall earned Academic All-ACC honors in 1995 and was a three-year starter at running back. Tim Zetts (Akron, '09) will serve as co-offensive coordinator and QBs coach. Zetts spent the last two seasons at John Carroll where he was named interim head coach last season to go with his offensive coordinator duties.

Fifth Season Davidson, 2003

Paul Nichols '03 is in his fifth season as the head coach of his alma mater.

He was named to the post by Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Dec. 21, 2012, and is the program's 27th head coach.

In 2016, the Wildcats opened with a 2-1 start and finished 2-9 overall. The program earned seven All-PFL team members, landed the Pioneer Football League Offensive Freshman of the Year, Stockton McGuire, and Academic All-Conference honoree, John Cook.

The 2016 season also gave Nichols his second Allstate AFCA Good Works Team member, linebacker Nate Casey, who was honored at the 2017 Allstate Sugar Bowl. His first Good Works honoree came in 2014 when Nate's brother, Matt Casey, earned the distinction. Davidson has boasted three selections in all, the first coming in 2010.

In the 2014 and '15 seasons the squad was led by two-time All-PFL first teamer William Morris. Morris remains Davidson's all-time leader in

career reception yards (3,200), career receptions (237) and single-season reception yards record (1,224 - 2014)

In Nichols' first season, the Wildcats were led by Matt Casey on the All-PFL team, had three representatives on the Academic All-PFL team, and 39 players were named to the PFL Academic Honor Roll. Additionally, Morris ranked ninth in the nation in receiving yards per game and Nichols' punt return defense ranked fourth in the nation.

In 2012, Nichols served as the director of player personnel at Illinois. In that position, he coordinated on-campus recruiting efforts and relations with high school coaches, among other duties, for former head coach Tim Beckman and the Fighting Illini staff.

Prior to his time at Illinois, Nichols spent three seasons on Beckman's staff at Toledo as co-defensive coordinator/safeties coach, where he played a vital role in the transformation of the Rockets' defense.

In 2011, Nichols helped guide the Rockets to a 9-4 record and a win over Air Force in the Military Bowl. Toledo was 7-1 in the MAC and shared the West Division title. Defensively, the Rockets forced 30 turnovers on the season (ranking 16th nationally) and ranked third nationally in turnover margin (+1.23). In 2010, UT increased its forced turnovers from 21 to 34, the fifth-highest takeaway total in the nation, as the Rockets made their first bowl appearance in five years.

Before making his way to Toledo, Nichols served as an assistant at Marshall University for three seasons, where he coached All-Conference USA safety Curtis Keyes (2006) and All-Freshman cornerback Zearrick Matthews (2006).

Prior to his tenure at Marshall, Nichols completed two seasons as a graduate assistant at Ohio State from 2004-05 where he assisted with the defensive backs and defensive line. A native of Dunwoody, Ga., Nichols graduated from Davidson College in 2003 with bachelor's degrees in political science and history. Nichols was a first-team All-Pioneer League and a first-team Pioneer League All-Academic selection as a senior, and was named honorable mention All-America by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

In 2000, he quarterbacked Davidson to its first-and-only undefeated season.

Nichols departed as the school record holder for career passing yards (5,822), completions (465) and touchdown passes (51), and compiled a 22-6 record as a starting quarterback. After seeing limited action as a freshman, Nichols won the starting job prior to his sophomore year and guided the 'Cats to a 10-0 season. His junior year was cut short by a knee injury, but Nichols bounced back as a senior and matched the school record for touchdown passes in a single season with 25.

Nichols now ranks third in passing yards and completions after being surpassed by Ryan Alexander '08 and Jonathan Carkhuff '14. He is also now second to Alexander in career passing touchdowns, with Carkhuff needing just six more touchdown passes to move past Nichols in that category.

Nichols is the first Davidson alumnus to guide the football program on a full-time basis since Dave Fagg '58, who finished his second coaching stint with the Wildcats following the 1992 season. He joins Matt Spear '93 (men's soccer) as the only other Davidson alum currently serving as a head coach at Davidson.

Nichols and his wife, the former Lauran Lightmas, a 2004 graduate of Davidson, have two sons, Drew and lack
