THE GAMI

- Davidson (2-2, 0-1 PFL) begins a two-game PFL road trip when they travel to Jacksonville (3-1, 1-0 PFL) Saturday for a 1 p.m. dual with the Dolphins.
 - The 'Cats are 29-73 (.284) all-time in PFL play.
- It is the 20th meeting all-time between the two since the first meeting in 1998. The pair have squared off every year since '98 with the last Wildcat win coming in 2008, a 38-35 victory at Richardson Stadium.
- Jacksonville enters the game leading the PFL in three categories, scoring offense (40.8), total offense (453.5) and rush offense (318.2).

OUICK HITS

- Davidson has 12 players from the Sunshine State including two 'Cats from Jacksonville. Sophomore running back Keylan Brown went to Oakleaf High School, while freshman wide receiver Pat Tabor attended Atlantic Coast High in Jacksonville.
- •Through 48 attempts, freshman quarterback Tyler Phelps has completed 30 passes and thrown for three scores without throwing an interception.
- Senior quarterback Taylor Mitchell ranks ninth on the all-time completions list with 286. Mitchell needs just 13 completions to pass David Harper '75, for eighth.
- Mitchell is up for the National Football Foundation National Scholar Athlete Award presented by Fidelity Investments. On Wednesday, Sept. 27 it was released he is one of 181 semifinalists across all divisions (FBS, FCS, DII, DIII and NAIA). The senior economics major is a three-time PFL Academic honor roll recipient.
- Second-year quarterback Stockton McGuire returns as the reigning PFL Freshman Offensive Player of the Year.
- Davidson welcomed 34 members to the Class of 2021; 17 are listed on offense, 16 on defense and one special teamer.
- The Wildcats' have 19 seniors; eight on offense, seven on defense and three special teamers. The Class of 2017 was also 19 deep.

LAST TIME OUT

Senior kicker Trevor Smith knocked down all three of his field goal attempts, but Davidson fell in their PFL opener against Marist at Richardson Stadium, 31-9. The Red Foxes capitalized off three Wildcat turnovers, scoring a touchdown off each blunder. Davidson sophomore quarterback Stockton McGuire completed 18-of-39 passes for 201 yards and an interception. The 'Cats kept up with the youth movement as rookie running back Wesley Dugger led the ground assault, 16 carries for 54 yards, and classmate Pat Tabor caught a team-high five passes for 78 yards.

STACKING UP IN THE FCS

Freshman running back Wesley Dugger ranks 12th in the nation in yards-per-game (107.8) and 14th in total yards (431). Sophomore defensive end Bryce Perry-Martin checks in in a tie for 24th with 6.5 tackles-for-loss.

CAN HE KICK IT? ... YES HE CAN!

Connecting on all 12 of his point after attempts this season, senior kicker Trevor Smith moved into second all-time in PAT's with 78. Smith is 78-of-82 in his career and trails only Daniel Hanks (109).

HONORARY CAPTAIN

This week's honorary captain is Ray Sinclair'82. Sinclair was one of the premier backs to play for the Wildcats. He holds the highest season rushing total of all-time (1,339) and the best ever game (260). His career 3,085 yards rank second in program history, behind only John Leverett (3,165). Sinclair went on to sign a free agent contract with the Seattle Seahawks in 1982.

LAST TIME THEY MET

Davidson wide receiver Jaris Scott had a career day, catching six passes for 190 yards, inlcuding a 73-yard touchdown in a 35-17 losing effort at Richardson Stadium. Stockton McGuire completed nearly half of his passes to Scott, finishing 13-of-29 for 225 yards with a TD and an interception thrown. The Wildcats trailed just 14-10 at the break, but a 21-point third quarter effort for the Dolphins, including a 38-yard scoring grab for Brian Burnett as time expired in the frame to put the game out of reach. JU quarterback Rylan Wells completed 13-of-19 passes for 211 yards and a TD, while rushing 12 times for 110 yards and two more scores. Davidson linebacker George Hatalowich made a career-best 11 tackles, eight of them solo stops.

ANOTHER ONE

For the fourth consecutive year, Davidson football earned an Allstate AFCA Good Works Team nominee. Senior linebacker Ryan Samuel joins Matt Casey, Chris Woods and Nate Casey in succession and looks to become the fourth Good Works Team member all-time with the Wildcats. The team will be announced in early September.

NEW ADDITIONS TO THE STAFF

Paul Nichols added four new coaches to the fold, two on each side of the ball. Hank Hughes (Springfield, '79) boasts an impressive resume having worked at the FBS level for 20 years. He most recently worked as defensive line coach for Nebraska in 2015. With an extended stay at the University of Connecticut from 2001-13, Hughes helped lead the Huskies to five bowl games and the 2012 team to a ninth place rank in the country in total defense and seventh against the run. Jeff McDaniels '14 returns to his alma as cornerbacks coach. McDaniels comes back after spending two seasons with Texas State University working with offensive skill players and special teams.

On the offensive side, Laymarr Marshall (Duke, '98) will coach the running backs. Marshall spent the last 18 seasons at Mt. Tabor High School where he was head coach since 2008. While at Duke, Marshall earned Academic All-ACC honors in 1995 and was a three-year starter at running back. Tim Zetts (Akron, '09) will serve as co-offensive coordinator and QBs coach. Zetts spent the last two seasons at John Carroll where he was named interim head coach last season to go with his offensive coordinator duties.

Fifth Season Davidson, 2003

Paul Nichols '03 is in his fifth season as the head coach of his alma mater.

He was named to the post by Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Dec. 21, 2012, and is the program's 27th head coach.

In 2016, the Wildcats opened with a 2-1 start and finished 2-9 overall. The program earned seven All-PFL team members, landed the Pioneer Football League Offensive Freshman of the Year, Stockton McGuire, and Academic All-Conference honoree, John Cook.

The 2016 season also gave Nichols his second Allstate AFCA Good Works Team member, linebacker Nate Casey, who was honored at the 2017 Allstate Sugar Bowl. His first Good Works honoree came in 2014 when Nate's brother, Matt Casey, earned the distinction. Davidson has boasted three selections in all, the first coming in 2010.

In the 2014 and '15 seasons the squad was led by two-time All-PFL first teamer William Morris. Morris remains Davidson's all-time leader in

career reception yards (3,200), career receptions (237) and single-season reception yards record (1,224 - 2014).

In Nichols' first season, the Wildcats were led by Matt Casey on the All-PFL team, had three representatives on the Academic All-PFL team, and 39 players were named to the PFL Academic Honor Roll. Additionally, Morris ranked ninth in the nation in receiving yards per game and Nichols' punt return defense ranked fourth in the nation.

In 2012, Nichols served as the director of player personnel at Illinois. In that position, he coordinated oncampus recruiting efforts and relations with high school coaches, among other duties, for former head coach Tim Beckman and the Fighting Illini staff.

Prior to his time at Illinois, Nichols spent three seasons on Beckman's staff at Toledo as co-defensive coordinator/safeties coach, where he played a vital role in the transformation of the Rockets' defense.

In 2011, Nichols helped guide the Rockets to a 9-4 record and a win over Air Force in the Military Bowl. Toledo was 7-1 in the MAC and shared the West Division title. Defensively, the Rockets forced 30 turnovers on the season (ranking 16th nationally) and ranked third nationally in turnover margin (+1.23). In 2010, UT increased its forced turnovers from 21 to 34, the fifth-highest takeaway total in the nation, as the Rockets made their first bowl appearance in five years.

Before making his way to Toledo, Nichols served as an assistant at Marshall University for three seasons, where he coached All-Conference USA safety Curtis Keyes (2006) and All-Freshman cornerback Zearrick Matthews (2006).

Prior to his tenure at Marshall, Nichols completed two seasons as a graduate assistant at Ohio State from 2004-05 where he assisted with the defensive backs and defensive line. A native of Dunwoody, Ga., Nichols graduated from Davidson College in 2003 with bachelor's degrees in political science and history. Nichols was a first-team All-Pioneer League and a first-team Pioneer League All-Academic selection as a senior, and was named honorable mention All-America by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

In 2000, he quarterbacked Davidson to its first-and-only undefeated season.

Nichols departed as the school record holder for career passing yards (5,822), completions (465) and touchdown passes (51), and compiled a 22-6 record as a starting quarterback. After seeing limited action as a freshman, Nichols won the starting job prior to his sophomore year and guided the 'Cats to a 10-0 season. His junior year was cut short by a knee injury, but Nichols bounced back as a senior and matched the school record for touchdown passes in a single season with 25.

Nichols now ranks third in passing yards and completions after being surpassed by Ryan Alexander '08 and Jonathan Carkhuff '14. He is also now second to Alexander in career passing touchdowns, with Carkhuff needing just six more touchdown passes to move past Nichols in that category.

Nichols is the first Davidson alumnus to guide the football program on a full-time basis since Dave Fagg '58, who finished his second coaching stint with the Wildcats following the 1992 season. He joins Matt Spear '93 (men's soccer) as the only other Davidson alum currently serving as a head coach at Davidson.

Nichols and his wife, the former Lauran Lightmas, a 2004 graduate of Davidson, have two sons, Drew and Jack.
