THE GAME

- Davidson hits the road for the first time this season when they head west to Cullowhee, N.C. for a non-conference clash with the Catamounts of Western Carolina University.
- The 'Cats enter Saturday's tilt on a three-game non-conference win streak dating back to last September.
- The meeting between the two in-state foes is the first since 1985.
- WCU leads the all-time series 2-0 after sweeping a home-and-home in the mid '80's.
- The Davidson defense enters Saturday ranked second in NCAA-FCS with -4.0 rushing yards, while WCU put up 482 yards of offense (19th nationally) against Hawai'i.

QUICK HITS

- Freshman running back Wesley Dugger ranks second in NCAA-FCS in rushing yards with 196 - trailing only Cardon Johnson of James Madison (265). Sophomore defensive lineman Bryce Perry-Martin leads the country in tackles for loss (5.0) per game.
- Senior quarterback Taylor Mitchell ranks ninth on the all-time completions list with 278. He needs just 21 completions to pass David Harper for eighth.
- Second-year quarterback Stockton McGuire returns as the reigning PFL Freshman Offensive Player of the Year.
- Davidson ranked fourth in the PFL in interceptions last season with 11. Seven different Wildcat defenders picked off a pass in 2016, but recently graduated Jaylen Mize and Ryan Leak totaled five of the 11 thieveries.
- Senior linebacker Ryan Samuels was nominated for the 2017 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team. The 'Cats have had three Good Works Team members including recent graduate Nate Casey in 2016.
- Davidson welcomed 34 members to the Class of 2021; 17 are listed on offense, 16 on defense and one special teamer.
- The Wildcats' have 19 seniors; eight on offense, seven on defense and three special teamers. The Class of 2017 was also 19 deep.

LAST TIME OUT

Behind 196 yards on the ground from freshman Wesley Dugger and a defense that held Brevard to -4 rushing yards, Davidson downed Brevard in the season opener last week at Richardson Stadium, 30-7. Dugger's debut is the best for a Wildcat running back all-time and ranks eighth in single-game yardage netted. The stout Davidson defensive line, led by Bryce Perry-Martin's 1.5 sacks and 5.0 tackles for loss, sacked Brevard's quarterback four times and registered 18 tackles for loss in all. Rookie receiver Pat Tabor also had a stellar debut, catching five passes for 69 yards including a 56-yard touchdown. Four different Wildcats found the end zone in the win, Tabor through the air, and Dugger, Stockton McGuire and Kahleel Shaw on the ground.

#TRENDINGNOW

Freshman Wesley Dugger posted the best debut by a Davidson running back in program history, rushing for 196 yards on 31 carries and a touchdown. For his efforts, he was selected a STATS FCS National Freshman of the Week honorable mention.

HONORARY CAPTAIN

Serving as honorary captain for the trip to Western Carolina is Bryan Fish '01. Fish was a four-year letterwinner for the 'Cats from 1997-00. In his senior year, Fish broke out for 1,055 rushing yards and seven touchdowns, helping lead the team to an undefeated season. His 256 rushes in 2000 remains the most carries in a single season all-time.

ANOTHER ONE

For the fourth consecutive year, Davidson football earned an Allstate AFCA Good Works Team nominee. Senior linebacker Ryan Samuel joins Matt Casey, Chris Woods and Nate Casey in succession and looks to become the fourth Good Works Team member all-time with the Wildcats. The team will be announced in early September.

BALL SECURITY

Davidson finished the 2016 season third in the PFL in turnover margin (+4). The Wildcats lost only four fumbles on the season and threw 12 interceptions, but picked off 11 passes and recovered nine fumbles. Dayton dominated the league with a +14 TO advantage, while Morehead State finished -10.

NEW ADDITIONS TO THE STAFF

Paul Nichols added four new coaches to the fold, two on each side of the ball. Hank Hughes (Springfield, '79) boasts an impressive resume having worked at the NCAA FBS level for 20 years. He most recently worked as defensive line coach for Nebraska in the Big 10 in 2015. With an extended stay at the University of Connecticut from 2001-13, Hughes helped lead the Huskies to five bowl games and the 2012 team to a ninth place rank in the country in total defense and seventh against the run. Jeff McDaniels (Davidson, '14) returns to his alma as cornerbacks coach. McDaniels comes back after spending two seasons with Texas State University working with offensive skill players and special teams.

On the offensive side, Laymarr Marshall (Duke, '98) will coach the running backs. Marshall spent the last 18 seasons at Mt. Tabor High School where he was head coach since 2008. While at Duke, Marshall earned Academic All-ACC honors in 1995 and was a three-year starter at running back. Tim Zetts (Akron, '09) will serve as co-offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach. Zetts spent the last two seasons at John Carroll University where he was named interim head coach last season to go with his offensive coordinator duties.

Paul Nichols '03 is in his fifth season as the head coach of his alma mater.

He was named to the post by Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Dec. 21, 2012, and is the program's 27th head coach.

In 2016, the Wildcats opened with a 2-1 start and finished 2-9 overall. The program earned seven All-PFL team members, landed the Pioneer Football League Offensive Freshman of the Year, Stockton McGuire, and Academic All-Conference honoree, John Cook.

The 2016 season also gave Nichols his second Allstate AFCA Good Works Team member, linebacker Nate Casey, who was honored at the 2017 Allstate Sugar Bowl. His first Good Works honoree came in 2014 when Nate's brother, Matt Casey, earned the distinction. Davidson has boasted three selections in all, the first coming in 2010.

In the 2014 and '15 seasons the squad was led by two-time All-PFL first teamer William Morris. Morris remains Davidson's all-time leader in career reception yards (3,200), career receptions (237) and single-season reception yards record (1,224 - 2014).

In Nichols' first season, the Wildcats were led by Matt Casey on the All-PFL team, had three representatives on the Academic All-PFL team, and 39 players were named to the PFL Academic Honor Roll. Additionally, Morris ranked ninth in the nation in receiving yards per game and Nichols' punt return defense ranked fourth in the nation.

In 2012, Nichols served as the director of player personnel at Illinois. In that position, he coordinated on-campus recruiting efforts and relations with high school coaches, among other duties, for former head coach Tim Beckman and the Fighting Illini staff.

Prior to his time at Illinois, Nichols spent three seasons on Beckman's staff at Toledo as co-defensive coordinator/safeties coach, where he played a vital role in the transformation of the Rockets' defense.

In 2011, Nichols helped guide the Rockets to a 9-4 record and a win over Air Force in the Military Bowl. Toledo was 7-1 in the MAC and shared the West Division title. Defensively, the Rockets forced 30 turnovers on the season (ranking 16th nationally) and ranked third nationally in turnover margin (+1.23). In 2010, UT increased its forced turnovers from 21 to 34, the fifth-highest takeaway total in the nation, as the Rockets made their first bowl appearance in five years.

Before making his way to Toledo, Nichols served as an assistant at Marshall University for three seasons, where he coached All-Conference USA safety Curtis Keyes (2006) and All-Freshman cornerback Zearrick Matthews (2006).

Prior to his tenure at Marshall, Nichols completed two seasons as a graduate assistant at Ohio State from 2004-05 where he assisted with the defensive backs and defensive line.

A native of Dunwoody, Ga., Nichols graduated from Davidson College in 2003 with bachelor's degrees in political science and history. Nichols was a first-team All-Pioneer League and a first-team Pioneer League All-Academic selection as a senior, and was named honorable mention All-America by Don Hansen's Football Gazette.

In 2000, he quarterbacked Davidson to its first-and-only undefeated season.

Nichols departed as the school record holder for career passing yards (5,822), completions (465) and touchdown passes (51), and compiled a 22-6 record as a starting quarterback. After seeing limited action as a freshman, Nichols won the starting job prior to his sophomore year and guided the 'Cats to a 10-0 season. His junior year was cut short by a knee injury, but Nichols bounced back as a senior and matched the school record for touchdown passes in a single season with 25.

Nichols now ranks third in passing yards and completions after being surpassed by Ryan Alexander '08 and Jonathan Carkhuff '14. He is also now second to Alexander in career passing touchdowns, with Carkhuff needing just six more touchdown passes to move past Nichols in that category.

Nichols is the first Davidson alumnus to guide the football program on a full-time basis since Dave Fagg '58, who finished his second coaching stint with the Wildcats following the 1992 season. He joins Matt Spear '93 (men's soccer) as the only other Davidson alum currently serving as a head coach at Davidson.

Nichols and his wife, the former Lauran Lightmas, a 2004 graduate of Davidson, have two sons, Drew and Jack.
