LAST TIME OUT

Jacksonville handed Campbell its second straight loss, 54-48, in three overtimes in front of a record Homecoming crowd at Barker-Lane Stadium. CU welcomed 6,691 to Buies Creek, a Barker-Lane Stadium record and the third sellout in five home games for the Camels this season.

Three JU backs ran for at least 95 yards, while the Dolphins finished with a 506-453 edge in total offense, including 396 rushing yards.

CU quarterback Daniel Smith ran for 191 yards, the third most rushing yards by a Camel all-time and the most ever by a quarterback, with three touchdowns, including two in extra time. The Leesburg, Va. native added 185 yards through the air, completing 15-of-31 passes with two more scores.

Coming into the game tied for Campbell's single-season passing TDs record, Smith tossed two more to reach 17 on the season. His 17th touchdown pass made Smith, just a redshirt freshman, Campbell's all-time leader for career touchdown passes.

Defensive back Carlos Merritt broke the school modern era single game record for tackles with 20, while Jack Ryan made 16 stops.

CAMPBELL FOOTBALL **BY THE NUMBERS**

- 1 -

Kurt Odom became Campbell's first and only All-American to date in 2013, collecting Third Team honors from the Sports Network at fullback.

- 2 -

The Campbell defense has finished in the top-20 in total defense in each of the last two seasons. After ranking fifth in total defense in 2015, the Camels stood 17th in 2016, allowing only 322.1 yards per game.

- 2 -

Two Campbell Football alumni have signed with NFL teams since the program was brought back in 2008. Both signed in 2015 when defensive tackle Greg Milhouse joined the New York Giants and long snapper Danny Dillon signed with the Arizona Cardinals.

The Camels have posted five wins in each of the last three seasons, tied for the second most victories in a single season in the program's nine years (record 6 in 2011). CU went 5-5 in 2016, notching the program's second season at .500 or better.

- 10 -

Campbell heads into its 10th season of football in 2017 (modern era). The Camels brought football back to the Creek in 2008 after a 58 year hiatus.

- 18 -

Since 2013, Camels have been named All-PFL 18 times, including four last season. From 2008-12, Camels were named all-conference 14 times. Additionally, CU owns 43 honorable mention All-PFL nods since 2013.

- 68 -

Former All-PFL running backs De'Shawn Jones and Jared Joyner combined for 68 percent of the Camels' running game over the last two seasons. The duo ran for 2,739 yards and 30 touchdowns in 2015 and 2016 (4,042 team rush yards). CU will have to look elsewhere for that production in 2017.

- 1,038 -Aaron Blockmon hauled in 1,038 yards receiving in 2016, becoming Campbell's first 1,000 yard receiver. The then redshirt sophomore doubled CU's previous single season marks for yards (previous 497, Jabri Ridenhour, 2014) and touchdowns (previous 5, 3 times) with 10 scores. Heading into his third season, Blockmon is already Campbell's all-time leader in receiving yards (1,491) and receiving touchdowns (15).

categories. His 902 yards rushing are the second most ever by a Camel, trailing only De'Shawn Jones' 2015 total of 1079. He adds seven touchdowns on the ground.

Joshua Jones adds 389 yards and a TD on the ground, while Goods rounds out the three-man rushing attack with 386 yards and seven total scores. Aaron Blockmon owns a team-high 423 yards receiving with five touchdowns.

Ryan owns a team-best 78 tackles, while Emmanuel Olenga has collected a Campbell single-game record 8.5 sacks, and 13.5 total tackles for loss. Merritt owns 75 tackles with five interceptions, scoring a pair of defensive touchdowns. The redshirt senior adds 3.0 tackles for loss and two fumble recoveries.

SCOUTING THE WILDCATS

Davidson has dropped five in a row, all in PFL play, since a 42-21 win over Guilford on September 16.

Wesley Duggar paces Davidson with 801 rushing yards, averaging 100.1 yards per game with four total touchdowns. George Hatalowich tops the DC defense with 53 tackles, including 6.0 stops for loss, adding an interception.

Davidson, Campbell's only in-state PFL foe, is one of three programs the Camels have played in each of their previous nine seasons (Butler, Morehead State). The Camels lead the series 5-4, taking the previous four matchups, including a 28-0 shutout in 2016.

PACKING THE HOUSE

A year after finishing fourth in the country in average attendance capacity, Barker-Lane Stadium is again packed in 2017. The home of the Camels averaged 5,523 fans per game in 2016 (100.42 capacity percentage), and through five games in Buies Creek this season, CU is averaging 5,803 (105.51), good for 10th nationally.

Three of Campbell's five home games have entertained more than capacity crowds, including a school record-best 6,691 fans in CU's Homecoming game against Jacksonville. Since 2013, Barker-Lane Stadium has hosted 13 sellouts.

With one game to go, Campbell is on pace to break its single season total and average attendance record, set just last season (33,138 total, 5,523 average).

NEXT UP

Campbell returns to Barker-Lane Stadium for its 2017 finale, hosting Drake at 1 p.m.

SMITH NAMED TO NATIONAL WATCH LISTS

Campbell quarterback Daniel Smith has been named to the College Football Performance Awards' (CFPA) 2017 midseason watch list for the FCS National Performer of the Year Trophy. Smith is one of 36 from across the FCS on the list.

Smith was named to the STATS Jerry Rice Award watch list last week, awarded annually to the top freshman in FCS. He was also named honorable mention STATS FCS Freshman of the Week for the second time this season following his record setting day against JU.

For the year, Smith has thrown for 1586 yards with 902 yards rushing, leading the Camels in both categories. His 902 yards rushing are the second most ever by a Camel, trailing only De'Shawn Jones' 2015 total of 1079. He adds seven touchdowns on the ground.

With his two TDs passing in Campbell's week nine outing against Jacksonville, he has piled up 17 touchdown tosses on the season, making Smith, just a redshirt freshman, not only Campbell's single-season leader, but its career leader in the category.

In the overtime loss to Jacksonville, Smith ran for 191 yards, the third most rushing yards by a Camel all-time and the most ever by a quarterback, with three touchdowns, including two in extra time. The Leesburg, Va. native added 185 yards through the air, completing 15-of-31 passes with two more scores.

Smith rushed for 43 yards and two touchdowns in overtime alone, adding a 17 yard TD run in the second, and passing for two touchdowns in the third quarter.

He leads the FCS in rush yards per carry (9.36), while ranking second in overall rushing yards in the nation. Smith also stands 10th in the country in total offense per game (310.6) and 19th in passing touchdowns.

The redshirt freshman leads the PFL in points responsible for (144), rushing yards and total offense.

CAMELS EYE PROGRAM HISTORY

At 5-4 overall and 4-2 in PFL play, Campbell has matched itis best start in program history. CU, which has collected five wins in each of the last three seasons, need one more victory to match its all-time high, set in 2011. Another victory also matches the program's high for PFL wins in a season, also set in 2011.

That same season, Campbell won five consecutive games, a record high for the Camels. One more road win would also set a new single season record for the program.

HUTTO STARTS 40TH CAREER GAME

Offensive tackle Josh Hutto started his 40th career game for the Camels at Butler, becoming just the fourth Campbell player to hit the mark. The redshirt senior has started all 40 games he has entered in his career. Hutto joins former defensive tackle Randel Herring (2008-11, 43 starts), center Troy Horan (2008-11, 43) and center Jacob Brewer (2012-15, 42) in the 40 start club. Former defensive end Isaac Scott (2011-14) is the Camels' all-time leader in games played at 46.

CAMELS AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS

In addition to the above mention Daniel Smith ranking among the national leaders in several statistical categories, Carlos Merritt and Emmanuel Olenga rank 11th in fumbles recovered with two each, with Merritt also 14th in interceptions per game with 0.6. Dante Simmons also ranks second in the nation in interceptions per game. Olenga also stands 17th in sacks (0.83 per game) and 20th in tackles for loss (1.5).

Campbell ranks in the top-25 in eight different team defensive categories, leading the country in passes intercepted (18) and turnovers gained (25). CU also ranks second in defensive TDs (4), 20th in scoring defense (19.2), and 25th in total defense (318.8).

CU also ranks in the top-25 in six offensive categories, highlighted by a 14th place showing in scoring (35.6) and rushing (220.9) offense.

CU UNIFORMS FEATURED ON SPORTSCENTER'S "GEAR UP"

Before the Camels took on Dayton on the road, Campbell's new all white uniforms were featured on ESPN's SportsCenter during the show's "Gear Up" segment.

The segment aired Saturday, October 14, just prior to College GameDay. "Gear Up" showcases the best uniforms from around college football throughout the season, hosted by Aaron Dodson of ESPN's The Undefeated.

Also featured on the jersey is a commemorative 10th season patch, celebrating the Camels' 10th season of football, bringing the sport back after a more than 50 year hiatus.

GOODS TABBED NATIONAL FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK

After posted 193 yards rushing and three touchdowns, Campbell's Montel Goods has been named FCS National Freshman of the Week by STATS. Goods helped Campbell down Morehead State 38-0 Saturday, and was named the Pioneer Football League's Offensive Player of the Week.

Making his first career start at running back, Goods' 193 yards stands as the second-highest total in Campbell's Division I era, and the most ever by a Camel at Barker-Lane Stadium. The Pittsboro, N.C. native carried 27 times for 193 yards, averaging 7.1 yards per attempt. In just three career games, Goods has scored six touchdowns, adding 260 yards rushing.

Goods' first TD of the day came from three yards out on the third play of the second quarter, capping a 13-play, 83-yard drive, Mitchell Brown added the PAT and the Camels took a 7-0 lead.

He added a two yard touchdown run in the third, rounding off a 12-play, 77 yard drive to put Campbell up 24-0. Goods' third touchdown of the day – a three-yard run – completed a six-play, 65-yard march in only 1:44 and left CU in front 38-0 with 11:41 left in the game. The three touchdown day marked the 11th time a Camel has reached the endzone at least three times in a single game.

STRYFFELER NAMED NFF CAMPBELL TROPHY SEMIFINALIST

Campbell's Brian Stryffeler is one of 37 Football Championship Subdivision student-athletes to be named a semifinalist for the 2017 William V. Campbell Trophy®, presented by Fidelity Investments®, by The National Football Foundation & College Hall of Fame (NFF).

The award recognizes an individual as the absolute best football scholar-athlete in the nation. In all, 181 football student-athletes have been nominated across all divisions.

An honorable mention All-PFL performer in 2016, Stryffeler earned FCS ADA Academic All-Star team and CoSIDA Academic All-District 3 honors as a redshirt junior. The Sanford, N.C. native was named First Team Academic All-PFL and picked up PFL Academic Honor Roll status for the second straight year.

Former Carolina Panthers standout and Nebraska Football Hall of Famer Mike Minter heads into his fifth season as head football coach at Campbell University in 2017.

In Minter's fourth season at the helm in 2016, Campbell went 5-5 on the year, notching the program's second season at .500 or better in its nine year history, and ranked third in the PFL in rushing offense, standing 19th nationally at 209 yards per game, as well as 17th in the country in total defense (322.1 yards per game). Wide receiver Aaron Blockmon also led the PFL in receiving yards (1,038) and touchdowns (10).

The Camels ranked fifth in the nation in total defense in 2015 (279.3 per game), standing third in team sacks per game (3.55) and ninth in scoring defense (17.7). The team shattered program records for all three categories, adding single season marks for tackles for loss (85.0) and total sacks (38.0). 16 Camels were honored on the conference's All-PFL teams following the 2015 season, with De'Shawn Jones (RB), Ugonna Awuruonye (DL) and Greg Milhouse Jr. (DL) all receiving First Team All-PFL accolades. Jack Ryan was also named PFL Freshman Defensive Player of the Year.

The offseason saw another Campbell first, with defensive tackle Greg Milhouse Jr. (New York Giants) and long snapper Danny Dillon (Arizona Cardinals) both signing NFL contracts.

2014 saw the Camels notch their second-most total and conference wins at 5-7 overall and 4-4 in PFL play. A school record seven Camels, plus eight honorable mentions, were named to the 2014 All-Pioneer Football League teams, including four first teamers. Eight CU student-athletes, with six first team members, were tabbed PFL All-Academic.

In Minter's first season as head coach at CU, the Camels set 21 offensive team records, including rushing yards (2,800), passing yards (2,436), and total offense (5,236). The Camels also established four defensive marks, including sacks (27), and posted three team records on special teams.

Senior Kurt Odom became Campbell's first football All-America selection, earning Third Team honors from the Sports Network. Odom was also named First Team All-PFL while seven Camels took home honorable mention nods. In May 2014, CU quarterback Brian Hudson signed a contract with the Canadian Football League's Calgary Stampeders.

Minter picked up his first win as a collegiate head coach in his home debut as the Camels cruised to a 56-21 triumph over UVA-Wise.

Minter, a member of two national championship teams at Nebraska and the Panthers' 2003 Super Bowl squad, joined the Fighting Camel program after serving as assistant coach at Liberty University in 2012 and Johnson C. Smith University in 2011. He also brought head coaching experience from First Assembly Christian School in Concord, where he guided his teams to 33 victories and two state titles in three seasons.

During his 10-year NFL career, Minter earned a starting safety role six games into his rookie year in 1997, and held that position until he retired after the 2006 season. A second-round draft choice, he helped lead the Panthers to three playoff trips, the 2003 NFC Championship and a berth in Super Bowl XXXVII.

In the Super Bowl against the New England Patriots, Minter suffered a broken left foot in the third quarter, but remained in the game and collected a career-high 18 tackles. At the time of his retirement, he held Panthers franchise records for starts (141), consecutive starts (94), fumble recoveries (11) and interceptions returned for touchdowns (4).

At Liberty, Minter worked as special teams coordinator/assistant defensive coach under head coach Turner Gill. He mentored three 2012 Big South all-conference performers in long snapper Richard Wright, place kicker John Lunsford and punter Grant Bowden. At Johnson C. Smith, Minter servedas as assistant head coach, defensive passing game coordinator and special teams coordinator, JCSU ranked fifth in the nation in punt return yardage in 2011.

Minter was a two-time national champion at Nebraska (1994 and 1995) where he played linebacker, free safety and strong safety for the Cornhuskers. He was a three-time all-conference performer and was inducted into the Nebraska Football Hall of Fame in 2006. He graduated in 1997 with a Bachelor of Science degree in engineering.

Born Jan. 15, 1974, in Cleveland, Ohio, Minter led the State of Oklahoma in rushing yards (1,589) as a senior at Lawton High School in 1991. He was an all-state performer, National Honor Society member and also averaged 21 points per game on the Lawton basketball team.

In addition to playing and coaching football, Minter is CEO of Minter Enterprises, a multi-faceted business impacting real estate development, general contracting and construction, business consultation, publishing, public speaking engagements and a non-profit organization focused on youth development.

Minter and his wife Kim have four children - Michael Jr., Isaiah, McKenna and Brianna.

The NFF will announce 12-14 finalists on Nov. 1, and each of them will receive an \$18,000 postgraduate scholarship as a member of the NFF National Scholar-Athlete Class, presented by Fidelity Investments. The finalists will travel to New York City for the 60th NFF Annual Awards Dinner on Dec. 5, where their accomplishments will be highlighted in front of one of the most powerful audiences in all of sports. Live during the event, one member of the class will be declared as the winner of the 28th William V. Campbell Trophy® and have his postgraduate scholarship increased to \$25,000.

CAMELS NOTCH FIVE TAKEAWAYS AT STETSON

Campbell's defense posted five takeaways in a 49-21 win at Stetson in week four. The Camels turned those five turnovers into 28 points, including a pair of interceptions returned for touchdowns. It was the fifth time in Campbell's 10 seasons of football that the team tallied five or more takeaways, hitting that mark for the first time since 2013 (vs. UVA-Wise 1 FR/4 INT). Campbell's record for takeaways is eight, coming in the program's first ever win at Carthage in 2008 (1 FR / 7 INT). The only other time a Campbell defense posted five or more takeaways in a PFL game was against San Diego in 2011, grabbing six interceptions. The Camels also forced five turnovers against Apprentice in 2011 (3 FR / 2 INT).

Eight Camels scored in 2008 and 2011, the fewest in the program's 10 seasons. Redshirt freshmen Daniel Smith and Montel Goods lead the way with seven scores each.

WAMER HIT GOES VIRAL

In his first game as a Camel, linebacker Michael Wamer made his arrival in the Creek known, delivering the hit of the night against Methodist. The hit was featured on ESPN's SportsCenter with Scott Van Pelt as his "Best available video" segment, then again on SC's Top-10 Plays, checking in at No. 2. SportsCenter's tweet of the hit ("Trucked") has generated more than 11,000 retweets (as of 9/6) and nearly 25,000 likes. Bleacher Report's tweet ("Smacked") added another 8,000-plus retweets and nearly 15,000 likes. The play also made No. 4 on the NCAA's FCS Plays of the Week.

CAMPBELL TO JOIN BIG SOUTH IN 2018

Campbell University will join the Big South Conference as a football member effective the 2018 season. Campbell President J. Bradley Creed made the announcement Monday, Nov. 14, at Gore Arena upon the recommendation of the Board of Trustees.

The University's Board of Trustees unanimously approved the motion for Campbell, already a Big South affiliate in 18 other sports. The Camels will be immediately eligible to compete for the Big South Championship beginning in the fall of 2018.

Current Big South Conference football membership includes core members Charleston Southern University (Charleston, S.C.), Gardner-Webb University (Boiling Springs, N.C.), Liberty University (Lynchburg, Va.) and Presbyterian College (Clinton, S.C.), plus associate football-only institutions Kennesaw State University (Kennesaw, Ga.) and Monmouth University (West Long Branch, N.J.). North Alabama (Florence, Ala.) will join the league as an associate member in 2019.
