

## Davidson College Sports Medicine Summer Drug Testing Contact Form



Every student-athlete who participates in Davidson College athletics is subject to year-round drug testing as mandated by the NCAA. In order to help facilitate communication with you over the summer in the event you are randomly selected, the NCAA requires every student-athlete to complete the NCAA Student-Athlete Summer Contact Form. This form will be filled out through ATS the same way you complete your yearly sports medicine paperwork.

The instructions below will guide you through the process to complete this form.

## \*\*Note DO NOT USE Internet Explorer\*\*

ATS does not operate correctly using the Internet explorer web browser. Open your internet browser (Firefox, Chrome, Safari), clear the address bar, and type in **davidson2.atsusers.com**. The ATS Web Portal Login Screen will appear and the database, **ats\_davidson**, should already be filled in. Enter your student ID number (801\*\*\*\*\*\*) in the Athlete ID box and type your password into the password box and click Login.

If you do not remember your password click on "Forgot your Username or Password?" and type in your email and **ats\_davidson** in the database field. You will receive an email to reset your password. If you are still unable to sign in contact your team assigned athletic trainer.

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Once you have signed in click on the athlete information option.

Next, click on the **Forms** tab at the top of the page.





## **Drug Testing Summer Contact Form**

- Click the dropdown arrow in the Form Name box, select the **Drug Testing Summer Contact** form and click the **New** button to the right.
- Complete all the required fields and sign the form at the bottom of the page in the signature box.
- You must sign your name with the mouse, type your name in the box, and click sign. (When your signature is saved a timestamp will be visible in the signature box.)
- Click the Save button at the bottom of the screen to save the form.

<sup>\*\*</sup>If any of this information changes it is your responsibility to update this information in ATS. Any missed drug test due to incorrect information will count as a positive drug test and you will be subjected to any sanctions imposed by the NCAA and/or the Davidson Student-Athlete Drug Testing Policy.
