OPENING TIP: Quick Hits

- Davidson is in its 38th season and has collected 421 wins in program history.
- The 'Cats are in their third year in the Atlantic 10 after a 21-year run in the SoCon.
- Davidson returns eight letterwinners and three of its five starters from last year's 11-19 team.
- Head coach Michele Savage is in her 7th year (96-120) and has a 0-2 record vs. Saint Joseph's.

LAST GAME OUT VS. FORDHAM, FEB. 14 ...

- Davidson erased a nine-point fourth-quarter deficit and junior Saadia Timpton hit the game-winner with 14.6 seconds left to give the Wildcats a thrilling 52-51 win vs. Fordham Tuesday.
- Down 48-39 with 9:15 to go in the final quarter, the 'Cats chipped away by using an 11-3 run capped off by a Chloe Johnson baseline jumper with 1:23 remaining.
- Justine Lyon all scorers, hitting the 20-point mark for the second straight game, and seventh time this year, by recording 22 points on 9-of-18 shooting, while hauling in five rebounds.
- The sophomore scored 18 of her points in the third and four quarters combined.
- The game was a back-and-forth affair with four lead changes and eight ties, six of them coming in the first two quarters.

WILDCAT ALL-TIME RECORD WATCH ...

- Latt is or will be ranked in the top-15 all-time in the record books during her third season. The junior became the 19th Wildcat to reach 1,000 points this year and currently sits in 11th with 1,128.
- She already ranks in the top-15 in career scoring average (8th, 13.1), blocks (10th, 76), field goals made (9th, 490) and attempted (9th, 1,088), and rebounds (9th, 630).

CONFERENCE STATS ...

- Lyon is fourth in the league in scoring overall at 15.2 points per game, while Latt is 11th (13.6).
- Lyon is second in the A-10 with an 18.9 scoring average in league games only.
- She has scored in double figures in all but one A-10 game, hitting the 20-point mark seven times.

RANDOM NOTES ...

- Latt has scored in double figures in 63 of her 86 career games, including a team-best 18 times this year, and had a personal-best 16-game streak of reaching double digits in points.
- Latt has 10 career 20-point outings, including this year's career-best 28 points at Charlotte.
- The junior has paced the team in rebounding 17 times, including a season-high 14 at Charlotte.
- Latt has 19 career double-doubles (6 this year), with 11 of them coming as a freshman.
- Lyon twice has reached 30 points this season, including a career-high 34 points at UMass, Feb. 4.
- Dating back to 1992-93, it is the first time a player has twice reached 30 points in a season.
- Lyon has registered all 7 of her career 20-point games this year, four times hitting 22 points.
- Lyon has scored in double figures a personal-best 18 times this year, including the last 7 games.
- Latt was named CollegeSportsMadness.com A-10 Player of the Week, Dec. 20.
- Lyon earned Davidson's first-ever A-10 Player of the Week honor, Feb. 6.
- Davidson has hit the 40-rebound mark 12 times, with a season-high 47 coming vs. URI, Feb. 11.
- The 'Cats have 18 double-digit assist games and dished out a combined 77 in the last five games.
- Johnson's 10-assist game, Feb. 11 vs. Rhode Island, was the first double-digit assist outing since Barbara Sitton had 11 at home vs. Princeton, Dec. 29, 2010.
- The Wildcats finished their home schedule with a 5-9 record, winning their final two games.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. SAINT JOSEPH'S ...

- The Wildcats and Hawks have played three times, with SJU claiming all three contests.
- In last year's meeting, the 'Cats fell on the road, 87-54, as 27 of their points came off the bench.

A LOOK AHEAD ...

- Davidson concludes the regular season with a Tuesday game, Feb. 21, at VCU.

Scouting the Opposition

- Saint Joseph's won its second straight, and sixth in the past seven games, with an 80-70 win at VCU Wednesday.
- Shooting 71.4 percent in the third quarter.
- The Hawks got a 19-point, 10 rebound double-double from junior Adashia Franklyn and the first career double-double from sophomore Sarah Veilleux, 17 points and 11 rebounds.
- Saint Joseph's has four players averaging in double figures, led by Chelsea Woods' 13.3 points per game.
- Franklyn is at 12.5 per game and a team-best 8.0 rebounds.
- SJU is 7-5 at home overall, with a 6-0 record vs. league foes.
- Dating back to Jan. 7, the Hawks have a record of 10-2.
- The Hawks are coming off a 14-15 season a year ago and went 8-8 in league games.
- They return 11 of 15 letterwinners, including two of their five starters.

PHILADELPHIA, Pa. — Playing its final regular season road game, Davidson was unable to overcome a slow start and dropped an 87-54 decision at Saint Joseph's Wednesday evening in Hagan Arena during Atlantic 10 women's basketball.

Davidson fell to 11-17 overall and 5-10 in league play, while the Hawks won their second in a row to improve to 13-14 and 7-8 in A-10 action.

The Hawks put four players in double digits, led by Chelsea Woods' game-high 23 points. Kathlee Fitzpatrick followed with 12 points, all coming in the first half and from behind the arc, while Sarah Veilleux and Sarah Fairbanks had 10 each.

Kianna Speight and Diona Johnson shared the team high honors for the 'Cats, netting 11 points apiece off the bench. Davidson tied a season-high with 27 bench points.

Mackenzie Latt kept her double-figure scoring streak alive with 10 points, pushing the streak to 12 games in a row.

The Wildcats were held to just five points through the first seven minutes of the opening quarter. Saint Joseph's took control of the game early, going on a 17-2 run to erase Davidson's 5-2 lead after a Latt jumper with 7:46 on the clock.

Hannah Early (8 points, 5 rebounds) swished home a three-ball at the buzzer to cut the Hawks' lead to 21-10 to finish the quarter.

The Hawks would continue to push its lead out, going up by 22 (40-18) before heading into the break up 44-23. Woods (13) and Fitzpatrick (12) combined for 25 of the first-half points.

Davidson, which got no closer than 46-26 on a Dukes' free throw at the 8:42 mark in the third quarter, finished the game shooting just 29.7 percent, despite swishing home 7-of-15 three-pointers on the evening.

Saint Joseph's hit 46.8 percent of its shots and won the rebound battle, 49-30, getting

16 on the offensive end. It also swished home 22-of-27 free-throw attempts and dished out 19 assists.

GAME NOTES: This was just the third meeting all-time between the two schools, with SJU having won all three games ... Davidson dished out 11 assists, making it 14 straight games with double-digit assists ... Latt has scored in double figures now in 31 of her past 36 games ... Early moved into fifth place all-time in scoring with 1,376 points ... Johnson's double-digit scoring game was her fifth of the season and sixth of her career ... Speight hit a career-high three shots from downtown.

HEAD COACH MICHELE SAVAGE



On May 28, 2010, Davidson College Athletic Director Jim Murphy announced the hiring of Michele Savage as the head coach for the Wildcat women's basketball program. She is the 11th head coach in the program's 38-

year history as she enters her seventh season for the 2016-17 campaign, which has the Wildcats playing its second year in the Atlantic 10.

Quick Highlights...

- Named 2011-12 Southern Conference Coach of the Year by media and coaches after guiding Davidson to a 22-10 record and school-best 17-3 mark in SoCon play.
- Won 50th career game at Appalachian State, Feb. 9, 2013 with a 56-49 victory.
- Ranks third all-time with 79 wins and had 53 of those against SoCon foes, second-most.
- Led Davidson to the program's first regular season SoCon title in 2011-12.
- Coached arguably the best player in program history in Sophia Aleksandravicius, who was a two-time SoCon Player and Defender of the Year, the 2013 SoCon Athlete of the Year, a three-time All-SoCon First Team member and set seven all-time career records.
- Coached the all-time scoring leading Laura Murray, who was a three-time All-SoCon First Team.
- Registered back-to-back 22-win seasons in 2011-12 & 2012-13.
- Led Davidson to back-to-back trips to the SoCon Championship title game in 2013 & 2014.
- Led the Wildcats to back-to-back post-season trips with bids into the Women's NIT in 2012 & 2013.
- Led Davidson to a school-record 12 homes wins in 2011-12.
- Guided the 'Cats to a school-best eight-game road win streak and tying a school record with eight straight in the SoCon on the road all in 2013.
- Coached Davidson to the program's first-ever Atlantic 10 win, Jan. 18, 2015 with a win at Saint Louis.
- Has coached 13 SoCon academic honor roll players, four A-10 Commissioner's Honor Roll players, four All-SoCon players, four 1,000-point scorers, four all-league Freshmen Team members, one SoCon Freshman of the Year and Player of the year.
- Has coached three Rebecca E. Stimson Award winners, given to Davidson's top female athlete in recognition of outstanding dedication and contribution to intercollegiate athletics.

Davidson, Through the Years

Entering its second year in the Atlantic 10, Savage helped the Wildcats improve across the board with six more wins overall and four in league play. Davidson went 11-19 on the season, while finishing 12th with a

5-11 A-10 mark. The Wildcats ran off a season-high three-game win streak, including collecting a thrilling double-overtime win at High Point. In addition, they recorded the program's first two-game A-10 win streak, collecting victories at VCU on national television and then at home vs. Fordham. The triumph at home vs. the Rams was Davidson's first league home victory in its new conference and the biggest in its two years so far at 69-51.

Savage guided the 'Cats to six non-conference wins, marking the most since the Wildcats went 6-5 during the 2007-08 season. They also won the program's seventh in-season tournament title since 1992-93 when they took home wins against Bowling Green and UNC Wilmington at the UNCW Thanksgiving Tournament. It was the second in-season tournament title under Savage for Davidson.

Senior Hannah Early and Dakota Dukes, under the direction of Savage, left their marks scattered throughout the Wildcats' record books. Early was honored with the Rebecca E. Stimson award as the top female athlete at Davidson. She finished her career as the program's all-time record holder in three-pointers, while ranking fourth in scoring with 1,406. Dukes concluded her career with 1,280 points, eighth-most all-time in the record books. Her name is found in nine overall categories in the Wildcat top-15, including third in made free throws (350) and second in attempts (486), and fifth in rebounds with 734.

The 2014-15 season marked a new era for the women's basketball program as Savage, in her fifth season, helped Davidson usher in its first year in the Atlantic 10. The Wildcats won their first-ever A-10 game on the road with a 53-50 win at Saint Louis to open the month of January. It would be the only win though in league play, as they went 1-15 in their first year and 5-25 overall. The 'Cats played 10 new opponents during the campaign, with nine of them being from the A-10.

Savage helped the program win its 400th game in its 36th season with a road win at Gardner-Webb, Nov. 20, 2014. The victory also marked her 75th career win at Davidson.

Under the guidance of Savage, junior Hannah Early became the 17th player in program history to reach 1,000 career points as she accomplished the feat during the 2014-15 season. It was the fourth time during Savage's tenure a Wildcat had reached the 1,000-point mark. Early also went on to set a single season record for three-pointers with 74. Freshman Mackenzie Latt had a great debut season for Savage, earning a spot on the A-10 All-Freshman Team, while earning two A-10 Rookie of the Week awards. Fellow classmate Saadia Timpton also earned an A-10 Rookie of the Week award during the season. Davidson as a team tied the single game record for blocks with 12 in a 76-57 home win over High Point.

In Davidson's final season in the Southern Conference, Savage, in her fourth year, coached the Wildcats to a third place finish

with an 11-7 record and a 16-16 mark overall in 2013-14. They reached the SoCon Championship game for the second year in a row, falling to Chattanooga. Savage collected her 50th career SoCon victory at UNCG, Feb. 8, 2014. She moved into second place in program history in league wins, finishing with 52. Davidson as a team tied the single season record for three-pointers with 180. It reached the 10-win plateau for the 11th time in the past 12 years in SoCon victories and had a seven-game home SoCon win streak that spanned from the end of the 2012-13 season into the first three league games of the 2013-14 campaign.

For the second year in a row, Savage saw one of the players in program history become its all-time scoring leader when Laura Murray hit her last bucket in the SoCon Final to set the record with 1,880 points, surpassing Sophia Aleksandravicius, who set the record the year before. Under Savage, Murray also became the program's all-time leader in made and attempted three-pointers and field goals attempted. In addition, the guard's senior season saw her set the single-season Wildcat record for points with 617, field goals attempted and free throws attempted.

Savage coached three all-league players in 2013-14, starting with Murray, who was a first team pick by both the coaches and the media. Dakota Dukes was also named to the first team by the coaches and teamed with Hannah Early on the second team for the media squad. The pair of Murray and Dukes were named to the SoCon All-Tournament First Team, with Murray becoming the first player in program history to earn the feat three times. She also joined Aleksandravicius as the only two players to earn All-SoCon First Team by the coaches.

Savage guided the Wildcats to their second straight 20-win campaign in 2012-13, as they followed up one of their best seasons in program history with yet another strong year. Davidson finished 22-13 overall and went second in the SoCon with a 16-4 record. The 'Cats' 22 wins were tied for the second-most in program history. They rode their outstanding season all the way to the conference tournament championship game, before falling to Chattanooga in a last-second affair. It was just the second time in program history Davidson had reached the final.

The Wildcats' season did not end there as they earned their second straight postseason appearance, and third overall, with a bid into the Women's NIT. They made history

winning the program's first postseason game, taking home a first round victory on the road at Old Dominion, 83-72.

Savage coached arguably the best player in program history in two-time SoCon Player and Defender of the Year Sophia Aleksandravicius. The senior at the broke seven all-time records during her three years under Savage, while being named to the coaches and media's all-league first team three times. Aleksandravicius capped off her career by being named the SoCon Female Athlete of the Year, the first female from Davidson to earn the honor. She was also earned the Davidson athletic department's Rebecca A. Stimson Award as the top female student-athlete at the school.

Also during 2012-13, Savage saw Laura Murray become the 16th Wildcat to score over 1,000 career points and earn a spot on the All-SoCon First Team by the coaches and second team by the media. Murray and Aleksandravicius were both named to the SoCon All-Tournament First Team. Dakota Dukes was named to the league's all-freshman team. February 9 was a special day for Savage as she collected her 50th career coaching win at Davidson in a 56-49 road victory at Appalachian State.

In 2012-13, Davidson set a school record with an eight-game road overall win streak, all against SoCon foes. The eight-game SoCon streak tied a school record set from 2005-06 and 2006-07.

The 2011-12 season saw Savage guide the Wildcats to one of their best seasons in program history. They captured the program's first SoCon Regular-Season Title with a school-best mark of 17-3, while the 'Cats' 22 wins were second-most in school history. Davidson also set a school mark for home wins (12-1), while it earned the program's 350th win during the season.

For all her accomplishments, Savage was honored by the coaches and media as she was named the 2011-12 SoCon Coach of the Year. She is the second coach in Wildcat history to garner the media's top coach, while she is the first to be coach of the year in the coaches all-league team. Davidson's trip to the Women's NIT was the program's second-ever bid into postseason play.

In addition, Savage coached the league's player and defender of the Year in Aleksandravicius, who also was a first-teamer on both the coaches and media teams, and Laura Murray, who was an All-SoCon First Team member on both teams as well.

Savage's first season, 2010-11, saw Davidson go 14-17 overall and sport an 8-12 campaign in the Southern Conference. The first-year head coach led the 'Cats to their first league tournament win since 2007 with a 69-53 victory against College of Charleston. They also nearly pulled off an upset of No. 1-seeded Appalachian State in the quarterfinals, before falling 73-63. Savage coached the SoCon Freshman of the Year in Murray and saw Aleksandravicius earn a spot on both the coaches and media All-SoCon First Team, while also pick up first-team all-state honors.

During the regular season, Savage led

Davidson to the program's fourth in-season tournament title when the Wildcats captured the UTSA Thanksgiving Tournament with the program's first-ever wins over North Texas and UTSA, Nov. 26-27. The 'Cats also had their 10th straight winning season at home, going 8-5.

Before Davidson- Part of a Successful Run at Tulane

A Street & Smith's All-American during her playing days at Northwestern, Savage came to Davidson after serving as an assistant coach at Tulane University from 2001-10. While at Tulane, Savage's duties touched all areas of the program as she coached the Green Wave post players on a day-to-day basis and worked with recruiting, directing Tulane's scouting efforts and overseeing the team's academic progress. She was the women's basketball program's liaison with the athletic department's marketing and game management units among many other responsibilities.

During her nine years at Tulane, the Green Wave twice hit the 26-win plateau and reached the NCAA Tournament in 2002, 2003 and 2010. The 2009-10 season saw Tulane go 26-7, earn the Conference USA regular-season title and earn an automatic bid to the postseason after winning the C-USA Tournament. Savage helped lead Tulane to two Conference USA regular-season titles and a Women's NIT bid in 2007.

She helped develop several top Green Wave players who were selected by USA Today for All-American Honorable Mention as well as several first-team Conference USA players. In addition, she had the chance to coach two players, Teana McKiver and Gwen Slaughter, who went on to play in the WNBA.

Hall of Fame Collegiate Career at Northwestern

Savage graduated from Northwestern University in 1993 after a standout career with the Wildcats. A three-time All-Big Ten selection, she was a Kodak All-District choice in 1990, 1991 and 1992 and earned All-America recognition from Street & Smith's in 1991. She helped lead the Wildcats to the 1990 Big Ten Championship and to appearances in the NCAA Tournament in 1990 and 1991 as NU posted 20-plus wins both years.

One of the top 15 players in the nation as a high school senior, she led Northwestern in scoring three times and was also the team's top rebounder in 1990 and 1991. Her



career field goal percentage of .606 is still a school record as is her .652 single-season mark from 1990. Savage scored in double figures in 25 straight games as a junior and had a 23-game double-figure scoring streak in her senior season. Savage was inducted in the Northwestern Hall of Fame in 2002 and the Illinois Hall of Fame in 2008.

Davidson Caps Home Slate With Thrilling Second Straight A-10 Win

Davidson erased a nine-point fourth-quarter deficit and junior Saadia Timpton hit the game-winner with 14.6 seconds left to give the Wildcats a thrilling 52-51 win in their home finale against Fordham, Feb. 14. It was the Wildcats' second straight win at home vs. Fordham, while also collecting its second consecutive Atlantic 10 overall and at home.

Down 48-39 with 9:15 to go in the final quarter, the 'Cats chipped away by using an 11-3 run capped off by a Chloe Johnson baseline jumper with 1:23 remaining to get within one at 51-50. Justine Lyon scored the other nine points.

The Rams missed twice on their next possession, Rachel Piles grabbed the rebound on the second miss and the 'Cats quickly called a timeout with 29 ticks left. Lyon tried for a reverse layup out of the break, but missed only to have the loose ball rebound go off a Ram and give the ball back to the Wildcats.

Davidson called its last timeout to set up an inbounds play under the basketball. Timpton got the ball from Johnson and banked in the short jumper on the left block with 14.6 seconds left for a 52-51 lead.

Fordham would use its last timeout and advanced the ball to half-court. G'mrice Davis got off two shot attempts near the basket with less than eight seconds left, but neither was close and time expired to give Davidson the win.

Another 20-Point Outing for Lyon

Sophomore Justine Lyon registered her seventh 20-point outing this year going off for a game-high 22 points in the 'Cats' home finale vs. Fordham, Feb. 14. The sophomore scored 18 of her points in the third and fourth quarters combined.

Six of her 20-point outings have come in league games this season. Three times she has gone off for 22 points in games against Fordham, George Mason and Dayton.

Savage Inches Closer to 100 Wins

Head coach Michele Savage moved within four wins of 100 for her career at Davidson after collecting her 96th victory, Feb. 14, with a 52-51 triumph vs. Fordham.

She would be the third coach in women's basketball's 38-year history to reach the 100-mark in their careers. Annette Watts is tops in the program with 144 victories, followed by John Filar at 102.

Seniors Lead 'Cats to Win vs. Rhode Island on Senior Day

Behind the senior trio of Rachel Piles, Melanie Ransom and Kayla Seymour, Davidson picked up a 74-64 Senior Day win over visiting Rhode Island, Feb. 11. It was the Wildcats' first win of the all-time series as well.

Piles hauled in a team-high seven rebounds to go with a block and three steals. Ransom in her first career start scored eight points and dished out three assists, while Seymour hit a personal-best 4-of-9 shots for a season-high eight points and assisted on

four other baskets.

Davidson pulled away with a 15-6 run that spanned the final 2:10 of the third quarter and went to the 6:17 mark in the fourth quarter. Capping the rally off was six straight points by Ransom to turn a 50-43 lead into a 65-49 advantage.

New Season Highs Set in Win Over the Rams

In Davidson's win over Rhode Island, Feb. 11, a 74-64 victory at home, it hit a few new team season highs. The Wildcats 27-point outing in the second quarter topped its previous high by four, while they hauled in a game-high 47 rebounds.

In addition, the 'Cats were very unselfish with the ball, dishing out 25 assists on 30 made field goals to top its previous high of 20 assists vs. High Point. Finally, they used the fast-break to their advantage, matching a season-high with 20 points, which was set vs. High Point earlier this season.

Another 40-Rebound Effort

The 'Cats registered their 12th 40-rebound outing on the season, with a season-high 47 in a win over Rhode Island, Feb. 11. Three times this year they had pulled in a season-best 45 in games against Radford, UNCW and Furman. The 47 is the most since a 55-rebound effort vs. High Point, Nov. 24, 2015.

Davidson had a six-game streak of pulling in 40 or more rebounds come to an end vs. Saint Louis, Dec. 31.

Johnson Dishes Out 10 Dimes, 'Cats have Season-high 25

Junior Chloe Johnson led an unselfish effort at home Feb. 11 in a win vs. Rhode Island by dishing out a career-high 10 assists, while Davidson as a team had a season-best 25 on 30 made field goals.

The 10-assist outing by Johnson was the most by a Wildcat since Barbara Sitton had 11 at home vs. Princeton, Dec. 29, 2010.

Outstanding Week Gives Lyon A-10 Co-Player of the Week

Justine Lyon was honored by the Atlantic 10 by being named the co-player of the week, Feb. 6. She shared her first collegiate weekly honor with George Washington's Caira Washington. It was also Davidson's first-ever weekly honor in its three years in the A-10.

The Durham, N.C., native had a stellar week in leading Davidson to a 1-1 record, averaging 28 points and 4.5 rebounds a game, while shooting a solid 54.3 percent. She also canned 5-of-13 three-balls and went 13-for-20 at the charity stripe, while adding three assists, two blocks and four steals.

Lyon's week started off with a 22-point effort, her fifth time reaching the 20-point mark, at home vs. Dayton. She hit 8-of-15 shots and added five rebounds to go with two steals.

She followed that up with a career game at UMass, netting 34 points in leading the 'Cats to a 63-59 win. Lyon scored 20 of her 34 in the first two quarters and helped seal the

She finished a career-best 9-of-12 from the charity stripe, all coming in the last quarter, while shooting 11-for-20 from the floor overall with a trio of three-balls. The 11 made field goals tied her career high from earlier this season at Charlotte.

Lyon Reaches 30 Again

Justine Lyon's stellar sophomore campaign continued as the sophomore reached the 30-point mark for the second time this season, going off for a career-high 34 points at UMass, Feb. 4. She hit for 20 of those points in the first and second quarter combined. Lyon tied her career-high with 11 made field goals on 20 attempts and set a personal best at the charity stripe by going 9-for-12, all coming in the fourth quarter.

The pair of 30-point outings is the first time dating back to 1992-93, when the women's basketball program was restarted, that a player had twice reached that mark in a single season. Jennifer O'Brien had three 30-point games spanned over four seasons (1996-2000). The last player to hit for 30 points in a season was Dakota Dukes at Wofford, March 2, 2014.

Lyon, 'Cats Down UMass on the Road For Second A-10 Win

Sophomore Justine Lyon scored a career-high 34 points and Davidson secured its second Atlantic 10 win by holding off UMass in a 63-59 road win, Feb. 4.

Lyon topped her previous career best from earlier this season by four points, scoring 20 of her 34 in the first two quarters, and helped seal the win by scoring eight of Davidson's final 10 points in the last two minutes. She finished a career-best 9-of-12 from the charity stripe, all coming in the last quarter, while shooting 11-for-20 from the floor overall with a trio of three-balls.

Davidson led for over 35 minutes of the game, holding off the Minutewomen after they tied the game at 43-all in the fourth quarter by using a quick 7-2 run to go up five and never looked back.

Latt Sees Double Figure Streak End at 16, Lyon's 9-Game Streak Ends vs. La Salle

Junior Mackenzie Latt saw her personal-best scoring streak of reaching the double-digit mark come to an end at 16 straight after recording just nine points at St. Bonaventure, Jan. 25. Her previous personal best was 12 straight.

Latt averaged 17.6 points and 8.7 rebounds during the streak. She is shooting 46.1 percent from the field, while dishing out 18 assists, blocking 16 shots and pocketing 33 steals, including a career-high nine vs. La Salle, Jan. 21.

The junior also registered all six of her double-doubles and all five 20-point outing this year during the scoring streak.

The Wildcats saw their streak of double-digit offensive rebounds come to an end at 18 straight, which dated back to the final game of the 2015-16 season, when they were held to eight board vs. George Mason, Jan. 18. Three times this year they have had 21 offensive rebounds in games vs. Radford, Charlotte and UMass.

Welcome to the 1,000-Point Club

Junior Mackenzie Latt became the latest Wildcat to reach 1,000 points, Jan. 7, at Duquesne. Latt is the 19th player in program history to hit the special mark after she nailed a long jumper in the second quarter for her 1,000th and 1,001 career points. She went on to finish with 18 points, while adding 11 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season.

It marks the 10th year in the past 11 that a Wildcat has scored 1,000 points for their career. Last year saw Dakota Dukes reach the milestone to become the 18th player.

Under head coach Michele Savage, it is her sixth 1,000-point scorer she has coached.

Four Double-Digit Scorers In the Book

For the first time this year Davidson placed four players in double figures in points, led by Justine Lyon's 22-point outing at Fordham, Jan. 4. The sophomore was followed by Mackenzie Latt's 19 points, while Chloe Johnson and Kyla Roland had 14 and 10 points, respectively. It was season highs for both players.

The last game where the 'Cats placed four scorers in double digits was at home last season against Duquesne, Feb. 6, 2016. It that game, Latt, Lyon and Roland were three of the players to score over 10 points, joining Hannah Early.

'Cats Fall in Conference Opener vs. Saint Louis

Davidson fell to 12-12 all-time in league openers when it dropped a 106-69 decision to Saint Louis, Dec. 31, at home. The 106

points were the most given up in a league game for the 'Cats between the Southern Conference and the Atlantic 10. They also fell to 8-6 in conference openers at home.

Mackenzie Latt and Justine Lyon again paced the offense with 23 and 19 points, respectively. Davidson had one of its better shooting games of the season, nailing 46 percent of its shots, including 52.9 percent in the first quarter.

Lyon Reaches Career High at Charlotte

Sophomore Justine Lyon had a game to remember at Charlotte, Dec. 21, reaching all the way to the 30-point mark in the 'Cats set-back to their cross-county rival. She hit an even 30 on a personal-best 11-of-18 shooting, including a career-best 4-for-5 from three-land.

The sophomore had quarters of seven, two, 12 and nine points on her way to becoming the first Wildcat to hit the 30-point mark since Dakota Dukes netted 31 at Wofford, March 2, 2014.

More Season Highs Hit at Charlotte

Despite a 93-79 setback to its cross-county rival Charlotte, Dec. 21, Davidson hit a few new season bests. The Wildcats registered season highs in made and attempted field goals (31-71), points in the paint (42), points off turnovers (30) and second-chance points (23).

They also scored a season-best 25 points in the third quarter.

Latt and Speight Strike Again, Pace 'Cats to Win vs. Furman

For the second game in a row, the pair of Mackenzie Latt and Kianna Speight helped carry Davidson to a win, scoring 25 and 20 points, respectively, in a 71-61 triumph at home vs. Furman, Dec. 18. The duos point totals each tied their career highs. The win was Davidson's seventh in the past nine meetings vs. the Paladins and 15th in the last 21 overall.

Latt finished the game canning a career-high 11 field goals on 17 attempts and added a team-best eight rebounds. Speight's five three-pointers were a career high and she set a new personal best with seven rebounds.

Justine Lyon gave Davidson three double-digit scorers with 12 points and matched Speight with seven boards. Rachel Piles came off the bench to pull in six rebounds and pocket a career-best four steals, while Chloe Johnson dished out a career-high nine assists.

Program's First Triple-Double

February 16, 2013 vs. Furman, Sophia Aleksandravicius registered her first career triple-double and the first registered in program history with 20 points, 10 rebounds and a new single-game school record 10 blocks in a 71-49 win.

Davidson as a team had 19 helpers on their 26 made field goals. In addition, the Wildcats' point totals of 24 and 28 in the first and fourth quarters were season bests, while it set a team season best with seven blocks and tied a season high with 45 rebounds.

A Pair of 20's

For the first time this year Davidson had a pair of 20-point scorers in the same game as the duo of Mackenzie Latt and Kianna Speight scored 25 and 20 points, respectively, in a win over Furman, Dec. 18.

The 25-point outing for Latt matched her career high, while Speight also matched her personal best, which she set a game earlier vs. High Point.

The last game with two 20-point scorers was last year vs. Charlotte at home, Dec. 20.

Speight & Latt Lead 'Cats to First Win

Kianna Speight and Mackenzie Latt combined for 39 points and Davidson shot a season-best 48.3 percent from the floor on its

way to an 82-72 win at home against High Point, Dec. 3.

Speight led all scorers with a career-high 20 points, canning four of her personal-best seven field goals from three-land, while Latt followed with a season-high 19 points on a season-best 9-of-17 shooting. She also filled the stat-sheet with six rebounds, four assists, three steals and a block.

The duo dominated the first and fourth quarters, with Speight scoring 10 points in the opening quarter to help the Wildcats (1-8) grab a 22-13 lead. Latt finished it off with a 10-point final quarter as the 'Cats led by as many as 19 points (77-58) before holding off a late Panther rally.

Season Highs Hit in Win Over the Panthers

In Davidson's first win of the season, an 82-72 victory at home vs. High Point, Dec. 3, it hit several team season bests. Besides the season-high 82 points, the Wildcats finished the game shooting a season-high 8-of-17 from behind the arc. It also had season highs of 20 assists, 20 fast-break points and 27 bench points.

The 20-assist outing was the first since dishing out 25 in a win over the same High Point team back on Nov. 25, 2014 at home.

Cancun Challenge

For the first time in the program's history, the Wildcats traveled outside the United States as they took part in the Cancun Challenge, Nov. 24-25.

Davidson faced Toledo and Idaho State for the first time, dropping both contests. Against the Rockets, the Wildcats fell behind 21-5 and never recovered. Latt paced the team with a game-high 15 points, while freshman Andrea Robinson crashed the glass for a game and season-high 12 rebounds. Davidson kept its streak alive of out-rebounding the opposition on the offensive end, making it five straight games by hauling in 13 rebounds and finished with a game-high 41 overall.

The following day vs. Idaho State, Davidson's valiant comeback effort fell just short against Idaho State in a 70-58. Trailing by as many as 20 (45-25) in the third quarter, Davidson twice got within single digits but a late 9-0 run by the Bengals halted the Wildcats' efforts. Mackenzie Latt again paced the Wildcat attack with a season-high 16 points, 14 of which came in the last two quarters when the 'Cats were making their comeback. Fellow junior Chloe Johnson netted a season-high 13 points, draining 3-of-5 shots from downtown.

Latt Named to the All-Riviera Division Team at Cancun Challenge

For her outstanding two games at the Cancun Challenge, Mackenzie Latt was named to the All-Riviera Division Team. The junior averaged 15.5 points and five rebounds a game vs. Toledo and Idaho State. She scored a season-high 16 points against the Bengals in Davidson's final game of the holiday tournament.

Davidson reached the 40-rebound mark for the first time, Nov. 19 vs. Radford, behind the strength of a season-high 21 offensive rebounds. It finished with a season-high 45 rebounds overall.

The 21-offensive boards were the most since a 22-rebound effort last year at Dayton, Jan. 31.

Mackenzie Latt and Justine Lyon each hauled in nine boards to lead the Wildcats, with Lyons tying her personal best. Saadia Tipton came off the bench to pull in eight boards, half on the offensive end.

Last year saw Davidson record 12 games of 40 or more rebounds, while its only 20-offensive effort was at Dayton.

Home Openers

In the program's 38-year history, the Wildcats are 17-19 overall in home openers (two of the year's results are incomplete). They fell in this year's home opener to UCF, 57-38, Nov. 16.

Davidson is 7-4 the last 11 years in home openers, falling 4-3 in the past seven years under head coach Michele Savage.

Home Sweet Home

Entering the 2016-17 season, the Wildcats look to continue their strong play at home since the opening of Belk Arena in 1992-93. The Wildcats have gone 170-116 during that time span. Davidson rattled off 13 straight seasons at home with a .500 or better record before the streak ended in 2014-15.

The 'Cats had a school-record 12-1 season in 2011-12 at Belk Arena, making it the 11th straight season the Wildcats had a winning mark. It included a seven-game-win streak to start the home season.

Latt and Roland Enjoy Trip Back Home to Michigan

Junior Mackenzie Latt (Kalamazoo) and Kyla Roland (Farmington Hills) got a chance to play in front of family and friends when Davidson took on No. 22 Michigan State and Western Michigan to open the season, Nov. 11-13.

The junior Latt finished with combined numbers of 18 points and 11 rebounds to go with three blocks and three steals in the two games. She had team highs of seven rebounds, three blocks and three steals at No. 22 Michigan State to open the season.

Roland tallied eight points and seven rebounds, while shooting 50% from the field and hit both free throws.

Season Openers

During the Wildcats' 38-year history, they have gone 10-28 in season-openers after opening the 2016-17 campaign on the road at No. 22 Michigan State, Nov. 11. The Wildcats fell 70-34 to the nationally-ranked Spartans.

Since the program was restarted in 1992-93, they have gone 8-17 and played some pretty tough competition. The 'Cats have faced the likes of top programs in North Carolina (three times), Duke, Vanderbilt, Nebraska, Michigan State (twice), Boston College, Arkansas-Little Rock and Clemson (twice).

During that time period ('92-93), Davidson has opened on the road or at a neutral site 22 times with a 7-15 record in those games.

Assist Streak Ends,

'Cats Pocket 15 Steals at No. 22 Spartans

Davidson saw its 16-game streak of dishing out double-digit assists come to an end in its season opener at No. 22 Michigan State. The Wildcats, who ended last season with 16 straight double-digit assist games, were three short, dishing out seven for the game against the Spartans.

The 'Cats though did do some damage on the defensive end against MSU. They pocketed a game-high 15 steals and forced 21 turnovers. The steal mark was the most since a 15-steal game at Winthrop, Dec. 12, 2014.

First Time Opponents

Davidson's non-conference schedule this year has four new opponents it will be facing for the first time in program history. The 'Cats will face Western Michigan on the road, then UCF at home before taking on Toledo and Idaho State at the Cancun Challenge.

It's the most first-time opponents Davidson will face in a year since it took on 10 during the 2014-15 season, the 'Cats first year in the Atlantic 10.
