OPENING TIP: Quick Hits

- Davidson is in its 39th season and has collected 429 wins in program history.
- The 'Cats are in their fourth year in the Atlantic 10 after a 21-year run in the SoCon.
- Eight letterwinners return and four starters from a year ago, while five freshmen were added.
- Head coach Gayle Coats Fulks is in her first year (8-12) and has a 0-0 record against UMass.

LAST GAME OUT AT ST. BONAVENTURE, JAN. 20 ...

- Kianna Speight drained a career-high 27 points in her first start of the season and Davidson nailed a season-high 10 three-balls on its way to a 75-68 road win at St. Bonaventure.
- Speight nailed a career-best 6-of-8 shots from three-land and tied for team season high in points.
- Katie Turner had 11 points, while Mackenzie Latt moved into fourth all-time in career points after filling the stat-sheet with 13 points, nine rebounds, a career-high tying six assists and two steals.
- The Wildcats dished out a season-best 20 assists in the win.
- After the Bonnies took a 50-49 lead late in the third quarter, Davidson ran off a 19-7 spurt that spanned the end of the third and the start of the fourth quarter to grab control.

DAVIDSON IN THE A-10 ...

- Davidson team rankings in the league's top-five- 5th in free throw percentage and steals per game.
- Sarah Donovan is second in free throw percentage (.878), while Mackenzie Latt ranks in the top-10 in: rebounding (8.1 per game), offensive (2.9) and defensive (5.2) rebounding, and steals (1.6).

WILDCAT ALL-TIME RECORD WATCH ...

- Mackenzie Latt became the 19th Wildcat to reach 1,000 points last year and has been moving up the charts recently, sitting in 4th place all-time with 1,407. She needs 103 more points to move to 3rd.
- She already ranks in the top-15 in career scoring average (8th, 13.1), blocks (5th, 98), field goals made (3rd, 609) and attempted (5th, 1,370), and rebounds (4th, 799).

RANDOM NOTES ...

- Sarah Donovan (Nov. 20) and Katie Turner (Dec. 26) have been named A-10 Rookie of the Weeks.
- Justine Lyon was named CollegeSportMadness.com Player of the Week, Dec. 26, after averaging 22 points, 8.5 rebounds, 6.0 assists and 2.5 steals per game in wins vs. High Point and Charlotte.
- Dating back to last season, the junior has scored in double digits in 39 of her last 42 games.
- She is riding a career-best 16-game streak of scoring in double figures.
- Lyon is closing in on 1,000 career points, needing 81 to become the 20th Wildcat to reach the mark.
- She tallied her first two career double-doubles vs. Gardner-Webb and at High Point.
- Mackenzie Latt has 23 career double-doubles (four this year), 11 of them coming as a freshman.
- Katie Turner twice has hit 6 triples in a game, while Kianna Speight did it at St. Bonaventure.
- The 'Cats dished out a season-best 20 dimes at St. Bonaventure and have 17 double-digit assist games.
- The 'Cats are riding an 11-game double-digit assist streak, dishing out 16 three times.
- The Wildcats hit the 40-rebound mark for the seventh time this year vs. GW with a game-high 46.
- Davidson had a season-high 47 rebounds at Furman, matching last year's season best.
- Of those 47 boards, 22 were on the offensive end, the most since a 22-outing vs. Dayton (1/31/16).
- Four players are averaging in double figures in points in A-10 games (Lyon, 13.7), Latt (13.3), Speight (10.4) and Turner (10.3).
- The 'Cats have had at least three double-digit scorers in eight of the past nine games.

ALL-TIME SERIES VS. UMASS ...

- The Wildcats and Minutewomen have played four times, meeting twice last season.
- The two teams split last year's meetings, each winning on the road as Davidson took the most recent game, 63-59, to earning its first win in the series.

- Davidson stays at home to face Dayton this coming Saturday at 2 p.m.

In the Last Meeting ... (Full Game Story)

AMHERST, Mass. — Sophomore Justine Lyon scored a career-high 34 points and Davidson secured its second Atlantic 10 win by holding off UMass in a 63-59 road win Saturday afternoon in women's basketball action inside the Mullins Center.

Lyon topped her previous career best from earlier this season by four points, scoring 20 of her 34 in the first two quarters, and helped seal the win by scoring eight of Davidson's (4-19, 2-9 A-10) final 10 points in the last two minutes.

She finished a career-best 9-of-12 from the charity stripe, all coming in the last quarter, while shooting 11-for-20 from the floor overall with a trio of three-balls.

Mackenzie Latt filled the box score with eight points, a game-high 10 rebounds, four assists, two blocks and two steals. Kyla Roland came off the bench for eight points and a career-high tying eight rebounds, five of them on offense.

UMass (9-16, 3-9 A-10) put three players in double digits, led by Alyx Stiff's 22 points. Leah McDerment had 12 points and eight assists, while Maggie Mulligan scored 10.

Davidson led for over 35 minutes of the game, but saw UMass tie the score to start the fourth quarter at 43-all. A free throw by Roland a few seconds later gave the 'Cats back the lead at 44-43.

Three minutes later, the lead would be one again at 46-45, but Latt hit a turn around layup with 5:31 left and Davidson pushed its lead out to as many as eight points the rest of the way.

Behind Lyon's hot-hand in the first quarter, Davidson held a 20-17 lead. The sophomore scored 12 points and the Wildcats shot 56.3 percent in the quarter.

Later in the second, Roland gave Davidson a nine-point advantage, 29-20, on a pair of free throws and Lyon capped off her outstanding first 20 minutes with two more buckets as the 'Cats held a 33-26 lead at half-time.

Davidson had a 39-31 edge on rebounds, including pulling down 15 offensive rebounds and turning them into 20 second-chance points.

GAME NOTES: This was the fourth meeting all-time between the two schools women's basketball programs ... the Wildcats collected their first win in the series today ... Lyon's 30-point effort was her second this season and it was her 15th double-digit scoring game of the year ... Davidson has had hit the double-digit mark in offensive rebounds in 21 of its 23 games ... Latt has led the team in rebounding 17 times this year ... the double-digit rebound game was the 22nd of her career ... the junior's two blocks moved her into ninth place all-time with 78 ... head coach Savage won her 94th career game ... the win snapped the Wildcats' four-game losing streak overall, including a four-game skid in league games, while halting a nine-game road losing streak (five in A-10 road games).

HEAD COACH GAYLE COATS FULKS



On May 10, 2017, Davidson College Athletic Director Jim Murphy announced the hiring of Gayle Coats Fulks as the head coach for the Wildcat women's basketball program. She is the 12th head coach in the program's 38-year history.

Quick Highlights...

- Spent five years at Wake Forest as an assistant coach, primarily working with the guards and wing players, and was the program's recruiting coordinator.
- She was integral in recruiting, helping the Demon Deacons put together ranked recruiting classes in each year on the staff, including the most recent class joining the program for 2016-17.
- She was recognized as one of WBCA's Thirty Under 30 honorees after fourth season at Wake Forest. The award is given annually to up-and-coming coaches 30 years old and younger, to recognize their involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others' professional manner and attitude as well as association involvement.
- During tenure at Wake Forest, the Demon Deacons earned back-to-back postseason bids to the Women's NIT in 2016 and 2017, reaching the second round both seasons.
- Coached two ACC All-Freshmen Team members and a pair of ACC First and Second Team picks during time at Wake.
- Graduated from Fairleigh Dickinson in 2007, where she was a four-year letterwinner for the Knights.

Coats Fulks came to Davidson from Wake Forest University, where she spent the past five years as an assistant coach under head coach Jen Hoover. This past season saw the Demon Deacons go 17-16 overall and earn a win over Bethune-Cookman in the first round of the WNIT before falling to Middle Tennessee State to end their season. Guard Alex Sharp became the second student-athlete under Coats Fulks to be named to the Atlantic Coast Conference All-Freshman Team, joining fellow teammate Ariel Stephenson who garnered the award a year ago from the Blue Ribbon Panel and the league's coaches.

During the 2015-16 season, Wake Forest found itself in postseason play for the first time since 2012 when it earned a berth to the WNIT. The Demon Deacons topped Charlotte in the first round before falling to Florida Gulf Coast in the second round.

In her first season with the Deacs, Coats Fulks helped guide one of the top scoring back courts in the ACC. Point guard Chelsea Douglas and Lakevia Boykin combined to make 134 three-pointers on the season, with Douglas' 72 ranking as the third-most for a single season in school history.

Coats Fulks came to Wake Forest after one season as an assistant coach at UNCG in 2011-12. With the Spartans, Coats Fulks assisted with recruiting, scouting, game preparation, and practice planning along with player development. She also served as the team's academic liaison.

She broke into the collegiate coaching ranks at Longwood University for four seasons from 2007-11. In her first season with the Lancers, they went 16-13 to notch the program's best win total in its Division I era at the time.

Prior to starting her collegiate coaching career, Coats Fulks served as the Assistant Video Coordinator during the 2007 season for the WNBA's New York Liberty. She assisted on scouting reports of the opponents and with film exchange.

A four-year letterwinner at Fairleigh Dickinson, Coats Fulks helped the Knights to NEC Tournament berths in her freshman and senior campaigns. A co-captain and a member of the NEC Academic Honor during her time at Fairleigh Dickinson, Coats Fulks graduated in 2007 with a degree in while carrying a 3.5 grade-point average.

Team, College Rally Around Robinson After Diagnosis

Davidson women's basketball head coach Gayle Coats Fulks announced, Jan. 22, that sophomore forward Andrea Robinson will miss the remainder of the season after she was recently diagnosed with leukemia.

Robinson, who played in nine games and started six of them this season, has been out since the middle of December. She underwent treatment at The Johns Hopkins Hospital in her hometown of Baltimore, Md.

"While this was unexpected and incredibly difficult news for Andrea, her family, and our program, I have been so impressed and inspired by Andrea's courage and positive attitude as she has faced this challenge head on," said Coats Fulks. "I'm grateful for the excellent medical care she has received starting here at Davidson and now at Johns Hopkins, and our team will be fighting with her and supporting her and her family every step of the way."

Speight Shoots Wildcats to Road Win at St. Bonaventure; First Win in the Series

Junior shooting guard Kianna Speight drained a career-high 27 points in her first start of the season and Davidson nailed a season-high 10 three-pointers on its way to a 75-68 road win at St. Bonaventure, Jan. 20.

Speight, who was 9-of-14 from the floor, swished home a personal-best six of the three-pointers on 6-of-8 shooting. Freshman Katie Turner hit the 10th triple, her third of the game, to give the Wildcats a commanding 71-59 lead with two minutes remaining.

Davidson had trailed 50-49 late in the third quarter before going on a 19-7 run that spanned from the end of the quarter to the start of the fourth quarter. The Wildcats would push its lead to as much as 12 points the rest of the way.

The win was also Davidson's first in the series after falling in the first three meetings.

Season Highs of 10 Triples & 20 Assists at St. Bonaventure

Davidson had its outside shot working in a win vs. St. Bonaventure, while playing self ball. The Wildcats hit a season-high 10 three-pointers, paced by Kianna Speight's career-best six. Katie Turner nailed three of her own, including the 10th of the ballgame.

Led by Mackenzie Latt's career-high six dimes, Davidson also dished out a season-high 20 assists. Speight had a personal-best four, while Saadia Timpton and Kelly Fitzgerald had three each.

The 20-assist outing was the most in a game since dishing out 25 against Rhode Island at home (2/11/17). The 10 three-pointers made were the most since the 'Cats swished home 11 at Virginia, Dec. 28, 2014.

Closing in on 1,000 Career Points

Junior Justine Lyon is close to becoming the next great Wildcat to hit the 1,000-point plateau for a career. She currently needs 81 more points to become the 20th player in program history to reach the mark.

16 in a Row for Lyon

Junior Justine Lyon has been on a double-figure scoring streak, pushing her streak to a career-high 16 in a row after a 13-point outing vs. George Washington, Jan. 17.

During this current streak, Lyon is averaging 15.9 points and 5.9 rebounds, while shooting 75.9 percent from the free-throw line. She has hit the 20-point mark three times, including a season-high 25 points in a win at High Point, Dec. 18.

40-Rebound Effort

The 'Cats registered their seventh 40-rebound outing, Jan. 17, against George Washington with a game-high 46 rebounds.

Six different Wildcats had at least five rebounds in the game. Sarah Donovan tied her season high with nine boards, while Mackenzie Latt and Justine Lyon followed with six each.

Davidson recorded a season-high 47 boards at Furman and of those 47, 22 were on the offensive end, also a season high.

Last year, Davidson registered 13 games of 40-rebounds or more. The Wildcats had a season-high 47 vs. Rhode Island, Feb. 11, which was the most since a 55-rebound effort vs. High Point, Nov. 24, 2015.

Wildcats Hold On For a 68-65 Win at Richmond

Davidson had at least three players score in double figures for the eighth consecutive game and led for all but 47 seconds in holding on for a 68-65 Atlantic 10 road win at Richmond, Jan. 14.

Justine Lyon led all scorers with 20 points, nailing her final three at the charity stripe to help seal the win. She went 7-of-8 from the line as Davidson was 20-of-25 overall as a team. Mackenzie Latt scored 18 points and Sarah Donovan came off the bench for 13, swishing home 7-of-8 free throws.

Three times in the second half Richmond closed within in one point, but each time the Wildcats answered. Lyon sealed the win at the end by sinking 3-of-4 shots at the charity stripe when the Spiders got to within 65-64 with 1:18 remaining.

Mackenzie Latt, who 11 times as a freshman recorded a double-double for the fifth-most in a Wildcat single season since 1992-93, tallied her fourth of the season vs. Rhode Island to give her 23 for her career.

The senior had 19 points and 12 rebounds.

 Behind Katie Turner's hot hand, the Wildcats canned a season-high nine of their 16 total field goals from behind the arc in leading to a win at home vs. Rhode Island.

Turner tied a season-high with six three-pointers on her way to 21 points. It was the freshman's second game this year with six triples in a game.

The Wildcats last hit at least nine three-pointers in a game, Feb. 27, 2016 vs. VCU when they went 9-for-21.

Turner, Wildcats Secure First A-10 Win, 77-67
 Freshman Katie Turner tied a season-high with six three-pointers on her way to 21 points to lead Davidson to its first Atlantic 10 victory with a 77-67 win at home over Rhode Island, Jan. 7.

Turner went 6-for-7 from behind the arc and reached the 20-point for the second time this year. Davidson halted a four-game league losing streak and went a season-best

9-of-16 overall on three-pointers. The Wildcats shook off a slow first quarter, which saw them fall behind by 10 points and 20-11 at the end of the quarter, to outscore URI 47-28 between the second and third quarters. They scored a season-high 25 points in the third quarter alone.

'Cats Fall in Conference Opener at George Mason
 Davidson fell to 12-13 all-time in league openers when it dropped a 74-61 decision to George Mason, Dec. 31, on the road. They also fell to 4-7 in conference openers on the road.

The Wildcats had a great first two quarters, leading 45-27 at the half, but were held to 16 points in the last two quarters. Mason scored them 47-16 in the second half.

Davidson led by 21 points in the second quarter (45-24), a season high and had season bests of 23 and 22 points in the first and second quarters, respectively. In addition, the 'Cats scored a season-best 30 points off of Mason turnovers, while nailing a combined seven triples in the first half.

Turner and Lyon Win Weekly Awards
 Freshman Katie Turner capped off her outstanding week before Christmas by being named the Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week, as announced by the league office, while Justine Lyon was named College Sports Madness Atlantic 10 Player of the Week for games played from Dec. 18-24.

Turner led Davidson to a 2-0 week with wins over High Point on the road and Charlotte at home by averaging 12 points and shooting 8-of-16 from the field, including 6-of-12 from beyond the arc. She also dished out seven assists, with five of them coming in the win vs. Charlotte.

The freshman recorded her second-highest scoring performance of the season with 17 points in the victory against the 49ers and

closed out the game by hitting the game-winning three-pointer to give Davidson a 68-66 lead with 37 seconds left on the clock.

Lyon had a stellar week, averaging a team-best 22 points per game, while hauling in 8.5 rebounds, dishing out 6.0 assists and pocketing 2.5 steals per game.

The junior led the 'Cats to a big comeback win at High Point by scoring a season-high 25 points and hauling in a career-best 13 rebounds for her second career double-double. She helped them overcome a 19-point third quarter deficit by netting 18 of their season-

The shooting guard ended the week with a 19-point outing vs. the 49ers and dished out a career-high seven assists.

Wildcats Halt Losing Streak vs. Cross-County Rival, Down Charlotte 68-66

Freshman Katie Turner drained a game-winning three-pointer with 37 ticks left and Davidson withstood a last-second shot from Charlotte to earn a 68-66 victory Thursday, Dec. 21.

The win snapped an eight-game losing streak in the series for the Wildcats, as they won for the first time since the 2006-07 season.

After Turner's triple, the Wildcats then withstood a flurry of shots from Charlotte in the closing 10 seconds. The 49ers miss two layups, but would draw a foul on the third shot attempt in the same possession. They missed both free throws though, and were forced to foul with 5.1 seconds remaining.

Davidson was unable to ice the game after two of its own missed free throws giving Charlotte one more chance to tie the game. An in-bounds play under the basket saw Octavia Wilson get off a shot in the paint that hit the back of the iron and fell off as the horn sounded to give Wildcats the victory.

Turner finished with 17 points, getting 15 on five three-balls. Mackenzie Latt had game highs of 23 points and 12 rebounds for her third double-double of the season. Justine Lyon rounded out the trio of double-figure scorers with 19 points and picked up a career-best seven assists.

Thrilling Comeback Win at High Point, Four in a Row in the Series

Justine Lyon led four players in double figures with a season-high 25 points and Davidson overcame a 19-point deficit in the third quarter to score an 82-74 comeback win on the road at High Point, Dec. 18. It was the Wildcats' fourth consecutive win in the series.

Lyon led the big comeback with 18 fourth-quarter points and six rebounds as she tallied her second straight double-double with a career-high 13 total rebounds.

Davidson trailed 59-40 with four minutes left in the third quarter before starting its comeback. It closed the third on an 11-4 run to get within 63-51 and then outscored HPU 31-11 in the final quarter to secure the win.

A Pair of Double-Doubles vs. Gardner-Webb on Education Day

Senior Mackenzie Latt and junior Justine Lyon did the best they could in trying to help the Wildcats pull out a win against Gardner-Webb, which they eventually did not, on Education Day, Dec. 15.

The duo each tallied double-doubles in the defeat, the first time two Wildcats did that in a game since at Dayton, Jan. 31, 2016 when Latt and Dakota Dukes each registered one.

Latt had a season best game, recording 27 points on a career-high 13-of-24 field goals and added 11 rebounds. Lyon earned her first collegiate double-double on 14 points and 10 rebounds, just the second time in her career she pulled in double-digit rebounds.

Davidson Hangs Tough vs. Princeton

Davidson fought back from a double-digit deficit and went down to the wire before falling at home to Princeton, 63-57, Nov. 25.

The Wildcats overcame a 15-point hole in the second quarter by opening the third quarter on a 14-2 run to go up 39-36 before ending the quarter tied at 48-all. The Tigers though would use a 10-2 run to start the fourth quarter and held off a late charge by the 'Cats to secure the win.

Twice Davidson was within three (58-55 & 60-57) in the final 1:19, but Princeton answered each time with a bucket of its own on its ensuing possessions.

Home Openers

In the program's 39-year history, the Wildcats are 18-19 overall in home openers (two of the year's results are incomplete) after scoring a 58-50 win this year against UNC Asheville, Nov. 22. They overcame a poor shooting night as well as falling behind by 10 points early to outscore UNCA 36-13 combined in the second and third quarters to secure the eight-point win.

Davidson improved to 8-4 the last 12 years in home openers.

Home Sweet Home

Entering the 2017-18 season, the Wildcats look to continue their strong play at home since the opening of Belk Arena in 1992-93. The Wildcats have gone 175-125 during that time span. Davidson rattled off 13 straight seasons at home with a .500 or better record before the streak ended in 2014-15.

The 'Cats had a school-record 12-1 season in 2011-12 at Belk Arena, making it the 11th

Donovan Earns Program's First A-10 Rookie of the Week Honor

Freshman Sarah Donovan collected the Wildcats' first Atlantic 10 women's basketball weekly award this season when she was named the league's rookie of the week for games played, Nov. 13-19.

Donovan becomes the program's second player to garner A-10 Rookie of the Week honors after Mackenzie Latt earned the award twice during her first year.

The first-year forward from London, Ontario, Canada, led Davidson to a 1-1 week against Furman and Appalachian State by averaging a team-best 14.5 points, while pulling in 7.0 rebounds a game. Donovan shot 47.4 percent from the floor and was 11-of-13 from the free throw line.

Donovan recorded a season-high 15 points and nine rebounds at Furman. Then against Appalachian State, she led the Wildcats with 14 points on 5-of-7 shooting and 4-for-6 from the line to go with five rebounds.

'Cats Escape Boone With a Win vs. App. State

Justine Lyon hit a driving layup on the baseline with 6.7 seconds and Davidson forced a turnover on Appalachian State's last possession to earn a hard-fought 59-57 road win, Nov. 19.

Davidson (2-2) saw ASU erase a 56-47 lead with 3:45 to go by going on a 10-1 run, capped off by back-to-back three-pointers to tie the game up at 57-all.

After a quick timeout by the Wildcats to advance the ball to midcourt, Lyon gathered in a pass on the far side and drove baseline, banking in the game-winner on a layup to make it 59-57. The junior then forced the Mountaineers' 25th turnover of the game to seal up the win.

Freshmen Tandem Shine at Furman

Despite suffering a tough 65-62 setback at Furman, the freshmen duo of Katie Turner and Sarah Donovan had themselves a stand-out game.

Turner did her best to try and lead the Wildcats to victory, dropping in a team season-high 23 points on 8-of-17 shooting that included 6-from-12 from three-land. The freshman guard dropped in 12 points, all on three-balls, in the third quarter alone.

Lyon Has 11-Game Double-Digit Scoring Streak Snapped

Junior Justine Lyon saw her consecutive streak of scoring in double figures halted at 11 after a 12-point outing at N.C. State, Nov. 12. The streak dates back to last season at St. Bonaventure, Jan. 25.

During the streak, seven times Lyon has reached the 20-point mark, including a career-high 34 at UMass.

Robinson & Donovan Lead 'Cats to Season-Opening Win, 10th Straight vs. Western

Andrea Robinson scored a career-high 16 points and Sarah Donovan sparked a fourth-quarter comeback as Davidson opened its 2017-18 season with 70-57 road win at Western Carolina, Nov. 10.

Donovan scored all eight of her points in the fourth quarter, tallying a pair of three-point plays in the first two and a half minutes to turn a 47-44 deficit into a 54-49 lead that Davidson would never give back.

Robinson, who hauled in a team-high eight rebounds, scored nine of the 'Cats' final 12 points in the last 4:30 to seal the win. Davidson ended up outscoring the Cata-mounts 26-10 in the final quarter to secure its 10th straight win against WCU in the series.

Congrats Coach Gayle on First Win

Davidson earned first-year head coach Gayle Coats Fulks her first career coaching win when it opened the season with a 70-57

road win at Western Carolina, Nov. 10.

Coats Fulks was the third head coach in program history to win their first game at Davidson.

Season Openers

During the Wildcats' 39-year history, they have gone 11-28 in season-openers after opening the 2017-18 campaign on the road at Western Carolina, Nov. 10. The Wildcats outscored WCU 26-10 in the fourth quarter on their way to a 70-57 win.

Since the program was restarted in 1992-93, they have gone 9-17 and played some pretty tough competition. The 'Cats have faced the likes of top programs in North Carolina (three times), Duke, Vanderbilt, Nebraska, Michigan State (twice), Boston College, Arkansas-Little Rock and Clemson (twice).

During that time period ('92-93), Davidson has opened on the road or at a neutral site 23 times with a 8-15 record in those games.

Lyon Named A-10 Most Improved Player in 2016-17

Justine Lyon had a breakout sophomore year a season ago. She paced the team with a 15.7 points-per-game average, which was an increase of 10 points per game from her freshman season. Lyon was even better in A-10 games, averaging 19.5, as both her season average and league average ranked third overall in the conference. In addition, the guard averaged just under five rebounds a game, dished out 44 assists (third-best on team) and tied Latt for team high honors with 48 steals.

Welcome to the 1,000-Point Club

Junior Mackenzie Latt became the latest Wildcat to reach 1,000 points last Jan. 7 at Duquesne. Latt is the 19th player in program history to hit the special mark after she nailed a long jumper in the second quarter for her 1,000th and 1,001 career points. She went on to finish with 18 points, while adding 11 rebounds for her fourth double-double of the season.

It marks the 10th year in the past 11 that a Wildcat has scored 1,000 points for their career. Last year saw Dakota Dukes reach the milestone to become the 18th player.

A-10 Preseason Honors For Lyon

At the annual Atlantic 10 Women's Basketball media day, junior Justine Lyon was named to the league's preseason all-second team. It was the second year in a row the Wildcats placed a player on the preseason team after Mackenzie Latt earned a spot on the third team a year ago. Davidson, picked 14th in the standings, returns eight letter-winners and four starters from last year's team.

Lyon had a breakout sophomore year a season ago capped off by being named the league's Most Improved Player.
