



## COOK, YARBROUGH, BALL & HUNTER EARN CROSS COUNTRY WEEKLY HONORS

**NEWPORT NEWS, Va.**—Fordham's Brian Cook was named the Atlantic 10 Conference Men's Cross Country Performer of the Week while Davidson's Caroline Yarbrough was named the Women's Performer of the Week. Also honored was Duquesne's Noah Ball, who was named the Men's Rookie of the Week, and Davidson's Maddie Hunter, who was named the Women's Rookie of the Week. The awards were based off performances from meets held Oct. 3-9.

Cook, a junior from Pearl River, N.Y., won the Metropolitan Championships at Van Cortlandt Park on Friday with a time of 26:12.8. As a team, Fordham finished fourth.

Yarbrough, a sophomore from Greensboro, N.C., placed third overall at the Royal Cross Country Challenge this past weekend, helping lead Davidson to a first-place team finish. She crossed the finish line in a time 17:41.2 (5K).

Ball, a freshman from Lancaster, Ohio, finished seventh in a field of 86 runners at the Carnegie Mellon Invitational with an 8K time of 27:09.5.

Hunter, a freshman from Charlottesville, Va., placed 11th overall at the Royal Cross Country Challenge, crossing the line in a time of 17:55.8 (5K).
