THE MATCH-UP: Marist returns home to face Davidson in a PFL contest on Homecoming & Reunion Weekend. Kickoff will be 1 p.m.

HOW TO FOLLOW US: Geoff Brault (play-by-play) and **Steve Eggink** (color) will have the call on Z-93 (93.3 FM) in the Hudson Valley. The pregame show will begin at 12:45 p.m. The game can also be listened to for free on iHeartRadio. A free video stream will be provided through the Red Fox Network at GoRedFoxes.com. Live game updates will be available on Twitter via Marist Athletics (@MaristAthletics) and Marist Football (@Marist_Football).

MARIST IN THE NFL: Jason Myers, who played at Marist from 2009-12 and graduated in 2013, is the New York Jets' placekicker. Myers kicked for the Jacksonville Jaguars from 2015-17. This season, Myers is 16-for-17 on field goal attempts with a long of 55, 15-for-16 on PATs, and has 32 touchbacks on 38 kickoffs. He set a Jets' record with seven field goals against Indianapolis on Oct. 14.

OUR LEADERS: Marist has four captains this season: fifth-year senior LB **Willie Barrett**, fifth-year senior FS **Wesley Beans**, red-shirt sophomore LB **Grant Dixon**, and junior C **Dan Wittekind**. Before this year, the Red Foxes had just two captains who were selected before their fourth year in the program in head coach **Jim Parady**'s tenure. That total doubled with the selections of Dixon and Wittekind.

JUSTON'S HISTORIC PERFORMANCE: Senior WR Juston Christian had 274 receiving yards and three touchdowns at Columbia on Oct. 6. His receiving yards total was the most in the FCS this year, set single-game records for Marist, against Columbia (in 1,103 games), and at Lawrence Wien Stadium. The touchdown total tied records in the latter three aforementioned categories. Christian was named PFL Offensive Player of the Week, and received Honorable Mention from STATS as FCS Offensive Player of the Week.

NATIONAL RECOGNITION FOR BARRETT: Red-shirt senior LB Willie Barrett was one of 25 named to the Watch List for the Buck Buchanan Award, which is presented to the best defensive player in the Football Championship Subdivision. Barrett was a First Team All-Pioneer Football League selection in 2017.

Head Coach Jim Parady 27th Season Career Record: 135-143-1 Maine/1983

Jim Parady, who has guided the Marist football program through over a quarter-century of growth, is in his 27th season as the program's head coach and 28th overall with the Red Foxes. He also coaches the team's quarterbacks.

Entering the 2018 season with 133 victories, Parady is the winningest coach in program history. He has made Marist a force to be reckoned with at the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), formerly known as I-AA, level. During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field. The Red Foxes have made the jump from Division III to FCS status, moved into a newly-renovated stadium, won four league championships and joined the Pioneer Football League on Parady's watch.

Three former Marist football players have signed contracts with NFL teams since 2013. In 2014, the Miami Dolphins' Terrence Fede became the first former Marist football player to appear in an NFL game. Marist graduate Jason Myers was the Jacksonville Jaguars' kicker for two-and-a-half seasons. On Sept. 20, 2015, the first NFL games with Marist graduates on each team took place when Miami played at Jacksonville. Overall, nearly 20 former Marist football players have gone on to have professional opportunities in the NFL, Europe, and in arena football.

In his tenure as head coach, Parady has posted a 135-143-1 record, with four league championships and a record of 93-68-1 in league contests. The Red Foxes won a share of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championship in 1994, 2006 and 2007, and a share of the Pioneer Football League championship in 2013.

A native of Nashua, N.H., Parady attended the University of Maine, earning a bachelor's degree in education in 1983. He was a four-year member of the football team as a quarterback and earned two varsity letters.

Parady and his wife, Kristen, reside in Poughkeepsie with their two children, Sarah Jane and Brett Kenneth. Sarah is a 2017 graduate of Marist.

History vs. Davidson

- Marist is 9-1 against Davidson all-time. The teams have now met for 11 straight years, starting with the year prior to the Red Foxes joining the PFL (2008).
- Marist has won seven consecutive games in the series, and three in a row at Tenney Stadium.
- Marist has topped 30 points in its last six games against Davidson.
- Marist has won five straight meetings by at least 20 points.

PFL History

- This is Marist's 10th season in the PFL. The Red Foxes are 38-37 in PFL play.
- All-time in the PFL, Marist is 5-10 in September, 22-14 in October, 11-12 in November, and 0-1 in December. Marist is 19-19 at home, and 19-18 on the road.
- Marist won a share of the PFL championship in 2013.

All-Time At Tenney

- This is Marist's 12th season at Tenney Stadium, where the Red Foxes are 26-35 all-time (22-24 in day games, 4-11 at night).

Season Stats/Trends

- In its two wins, Marist has outscored the opposition 20-0 in the fourth quarter.
- The last three times Marist erased a double-digit fourth quarter deficit to win have all come against Jacksonville (2018, trailed 17-7 & won 20-17; 2014, trailed 13-3 & won 17-17; 2009, trailed 27-17 & won 31-27).
- Marist's win over Dayton was its first against the Flyers at Tenney Stadium in five tries. The Red Foxes' triumph at Jacksonville was their first on the road against the Dolphins in four tries.
- Average Time of Possession: Opposition 35:20, Marist 24:40. Marist's win over Dayton was the only time this year the Red Foxes had more time of possession.

Meet Our New Quarterback, Jaken Daysnibeck

- Marist played three quarterbacks **Jacob Hallenbeck**, **Mike Husni**, and **Austin Day** in its win at Jacksonville. The trio combined to go 20-for-31 for 222 yards, two touchdowns, and two interceptions. Day, who played the entire second half, went 12-for-15 for 153 yards and two touchdowns as the Red Foxes erased deficits of 14-0 at halftime and 17-7 after three quarters.
- In each of the last three weeks Marist has played multiple quarterbacks in a game. In this span, the Red Foxes completed 67 percent of their passes (49-for-73) for 761 yards (10.4 yards per attempt) with six passing touchdowns and three rushing touchdowns against four interceptions.
- Marist has played at least two quarterbacks in four games this season. The only two "complete games" came from Husni at Bryant and at Stetson.

Toxic Differential

- Coined by former Baltimore Ravens head coach Brian Billick, "toxic differential" measures differences in big plays (covering 20+ yards) and turnovers.
