- Davidson wraps up the 2018 slate with Butler at Richardson Stadium.
- The 'Cats are 31-85 (.267) all-time in PFL play.
- Butler holds a slim 6-5 edge over the 'Cats and have won six straight in the series entering the contest.
- The two first squared off in 2003, the first of five straight Davidson wins from 2003-08.

A DAVIDSON WIN WOULD...

- Secure a winning season for the first time since 2007;
- Halt a six-game losing streak to Butler;
- · Snap a four-game losing skid overall;
- Be the first win over the Bulldogs since 2008.

QUICK HITS

- Davidson reset the FCS record for rushing yards in a single-game (789), snapping Missouri State's 1988 mark of 681. Four 'Cats rushed for 150+ yards; Wesley Dugger (231), Will Wicks (197), Tyler Phelps (153), Keylan Brown (150).
- Dugger eclipsed the 1,000-yard mark for the second straight season on his first carry at San Diego, a 94-yard scoring scamper. The sophomore back has 1158 yards and sits fourth on the all-time rushing list.
 - With Wicks sitting at 898 rushing yards, the 'Cats have the potential for two backs to eclipse 1,000.
 - Davidson has 13 interceptions this season, 10 more than 2017. Dreylan Hines leads the squad with 4.
 - The Wildcats have 39 rushing plays of 20 or more yards this season including 14 such plays at San Diego.
 - Junior defensive tackle Bryce Perry-Martin ranks first in the PFL in tackles for loss (13.5).
- Davidson welcomed 32 members to the Class of 2022 and a sophomore transfer; 17 are listed on defense, 14 on offense and 2 special teamers.

- Davidson is 3-4-1 all-time.
- •The Wildcats first played on 11/17 in 1899 when they tied North Carolina A&M, 0-0.
- The last win came in 1973, a 19-16 victory over The Citadel.
- Davidson is 0-1 in PFL games, a 17-10 loss to San Diego.

IN OTHER NEWS

#TRENDINGNOW

- The Wildcats smashed the FCS record for rushing yards last weekend at San Diego with 789.
- Davidson also snapped its own record for yards in a half with 571in the first half of the game.

LAST TIME OUT

- Davidson reset the FCS rushing record for yards in a game with 789 in a 56-52 setback at PFL Champion San Diego.
- Wesley Dugger rushed for a career-high 231 yards, putting him over 1,000 for the second consecutive season. He is the eighth Wildcat ever to rush for 200 yards and first since Justin Williams in 2007.
- Four Wildcats rushed for over 150 yards; Dugger (231), William Wicks (197), Tyler Phelps (153) and Keylan Brown (150), tying Jacksonville State's record set in 2013
- Davidson picked off two USD passes, one from **Rayshawn McCall** and another by **Cade Vela**. McCall was a force in the secondary, breaking up a pair of passes in the first half. He leads the PFL with 14 passes defended.
 - For a quick box score of the game turn to page 26.

CUTTING IT CLOSE

- The 'Cats last six games have been decided by 7 or fewer points.
- Davidson won the first two games of the stretch, 40-35 at Valpo and 44-37 over Jacksonville, but have dropped its last four by a combined 21 points.

FOR THE RECORD

- It's no surprise the 2018 Wildcats have started knocking off rushing records.
- FCS record for rushing yards in a game (789) at San Diego (11/10)
- The #1 rushing offense in NCAA FCS currently has 4402 rushing yards.
- Their 50 rushing scores is also a new single-season record.
- The 453 points scored is the most achieved in a single-season.

ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

- Davidson set FCS records for total yards in a game (964) in a 91-61 victory over Guilford (9/13).
- The Wildcats set program records of total TDs (13), rushing TDs (10), average yards per play (15.5) and blocked kicks (4).
- Davidson's longest drive of the game was 3:03 as 8 of the 13 scoring plays were from 50 yards or more.
- Wesley Dugger rushed for 3, while Will Wicks rushed for a pair and caught another TD. Dugger posted 186 yards, while Wicks' boasted 161 all-purpose yards.
- QB **Tyler Phelps** completed all 6 of his pass attempts for 192 yards and 2 TDs. He also rushed 62 yards for another score.
 - Freshman Coy Williams posted his first career 100-yard rushing game (168, 2 TDs).
 - Corey Coppola blocked 3 kicks (2 PATs, 1 punt), an individual Wildcat record.

TALE OF TWO HALVES

- Davidson has gotten off to fast starts in its 10 games, outscoring opponents 307-184 in the opening half of play this season including 155-68 in the first quarter alone.
- On the flip side, the 'Cats are getting outscored 125-69 in the fourth and 213-139 in the second half overall.

Scott Abell is in his first season on the sideline as Davidson head football coach for the 2018-19 season.

He was named to the post by former Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Jan. 2, 2018 and is the program's 28th head coach.

Abell joins the Wildcats following a six-season stint as head football coach at Division III Washington & Lee University. While leader of the Generals, Abell posted a 39-24 overall record and won the Old Dominion Athletic Conference Championship three times. His conference peers selected him ODAC Coach of the Year on three occasions and he was tabbed the Willy Lanier Virginia State Coach of the Year twice.

Abell served as the Washington & Lee offensive coordinator until 2012 when he was elevated to head coach. Under Abell, the Generals were transformed into a national rushing powerhouse, leading the NCAA Division III in rushing three of his final six seasons. His 2015 squad went undefeated in the regular season, the first to do so in program history, and set records in total yards (5,439), rushing offense (4,773) and points scored (417).

His head coaching career started uphill in 1997 at Liberty High School, near Lynchburg, Va., where he turned an 0-10 program into district champions in three years. He moved to nearby Amherst High School, which had not brought home a state championship in a dozen years, and led teams to back-to-back state titles.

Prior to landing his first head coaching gig, Abell served as an assistant at Altavista High (1996-97), West Albemarle High (1994-96) and Albemarle High (1993). His duties ranged from offensive coordinator to coaching the quarterbacks, defensive backs and linebackers.

Abell graduated with a bachelor's degree in education from Longwood College in 1992 where he played both football and baseball. A gifted baseball player, Abell was drafted by the Kansas City Royals and spent two years in the minor leagues, hitting a home run in his first at-bat.

Abell then turned his attention back to football and teaching, eventually earning his master's of administration/supervision at Lynchburg in 2007.

Abell and his wife, Crissie, have a son, Porter, who serves as the Wildcats wide receivers coach, and a daughter, Emily, who is currently enrolled at High Point University.
