#### **THE GAME**

- Davidson returns to the road for the second consecutive week when they visit Valparaiso for a PFL clash with the Crusaders.
  - •The 'Cats are 29-81 (.263) all-time in PFL play.
- Davidson leads the all-time series 7-4 dating back to the first meeting in 2001. The 'Cats won the first five meetings, but have fallen in four of the last six. Two of the games have been settled in overtime.

#### **QUICK HITS**

- Senior cornerback Nate Campbell was named a semifinalist for the National Football Foundation William V. Campbell Trophy. The Campbell Trophy is awarded annually to a senior who excels both on the field and in the classroom. Davidson has recorded back-to-back years with a semifinalist as Taylor Mitchell made the grade in 2017. Campbell is up against 178 other semifinalists, 39 from FCS institutions.
  - Junior slot receiver William Wicks leads the team with 8 touchdowns (6 rushing, 2 receiving).
- Sophomore running back Wesley Dugger moved into sixth on the all-time rushing list with 1669 yards. He needs just 7 yards to pass Jim Thacker '55 for fifth.
  - Junior Bryce Perry-Martin leads the PFL in tackles for loss (5.0) and is tied for the lead in sacks (2.5).
- Davidson looks to snap a 17-game Pioneer Football League losing streak at Valpo Saturday. The last PFL win for the 'Cats came in the 2015 season finale at Stetson, 20-17.
- Davidson welcomed 32 members to the Class of 2022 and a sophomore transfer; 17 are listed on defense, 14 on offense and 2 special teamers.

#### IN OTHER NEWS

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Davidson jumped out to a 14-0 lead, but it was all Dayton from there as the Wildcats dropped its PFL opener at Welcome Stadium, 42-21.
- Sophomore Wesley Dugger notched his sixth touchdown of the season and recorded 81 yards on 26 carries.
- Sophomore Tyler Phelps opened the scoring with a 48-yard scoring strike to Zach Hester. Freshman Kendahl Ross scored the final TD of the game, a 1-yard scoring scamper.
- •Three Wildcats registered 7 tackles apiece including junior Bryce Perry-Martin who made a 7-yard sack of Flyer QB Jack Cook.
- Davidson owned the first quarter, out-gaining Dayton 171-39 and running 20 more plays (25-5), but the Flyers finished with 392 yards (DC, 371) after a dominant third quarter where they found the end zone 3 times.

#### ONE FOR THE RECORD BOOKS

- Davidson set FCS records for total yards in a game (964) and rushing yards in a game (685) in a 91-61 victory over Guilford (Sep.13).
- The Wildcats set program records of yards in a half (525), total TDs (13), rushing TDs (10), average yards per play (15.5) and block kicks (4).
- Davidson's longest drive of the game was 3:03 as 8 of the 13 scoring plays were from 50 yards or more.
- Wesley Dugger rushed for 3, while Will Wicks rushed for a pair and caught another TD. Dugger posted 186 yards rushing, while Wicks' boasted 161 all-purpose yards.
- QB Tyler Phelps completed all 6 of his pass attempts for 192 yards and 2 TDs. He also rushed 62 yards for another score.
  - Freshman Coy Williams posted his first career 100-yard rushing game (168, 2 TDs).
  - Corey Coppola blocked 3 kicks (2 PATs, 1 punt), an individual Wildcat record.

Scott Abell is in his first season on the sideline as Davidson head football coach for the 2018-19 season.

He was named to the post by former Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Jan. 2, 2018 and is the program's 28th head coach.

Abell joins the Wildcats following a six-season stint as head football coach at Division III Washington & Lee University. While leader of the Generals, Abell posted a 39-24 overall record and won the Old Dominion Athletic Conference Championship three times. His conference peers selected him ODAC Coach of the Year on three occasions and he was tabbed the Willy Lanier Virginia State Coach of the Year twice.

Abell served as the Washington & Lee offensive coordinator until 2012 when he was elevated to head coach. Under Abell, the Generals were transformed into a national rushing powerhouse, leading the NCAA Division III in rushing three of his final six seasons. His 2015 squad went undefeated in the regular season, the first to do so in program history, and set records in total yards (5,439), rushing offense (4,773) and points scored (417).

His head coaching career started uphill in 1997 at Liberty High School, near Lynchburg, Va., where he turned an 0-10 program into district champions in three years. He moved to nearby Amherst High School, which had not brought home a state championship in a dozen years, and led teams to back-to-back state titles.

Prior to landing his first head coaching gig, Abell served as an assistant at Altavista High (1996-97), West Albemarle High (1994-96) and Albemarle High (1993). His duties ranged from offensive coordinator to coaching the quarterbacks, defensive backs and linebackers.

Abell graduated with a bachelor's degree in education from Longwood College in 1992 where he played both football and baseball. A gifted baseball player, Abell was drafted by the Kansas City Royals and spent two years in the minor leagues, hitting a home run in his first at-bat.

Abell then turned his attention back to football and teaching, eventually earning his master's of administration/supervision at Lynchburg in 2007.

Abell and his wife, Crissie, have a son, Porter, who serves as the Wildcats wide receivers coach, and a daughter, Emily, who is currently enrolled at High Point University.
