#### GAME DAY NOTES

The Georgetown University football team opens the 2019 season at Davidson on Saturday, the sixth season with Head Coach Rob Sgarlata at the helm.

#### WHAT'S AT STAKE

- The Hoyas are 8-11 in season openers since 2001 and have won three-straight openers, including a 38-14 win over Davidson in 2016 at Georgetown.
- GU is 5-2 against members of the Pioneer Football League over the past five seasons.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- The Hoyas are coming off one of the biggest turnaround seasons in the country last season, finishing 5-6 overall after a 1-10 2017 season.
- Georgetown went 4-2 in Patriot League play, its best conference record since joining the league in 2001. GU's win over Fordham snapped a 15-game losing streak against PL opponents.
- The Hoyas led the Patriot League with 34 sacks and 20 interceptions, and ranked second in scoring defense (21.1 ppg), total defense (298.0 ypg) and rushing defense (103.2 ypg).
- Nationally, the Blue & Gray was among the top 20 in interceptions (2nd), pass efficiency defense (2nd), turnovers gained (6th), rushing defense (10th), total defense (12th), sacks (10th) and scoring defense (18th).
- In its first season under Offensive Coordinator Rob Spence, the GU offense improved in almost every statistical category including points per game, touchdowns, total yards per game and total rushing yards.

#### WHAT IS RETURNING

- The Hoyas return 15 starters from the 2018 season, including seven on offense and eight on defense.
- Quarterback Gunther Johnson returns after starting all 11 games last season (152-296, 1,696 yards, 9 TD, 6 INT, 4 rushing TD).
- The Hoyas return its top three rushers from 2018 (Herman Moultrie, Saffold, Tolliver).
- Georgetown returns three of its top five receivers in terms of receiving yards (Dereus, Tomas, Edwards).
- Brad Hurst returns as the primary punter after back-to-back seasons average 40+ yards per punt.
- The defense returns four of its top five tacklers (Bowers, Reddick, Tate, Kessler).

#### ABOUT THE MATCHUP

- Georgetown and Davidson are meeting for the 13th time, with the Hoyas holding a 9-3 advantage in the series and have won the past five meetings.
- The two teams last met in the 2016 season opener at Georgetown, a 38-14 victory for the Hoyas. Tim Barnes passed for 215 yards and four touchdowns, Justin Hill had two touchdown receptions and Henry Darmstadter hit all five PAT attempts and a 27-yard FG.
- The last time Georgetown visited Davidson was a 35-14 Hoya win in the 2012 season opener.

#### INDIVIDUAL NOTES

- Michael Dereus has 1,153 career receiving yards and has scored 10 total touchdowns (8 receiving, 1 rushing, 1 KR).
- Kristian Tate led the Patriot League with 10.0 sacks in 2018.
- Tate has 145 career tackles and 16.5 sacks.
- Wes Bowers has 148 career tackles after leading the team with 91 tackles in 2018.

## HOYA NOTES

## FCS PUNTER OF THE YEAR WATCHLIST

Senior punter Brad Hurst was named to the inaugural 2019 FCS Punter of the Year Preseason Watchlist. Hurst punted 78 times for 3,182 yards in 2018, averaging 40.8 yards per game which ranked fifth in the Patriot League. The number of punts and punting yards both rank third in program history while his average per punt is fourth all-time. Hurst had 18 punts that traveled at least 50 yards and pinned the opponent inside their own 20-yard line on 19 occasions.

## PRESEASON ALL-AMERICAN

Senior defensive lineman Khristian Tate was named to the STATS FCS Preseason All-America Third Team. In 2018, Tate ranked fourth on the defense in tackles (54), while leading the way in TFL (16.5), sacks (10) and QB hurries (9). He recorded multiple sacks in each of Georgetown's four league wins, including two each against Lafayette, Lehigh and Bucknell.

## FBS TRANSFERS

The Hoyas have two transfers from FBS programs who are eligible to play immediately in 2019. Junior wide receiver Cooper Melton is in his first year on the Hilltop after spending two years at the University of Tennessee. Sophomore kicker Davis Walker, a local product from Potomac, Maryland, transferred to Georgetown after spending his freshman year at Tulane.

## HOYAS ON TV IN 2019

Georgetown will have three of its games, including two of its five home contests, broadcast nationally via Stadium's over-the-air (OTA) channels. GU's games against Marist (September 7) and Lafayette (October 19) at Cooper Field, as well as the season finale at Holy Cross (November 23) will be seen by a national audience.

All of Georgetown's five home games, as well as the team's three road conference games will be broadcast on the Patriot League Network. Additionally, GU's games against Catholic (September 14), Fordham (October 12) and Colgate (November 2) can all be seen on DCW50, Washington's CW channel.

## OH CAPTAIN, MY CAPTAIN

Prior to the team's departure for its season opener, Head Coach Rob Sgarlata announced the team's captains for the 2019 season. Seniors Gunther Johnson, Ryan Jelink and Khristian Tate, and junior Wes Bowers, will lead the Hoyas this fall.

"Since the start of 2018 these four seniors have been members of our Hoya Leadership Council," Sgarlata said. "As members of the Council they were tasked with defining the Hoya football culture. They have worked extremely well together on and off of the field towards this goal. I am looking forward to seeing Brandon, Carl, Blaise and Ramon continue their journey and development as the servant leaders of our program."

## BOWERS SELECTED TO WEAR NO. 35

Junior Wes Bowers was selected as the 2019 No. 35 Joe Eacobacci Memorial Jersey recipient at the team's award banquet this spring. He becomes just the second junior to ever earn the honor and the first since Michael Ononibaku (B'06) wore it as a junior in 2004. Bowers is the 11th defensive player to don the No. 35 jersey since its inception in 2003, and the fifth linebacker.

## PRESEASON ALL-PATRIOT LEAGUE

The Hoyas had a record six student-athletes selected to the All-Patriot League Preseason Team. The Hoyas were also selected to finish third in the Patriot League Preseason Poll, the highest predicted finish in program history.

Junior linebacker Wes Bowers was an All-Patriot League Second Team selection last season and earned HERO Sports FCS Sophomore All-American honors.

Senior wide receiver Michael Dereus led the Georgetown receiving corps in 2018 with 379 receiving yards and an average of 18.1 yards per catch while playing in just eight games.

Junior defensive lineman Duval Paul earned All-Patriot League Second Team honors in 2018.

Senior Isaac Schley was selected to the preseason team as a fullback. A key blocker in the running game, Schley ranked third on the team last year with 19 receptions and sixth with 112 receiving yards.

Senior defensive lineman Khristian Tate is the only member of the preseason team that has earned three All-Patriot League selections in his career after being named to the second team as a freshman and the first team each of the past two seasons.

Junior safety Ahmad Wilson was selected to the preseason team as both a defensive back and special teams non-specialist, after earning All-Patriot League recognition in each of his first two seasons as a special teams non-specialist.

## HOYAS WITH NFL PEDIGREE

Three Hoyas own a slight edge over their teammates, being the sons of former NFL players. Junior quarterback Joseph Brunell is the son of former NFL quarterback Mark Brunell, who was a three-time Pro Bowl selection in 18 years in the league playing for five different teams. Junior wide receiver Skyler Springs is the son of former Pro Bowl cornerback Shawn Springs, who played 12 seasons in the NFL for three different teams. Freshman offensive lineman Talati Polamalu is the nephew of former Pittsburgh Steelers safety Troy Polamalu.

Additionally, the Hoyas have some NFL experience on the sidelines. Assistant Coach Jamie Sharper, who is working with the linebackers, enjoyed a nine-year career in the NFL. He was a second-round draft pick by the Baltimore Ravens in 1997. He played for the Ravens for five seasons, starting all but one game, including Baltimore's Super Bowl XXXV victory in 2000. In 2003, playing for Houston, Sharper led the NFL with 164 tackles and was selected as Houston's Player of the Year while also being named a finalist for the Walter Payton Man of the Year Award. He played his final season with the Seattle Seahawks in 2005, helping them reach their first Super Bowl. He ended his career having played in 136 consecutive games and recording 882 tackles, 25.5 sacks and two interceptions.

## GET IN THE GAME, SAVE A LIFE

The Hoyas partnered with Be The Match to host its second annual "Get In The Game, Save A Life" (GITG) bone marrow registry drive in April. In two years participating in bone marrow registry drives, the Hoyas have registered 422 new members, many of which were Georgetown student-athletes and coaches, to the national bone marrow registry.

Rob Sgarlata (C'94, S'12) was named the 31st head football coach in GU program history in February 2014, becoming just the fourth person to have played football and graduated from Georgetown before earning the head coach title, joining Joe Reilly, Jack Hagerty and Maurice Dubofsky. In addition to his head coaching duties, Sgarlata also works with the cornerbacks.

#### Sgarlata has established a foundation for the program based on three principles ...

- **4 for 40** - a four-year commitment to Georgetown football leads to a 40-year relationship with special attention to their mind, body and spirit - Cura Personalis
- **Men for Others** - the Jesuit value of service to the community
- **SISU** - a Finnish phrase that translates into courage in the face of adversity

In his first five seasons as head coach, Sgarlata has seen 30 student-athletes earn postseason All-Patriot League honors and 160 Georgetown football players have been named to the Patriot League Football Academic Honor Roll. In 2016, Sgarlata led the Hoyas to their first 3-0 start since 1999 with wins over Davidson, Marist and Columbia. With its homecoming win over Columbia, Georgetown claimed its second-straight Lou Little Trophy. The GU defense led the Patriot League in scoring defense (23.3 ppg), while the special teams unit tied for the national lead in blocked kicks (8).

In 2018, the Hoyas enjoyed one of the best improvements seasons in the country, finishing 5-6 overall and 4-2 in league play, the program's best Patriot League record since joining the conference in 2001. Georgetown enjoyed conference wins over Fordham, Lafayette, Lehigh and Bucknell. The double OT win over Lehigh was GU's first since 1925. Six Hoyas were named to All-Patriot League postseason teams.

In each of his first two seasons at the helm, Sgarlata guided a one-game improvement in the win column. In 2015, Georgetown took home the first Lou Little Trophy by beating Columbia and earned its first home victory over an Ivy League program, defeating Brown. Kyle Nolan became GU's all-time leader in pass attempts, completions and total offense, earning an invitation to Baltimore Ravens Rookie Mini-Camp.

Alec May had an All-America season in 2014, setting the program's single-season sack record and leading the nation with 16.5, while Nick Alfieri became the third player in program history to eclipse 300 tackles. Both were named First Team All-Patriot League.

Sgarlata's emphasis on excellence in the classroom has shown as the program set a Patriot League record with 45 student-athletes on the Patriot League Academic Honor Roll in 2014. The Hoyas also had the highest academic progress rate (APR) in the Patriot League for two-straight academic years (2013-14 and 2014-15), scoring a perfect 1,000 in 2014-15.

Prior to being named head coach, Sgarlata had been on the Hoya coaching staff for 18 seasons, working with four different position groups and served as the assistant head coach and defensive coordinator for 10 seasons. During his tenure as defensive coordinator, he helped guide the Hoyas to the top-ranked scoring defense in the Patriot League in 2011 and the second-ranked scoring defense in 2012. The Hoyas featured four ECAC First Team selections and 20 All-Patriot League selections on defense.

Within the defense, Sgarlata coached All-Americans Michael Ononibaku (2005), Alex Buzbee (2006), Andrew Schaetzke (2011) and Robert McCabe (2012). Both Schaetzke and McCabe earned Patriot League Defensive Player of the year honors and Sgarlata also guided the 1996 Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference (MAAC) Defensive Player of the Year Janne Kouri.

Buzbee became the second Hoya in program history to make an NFL roster, suiting up for the Washington Redskins (2007-09). He also played for the Toronto Argonauts of the CFL from (2010-11).

While working on the offensive side of the ball, Sgarlata helped lead the Hoyas to consecutive MAAC Championships (1998, 1999) and an appearance in the 1998 ECAC Bowl. J.J. Mont was named the 1999 Co-Offensive Player of the Year and he coached Gharun Hester, Georgetown's all-time leading receiver in yards (3,089) and touchdowns (39).

Sgarlata has also served as an academic advisor, career and alumni liaison, financial aid liaison, internship director and computer and technology liaison during his time with the football program.

A four-year letterwinner at Georgetown, Sgarlata is among the program's all-time leading rushers. He was a team captain as a senior in 1993 and received the John J. Hagerty Award. He excelled in the classroom, being named to the 1993 GTE District II Academic All-America Football Team and was also named to the MAAC Football League Academic All-Star Team.

Sgarlata graduated from Georgetown in 1994 from the College of Arts & Sciences with a degree in government and international relations. In May 2012, he completed his master's degree in sport industry management from Georgetown's School of Continuing Studies.

## ROB SPENCE

**OFFENSIVE COORDINATOR  
QUARTERBACKS  
SECOND SEASON**

Rob Spence was introduced as Georgetown's offensive coordinator in March 2018. Spence, who brings more than 25 years of college coaching experience to the Hilltop, will work directly with the quarterbacks in 2019.

In his first season with the Hoyas, the offense improved in almost every statistical category including points per game, touchdowns, total yards per game and total rushing yards.

Spence brings 17 years of experience as a collegiate offensive coordinator, including at FBS programs such as Clemson, Louisiana Tech, Syracuse and Toledo. Most recently, he was the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Morgan State, where he led the Bears to the third-best scoring offense (26.8 ppg) in MEAC conference games. The Bears also ranked first in the MEAC in third-down conversions (.427), second in total offense (419.9 ypg), rushing offense (191 ypg) and sacks against (9) and fourth in passing offense (228 ypg).

Prior to Morgan State, Spence spent two years as a receivers coach at the University of Tennessee at Chattanooga. He also spent two years as the head coach of Chattanooga Christian High School following a two-year stint as the quarterbacks coach at Rutgers.

He was the offensive coordinator at Bethune-Cookman in 2011, where the Wildcats led the MEAC in scoring offense (33.9 ppg) and total offense (435.3 ypg), ranking 15th and 12th, respectively, in the country. Bethune-Cookman also boasted the nation's fifth-best rushing attack, averaging nearly 260 rushing yards per game.

Spence spent 2010 as the wide receivers coach at Temple and 2009 at Syracuse as the offensive coordinator under current Jacksonville Jaguars head coach Doug Marrone.

Prior to joining the Orange, Spence enjoyed a successful four-year run at Clemson. During his tenure at Clemson, the Tigers had two top-25 seasons, went to three bowl games, and won 25 games. Clemson led the ACC in scoring offense twice under Spence.

The 2005 Tigers improved 89 yards per game in total offense over 2004, the fourth-largest jump in school history and the eighth-best improvement among Division I-A teams.

Before Clemson, Spence led Toledo to four straight top-13 final marks in total offense and helped the Rocket program to 35 wins from 2001-04. Twice in his four years, the Rockets were in the top 20 in the nation in rushing and passing.

Spence went to Toledo after a year as co-offensive coordinator at Louisiana Tech, where he tutored freshman Luke McCown, who threw for 2,533 yards and 21 touchdowns on the way to a freshman All-America season.

He was also the offensive coordinator and quarterbacks coach at Hofstra from 1997-99. In 1999, his offense averaged 34 points a game with an 11-2 record and No. 5 final national ranking. He started his career at Hofstra as an offensive assistant in 1990, helping the program to a 12-1 record and No. 3 national ranking.

In between his stops at Hofstra, he was an assistant at Maryland (1992-96) under Mark Duffner. The Terps set 70 school records during his tenure.

He earned his bachelor's degree in social work from Iona in 1981 and later earned his Master's Degree in education from Iona in 1990. A native of Pelham, New York, Spence and his wife Susen have two daughters, Samantha and Sydney Rae.

Kevin Doherty was named Georgetown's defensive coordinator in January 2017 after serving as the special teams coordinator from 2012-16. He works directly with the team's linebackers.

In 2018, the Hoyas boasted one of the best defenses in the entire country. Georgetown led the Patriot League with 34 sacks and 20 interceptions, and ranked second in scoring defense (21.1 ppg), total defense (298.0 ypg) and rushing defense (103.2 ypg). Nationally, the Blue & Gray was among the top 20 in interceptions (2nd), pass efficiency defense (2nd), turnovers gained (6th), rushing defense (10th), total defense (12th), sacks (10th) and scoring defense (18th). Five members of the defense were named to postseason All-Patriot League teams.

The Hoyas were one of the nation's best special teams units in 2016, tying for the national lead with eight blocked kicks, while Hunter Kiselick led all players in FCS with four blocked kicks. Henry Darmstadter, who set Georgetown's record for career field goals, earned All-Patriot League Second Team honors after tying for the conference lead with 11 made field goals. Harry McCollum was also named to the second team after setting GU single-season records with 86 total punts for 3,575 yards, becoming the first Hoya to surpass 3,000 punt yards in a season.

In 2015, Doherty helped guide Darmstadter to a second team selection and Isaac Ellsworth posted the second best kick return average in GU history (22.9 yards/return). In 2014, McCollum set the Georgetown single-season mark, averaging 42.7 yards/punt.

In the defensive backfield, Jelani Williamson tied for the league lead in 2016 with four interceptions and the Hoyas led the PL in scoring defense (23.3 ppg). In 2012, Doherty helped the Hoyas rank third in the PL in pass defense (215.7 ypg), despite losing three starters from the previous season.

Doherty has also helped the Hoyas forge strong relationships in the community. In 2014, he organized the team's adoption of Elijah Davis and Jackson Dundon through the Friends of Jaclyn Foundation. The Georgetown added Willie Hughes to the football family in 2016.

Before Georgetown, Doherty served as the assistant head coach and defensive backfield coach at St. Anselm College after coaching at Harvard from 2001-09, helping the Crimson win four Ivy League championships. He was the defensive backfield coach in 2001 before becoming co-defensive coordinator in 2002 when he was named the All American Football Foundation Assistant Coach of the Year. In 2003, he was named assistant head coach and defensive coordinator.

Doherty spent two seasons at the University of Connecticut as the defensive backfield coach, earning his first Assistant Coach of the Year honor.

He spent the 1998 season as the head coach at St. Francis (Pa.) after a six-year run as the defensive coordinator and special teams coordinator at Marist. In 1997, the Red Foxes led the nation in total defense (213 ypg) while setting NCAA records in rushing (39.8 ypg) and yards/carry (1.24).

From 1989-92, Doherty was the defensive backfield coach and special teams coordinator at Tufts and spent the spring of 1989 coaching linebackers at Northeastern.

Doherty began his coaching career at Syracuse from 1987-89 as a graduate assistant, helping the Orange to a 1987 Sugar Bowl Championship and a 1988 Hall of Fame Bowl Championship.

Doherty earned his Bachelors of Arts from Tufts in 1987 and his Masters of Science from Syracuse in 1989. He lives in Springfield, Va., with his wife, Sue, and has three children - son Kevin Jr. and daughters Katherine and Claire - and three stepchildren - Abigail, Emmanuel and Annie.



## TREY HENDERSON

**SPECIAL TEAMS COORDINATOR  
SAFETIES  
FIRST SEASON**

Trey Henderson joined the Georgetown coaching staff in March 2019. Along with being the team's special teams coordinator, he also works with the safeties.

Henderson came to the Hilltop after spending 13 years on the coaching staff at William & Mary, most recently working with the safeties and serving as the recruiting coordinator. In 2016, the Tribe defense led the country in fewest passing yards allowed per game (154.2) and ranked fourth in passing efficiency defense (105.16).

He coached four all-conference honors in three seasons with the safeties, including working with the 2015 Colonial Athletic Association co-Defensive Player of the Year and consensus first-team All-American DeAndre Houston-Carson, who was drafted by the Chicago Bears. Henderson also coached cornerback Derek Cox (third round draft pick by Jacksonville Jaguars in 2009), cornerback B.W. Webb (fourth round draft pick by the Dallas Cowboys in 2013) and safety Jerome Couplin III (free agent signee by the Detroit Lions).

In addition to his role with the defensive secondary, Henderson also worked with the Tribe's specialists, helping four players earn five all-conference honors, including a pair of first-team all-league picks in 2015. Additionally, placekicker Nick Dorka, Jr. garnered multiple All-America honors in 2015 after ranking fourth nationally in field goals made per game (1.62), 10th in field goal percentage (.840) and 11th in scoring (8.5).

Henderson came to William & Mary in 2006 after serving as the defensive backs and wide receivers coach at Hopewell High School in Virginia for three seasons, which included an AAA State Championship in 2003.

A four-year letterwinning defensive back at Randolph-Macon College, Henderson started three years in the secondary and was the Yellow Jackets' co-captain in 2001, while also spending three seasons on the baseball team. He received his Bachelor of Arts in economics and business from RMC in 2002 and completed a Master's of Science in sport leadership at Virginia Commonwealth University in December 2006.

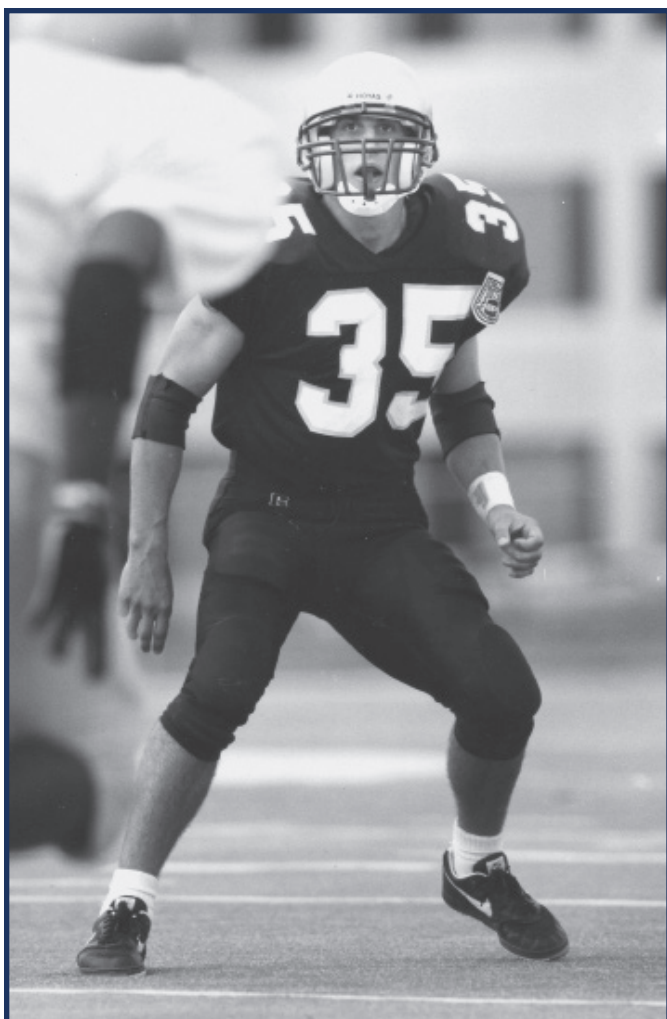

## IN MEMORY OF JOE EACOBACCI

On September 11, 2001 the Georgetown community lost former Hoya football standout Joe Eacobacci. A 1996 graduate of the College of Arts and Sciences, he was an energy trader for the investment firm Cantor Fitzgerald on the 105th floor of the North Tower of the World Trade Tower. Since the 2003 season, the No. 35 has been awarded as a living memorial to the spirit and memory of Joey.

Joe was a football student-athlete for former head coach Bob Benson between 1993 and 1995 and was the team's tri-captain his senior season. Benson believed that Eacobacci's mark on Georgetown was inked not only on the gridiron but also on the entire Georgetown campus.

"He had more friends than anybody, and that was what made him a beautiful person," Benson said in an interview with GU's student newspaper, The Hoya. "He would light up a room, he really could make people smile and bring enjoyment and pleasure to a room."

Joe is survived by his parents, Ann and Mitch Eacobacci, his older brother, Tom (a 1993 graduate of the McDonough School of Business and former football player), his younger sister, Michelle, and by his girlfriend of many years, Denise Mauro.

The Eacobacci family and Georgetown University have set up a need based scholarship fund in Joe's name.

The student-athletes chosen to wear the No. 35 jersey have been selected based not only on on-field performance, but a combination of skills and intangibles that have cemented Eacobacci's place in Georgetown football history.
