#### **THE GAME**

- Davidson returns home for a twinbill starting with Marist College.
- The 'Cats are 34-86 (.283) all-time in PFL contests and 5-6 since head coach Scott Abell took over in 2018.
- The two have faced off every season since the first-ever meeting in 2008. The 'Cats lone win over Marist came on the road in 2010, 28-21.

## A DAVIDSON WIN WOULD...

- Give the 'Cats six wins for the second consecutive season;
- Snap an eight-game losing skid to the Red Foxes;
- Tie the 2018 PFL win total with three.

## **QUICK HITS**

- Davidson is 2-1 in the PFL for the first time since 2009.
- Running back *Wesley Dugger* moved into third on the all-time rushing list, passing Eric Ferguson. The junior sits at 2940 yards, 145 behind Ray Sinclair for second.
- Dugger was named the PFL's Offensive Player of the Week and was an Honorable Mention for the STATS FCS Offensive Player of the Week for his dominant day in Jacksonville.
- Junior slot receiver *Pat Tabor* earned the PFL's Special Teams Player of the Week after filling in at place kicker and going 7 for 7 on point after attempts.
  - The Wildcats have scored first in every game this season.
- Dugger was named to the College Football Performance Award FCS National Performer of the Year Trophy watch list and a HERO Sports Preseason All-American.
- Davidson welcomed 26 members to the Class of 2023 and a junior transfer; 13 are listed on offense, 12 on defense and 2 special teamers.

• Wesley Dugger reset the single-game rushing touchdown (5) and career rushing touchdown (37) records at Jacksonville last weekend, all while moving up to third on the all-time rushing list (2,940 yards) ... and he's only a junior.

#### **LAST TIME OUT**

- Davidson posted a dominant performance on the road at Jacksonville last Saturday, 49-19.
- Junior running back Wesley Dugger rushed for a Davidson single-game record five touchdowns, totaling 193 yards on 22 carries - 8.8 yds per carry.
- The 'Cats rushed for a season-high 521 yards on 73 carries. 11 Wildcats rushed for double digit yardage including senior *Jorell Story* (82 yards).
- Junior slot receiver *Pat Tabor* filled in place kicking responsibilities and converted 7 of 7, including the one after his three yard scoring scamper.
- Senior linebacker *Tony Collins* led a balanced defensive attack, leading the team in tackles (6) and intercepting his first pass since 2016 at Kentucky Wesleyan.

## GO BIG, OR GO HOME

• Sophomore receiver *Jalen Staples* leads the FCS in yards per reception, averaging 26.07 yards per catch. Staples has caught 15 passes for 391 yards and two touchdown grabs. His long reception of the season went 66 yards to the shadow of the goal line at Morehead State.

#### **OLD FAITHFUL**

- **Wesley Dugger** has scored a touchdown in eight of his last nine games played, finding the end zone 21 times during that stretch.
  - Dugger has scored 11 in his last three games.

## **#WE WANT THE BALL**

- The 'Cats have scored first in all seven games this season.
- Davidson has scored on their opening possession in every game and started with the ball five times. Only West Virginia Wesleyan and Jacksonville took the opening kick over Davidson and each were kept off the scoreboard on their opening series.

## THE OLD FAMILIAR

• The 'Cats sit comfortably atop the top five FCS teams in rushing (3rd - 332.4) and 3rd down conversion percentage (2nd - 55.9%).

## **NEW TERRITORY**

• The Davidson defense remains in the top five nationally in total defense (3rd - 278.6) and rushing defense (5th - 81.4).

## **HOME COOKING**

• The 'Cats are 8-3 under head coach Scott Abell at Richardson Stadium.

#### **BRAINS AND BRAWN**

- Davidson senior offensive lineman *Ethan* Steinbacher was named a National Football Foundation William V. Campbell Trophy Semifinalist.
- The Campbell Trophy, in its 30th year, honors a senior or student-athlete playing in their final year of eligibility, who exemplifies academic success, performance on the field and exemplary leadership. One player can be nominated per program and must have a 3.2 GPA or higher.
- Steinbacher makes it three consecutive years a Wildcat has reached semifinal status Nathan Campbell (2018) and Taylor Mitchell (2017).

#### **GOOD WORK**

- Senior linebacker *George Hatalowich* was named to the 2019 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team, announced last month. Hatalowich was integral in starting the Uplifting Athletes Chapter at Davidson to raise money and awareness for the rare disease community.
- George was one of 22 selected out of a pool of 137 nominees between all four NCAA football designations (FBS, FCS, DII, DIII). He will be honored at the 2020 Allstate Sugar Bowl.
- He is the fourth Wildcat to be given this honorable distinction.

## **2018 SEASON REWIND**

- Davidson finished 6-5 (3-5 PFL) for their first winning season since 2007.
- Five 'Cats landed on the All-PFL Team including first team running back *Wesley Dugger Ethan Steinbacher* (OL), *Jorell Story* (RB) and *Bryce Perry-Martin* (DT) were among the second team selections.
- Safety **Dreylan Hines** made the HERO Sports Freshman All-American Team, following up his PFL Co-Freshman Defensive Player of the Year honors. He led the squad with four interceptions.
- Davidson opened the season 3-0 including a historical 91-61 game against Guilford. The 'Cats scored 13 TDs to reset a program record.
- The win at Valparaiso on Sep. 29 was the first PFL win for the team since 2015.

## A SEASON FOR THE AGES

THE LAST TIME THEY MET

- The 'Cats reset program records in rushing yards (4279), points scored (494) and rushing TDs (55) among others.
- Davidson finished atop the FCS in total offense (561.9), rushing offense (442.9), and 3rd down conversions (55.6%)
- The Wildcats 789 rushing yards at San Diego broke a 30-year old NCAA record previously held by Missouri State. Davidson also became the first team ever to boast four players with over 150 rushing yards in a game.
- Davidson set FCS records for total yards in a game (964) in a 91-61 victory over Guilford (9/13).

Scott Abell is in his second season on the sideline as Davidson head football coach for the 2019-20 season.

He was named to the post by former Director of Athletics Jim Murphy on Jan. 2, 2018 and is the program's 28th head coach.

In his first season at the helm, Abell led Davidson to its first winning season since 2007, directing the 'Cats to a 6-5 mark that concluded with a heroic goal-line stand on the final play of the season to secure the winning campaign.

Coach Abell led the Wildcat offense to NCAA FCS statistical champions in total offense (561.9) and rushing (442.9), while also directing the 'Cats to top-five ranks in third down conversion percentage, offensive red zone percentage and scoring.



Davidson rewrote the NCAA history books with a 789-yard rushing performance at San Diego in 2018, the most by any team in NCAA history, snapping Missouri State's mark of 681 yards set in 1998. Four Wildcats rushed for over 150 yards including Wesley Dugger's 231-yard output.

Abell joined the Wildcats following a six-season stint as head football coach at Division III Washington & Lee University. While leader of the Generals, Abell posted a 39-24 overall record and won the Old Dominion Athletic Conference Championship three times. His conference peers selected him ODAC Coach of the Year on three occasions and he was tabbed the Willy Lanier Virginia State Coach of the Year twice.

Abell served as the Washington & Lee offensive coordinator until 2012 when he was elevated to head coach. Under Abell, the Generals were transformed into a national rushing powerhouse, leading the NCAA Division III in rushing three of his final six seasons. His 2015 squad went undefeated in the regular season, the first to do so in program history, and set records in total yards (5,439), rushing offense (4,773) and points scored (417).

His head coaching career started uphill in 1997 at Liberty High School, near Lynchburg, Va., where he turned an 0-10 program into district champions in three years. He moved to nearby Amherst High School, which had not brought home a state championship in a dozen years, and led teams to back-to-back state titles.

Prior to landing his first head coaching gig, Abell served as an assistant at Altavista High (1996-97), West Albemarle High (1994-96) and Albemarle High (1993). His duties ranged from offensive coordinator to coaching the quarterbacks, defensive backs and linebackers.

Abell graduated with a bachelor's degree in education from Longwood College in 1992 where he played both football and baseball. A gifted baseball player, Abell was drafted by the Kansas City Royals and spent two years in the minor leagues, hitting a home run in his first at-bat.

Abell then turned his attention back to football and teaching, eventually earning his master's of administration/supervision at Lynchburg in 2007.

Abell and his wife, Crissie, have a son, Porter, who serves as the Wildcats wide receivers coach, and a daughter, Emily, who is currently enrolled at High Point University.
