**THE MATCH-UP:** Marist returns to Pioneer Football League play and goes back on the road as the Red Foxes head to North Carolina to face Davidson. Kickoff is set for 1 p.m.

**HOW TO FOLLOW US:** **Geoff Brault** (play-by-play), **Mike Ferraro** (color), and **Ed Weir** (sideline) will have the call on Z-93 (93.3 FM) in the Hudson Valley. The pregame show starts at 12:45 p.m. The game can be listened to for free at GoRedFoxes.com via the Red Fox Network, and on iHeartRadio. Game updates will be available on Twitter via Marist Football (@Marist\_FBall).

**MARIST IN THE NFL:** **Jason Myers**, who played at Marist from 2009-12 and graduated in 2013, is the Seattle Seahawks' placekicker. Myers kicked for the Jacksonville Jaguars from 2015-17, and the New York Jets in 2018. Last season, Myers became the first Marist football player to earn a berth in the Pro Bowl. He signed a multi-year contract with the Seahawks this past off-season.

**OUR LEADERS:** Marist has five captains this season: senior OL **Dan Wittekind**, red-shirt junior LB **Grant Dixon**, senior LB **Maliek Carr**, red-shirt junior OL **Luke Butera**, and red-shirt junior LB **Matt Thomson**. Wittekind and Dixon are in their second seasons as captains, while Carr, Butera, and Thomson are in their first. Thomson is serving as special teams' captain.

**ABOUT DAVIDSON:** The Wildcats are coming off a 49-19 triumph at Jacksonville in their last outing on Saturday, Oct. 19. Davidson has the reigning PFL Offensive Player of the Week (RB **Wesley Dugger**, who scored five touchdowns) and PFL Special Teams Player of the Week (K **Pat Tabor**, who went 7-for-7 on PATs and scored a touchdown). Davidson ranks second in the Football Championship Subdivision in time of possession, third in total defense, and third in rushing offense. The Wildcats were picked to finish fifth in the PFL Preseason Poll, with Dugger, OL **Ethan Steinbacher**, and DL **Bryce Perry-Martin** earning Preseason All-PFL honors. Head coach **Scott Abell** is in his second season.

**UP NEXT:** Marist will return home to Tenney Stadium to face Butler on Saturday, Nov. 2. Kickoff is set for noon.

**Head Coach Jim Parady**  
**28th Season**  
**Career Record: 139-150-1**  
**Maine/1983**

Jim Parady, who has guided the Marist football program through nearly three decades of growth, is in his 28th season as the program's head coach and 29th overall with the Red Foxes. He also coaches the team's quarterbacks.

Parady is the winningest coach in program history, and the longest-tenured head coach in Division I football. He has made Marist a force to be reckoned with at the Football Championship Subdivision (FCS), formerly known as I-AA, level. During his tenure, Parady has coached conference championship teams and has had student-athletes excel both on and off of the playing field. The Red Foxes have made the jump from Division III to FCS status, moved into a newly-renovated stadium, won four league championships and joined the Pioneer Football League on Parady's watch.

Three former Marist football players have signed contracts with NFL teams since 2013. In 2014, the Miami Dolphins' Terrence Fede became the first former Marist football player to appear in an NFL game. Marist graduate Jason Myers was the Jacksonville Jaguars' kicker for two-and-a-half seasons. On Sept. 20, 2015, the first NFL games with Marist graduates on each team took place when Miami played at Jacksonville. Myers became the first Marist football player selected to the Pro Bowl following the 2018 season. Overall, nearly 20 former Marist football players have gone on to have professional opportunities in the NFL, Europe, and in arena football.

In his tenure as head coach, Parady has posted a 139-150-1 record, with four league championships and a record of 98-70-1 in league contests. The Red Foxes won a share of the Metro Atlantic Athletic Conference Football League championship in 1994, 2006 and 2007, and a share of the Pioneer Football League championship in 2013.

A native of Nashua, N.H., Parady attended the University of Maine, earning a bachelor's degree in education in 1983. He was a four-year member of the football team as a quarterback and earned two varsity letters.

Parady and his wife, Kristen, reside in Poughkeepsie with their two children, Sarah Jane and Brett Kenneth. Sarah is a 2017 graduate of Marist.

## History vs. Davidson

- Marist is 10-1 against Davidson all-time, with eight straight wins.

- Marist is 6-0 all-time at Davidson, and 10-0 all-time in the state of North Carolina. The Red Foxes also went 4-0 at Campbell.

- This is the 11th straight season the teams have met.

## Last Time Out

- Marist was defeated by #21 Dartmouth, 49-7, on Oct. 19..

- LB **Grant Dixon** forced a fumble and had an interception.

- Making his collegiate debut, QB **Matt Edwards** went 9-for-9 for 85 yards passing and a touchdown, all of which occurred on the Red Foxes' final drive.

## Trends/Notes

- Marist ranks 14th in the FCS in Red Zone Defense, as the opposition has been kept off the scoreboard on eight of its 25 trips inside the Marist 20 this season.

- Marist is 17th in the FCS in kickoff coverage, allowing 16.89 yards per return.

- Marist QBs have been sacked once in the last three games (132 passes).

- On the season, Marist is 23% on fourth downs (3-for-13), while the opposition is 63% (12-for-19).

- Marist is minus-9 in turnover differential (16 giveaways - 12 interceptions, 4 fumbles lost; 7 takeaways - 4 fumbles recovered, 3 interceptions). The Red Foxes have committed four turnovers in a game three times this year.

## McElroy Named Campbell Trophy National Semifinalist

- Safety **Andrew McElroy** was named one of 185 national semifinalists - including one of 39 in the FCS - for the William V. Campbell Trophy, known as the "Academic Hesiman".

- McElroy has started a Master's program in Public Administration. As an undergraduate, he majored in Business Administration/International Business and minored in Criminal Justice.

- A three-year starter at safety, he is a four-time Dean's List honoree, four-time PFL Academic Honor Roll selection, and two-time PFL All-Academic Team choice.

## Award Winners

- Both **Anthony Olivencia** (Offensive Player of the Week) and **Kyle Fleitman** (Defensive Player of the Week) earned PFL awards on Sept. 15 following Marist's victory over Stetson.

- Olivencia caught four passes for 150 yards and two touchdowns. Fleitman had 10 tackles (including a team-high eight solo stops), three pass break-ups, a forced fumble, and a tackle for loss.

- It was the first career PFL weekly honor for both Olivencia and Fleitman.

## Marist In The PFL

- Marist is in its 11th season in the Pioneer Football League in 2019.

- The Red Foxes are 42-41 all-time in PFL play. Marist is 6-11 in September, 24-15 in October, 12-14 in November, and 0-1 in December. Marist is 22-21 at home, and 20-20 on the road.

- Marist won a share of the PFL championship in 2013.

## Openers

- In Marist's 42 years in Division I, the Red Foxes are 16-26 in season openers.

- The Red Foxes have dropped their last seven season openers. Their last win to open a season was a 35-10 triumph at Bryant on Sept. 1, 2012.

## Player Notes

### Quarterbacks

**Austin Day (14)** has started five games; he missed the Sept. 21 game at Cornell due to injury. His season high for passing yards is 221 against Drake on Sept. 28. Day set Marist's single-game record for passing yards (440) and tied the record for touchdown passes (five) in his first career start last season, a double overtime win over Davidson. ... **Luke Strnad (13)** has appeared in all of Marist's six games. Subbing for an injured Day, he completed a 75-yard touchdown pass to **Anthony Olivencia** for the game-winning score against Stetson. Strnad made his first collegiate start against Cornell on Sept. 21. ... **Matt Edwards (11)** saw his first collegiate action in the final drive against Dartmouth on Oct. 19, and went 9-for-9 for 85 yards and a touchdown pass.

### Running Backs

**Mekhai Johnson (48)** is the Red Foxes' leading rusher with 222 yards and a 4.7 yards per carry average. Johnson had his second career 100-yard game against Stetson with 125 yards on 16 carries, including a 54-yard touchdown. He has missed Marist's last two games (knee). ... **Hunter Cobb (45)** has started Marist's last two games, and has a team-best two rushing touchdowns. ... **Darryn Jordan (28)**, last season's leading rusher (507 yards), is the team's second-leading rusher (73 yards) this season.

### Wide Receivers

**Anthony Olivencia (15)** is tied for the team lead in receptions (23) while pacing the Red Foxes in receiving yards (379) and receiving touchdowns (three) this season. Over his last 11 games dating back to last season, Olivencia has 59 receptions for 946 yards with five touchdowns. In last year's season finale vs. San Diego, he tied the program record with 12 catches for a career-high 224 yards. ... **Ethan Carpenter (1)** set career highs with eight receptions for 83 yards at San Diego, and is third on the team in receptions (17). ... **Sydney Person (80)** had career highs with five receptions and 45 receiving yards against Dartmouth. ... **Joe Petro (6)** had a career-high 95 yards receiving against Cornell, and is third on the team with 180 receiving yards. ... **Cade McNaughton (29)**, who converted from safety in the spring, scored his first career touchdown against Drake.

### Tight End

**Jon Kanda (49)** had career highs for receptions (six) and receiving yards (107) against Stetson on Sept. 14 for the first 100-yard receiving game of his career. Kanda is tied for the team lead in receptions (23) and is second in receiving yards (247) this season. Kanda had six receiving touchdowns last year. ... **Sean Gaffney (82)** has four receptions for 33 yards this season, and scored a touchdown against Dartmouth. ... **Wyatt McMahon (85)** started alongside Kanda at tight end at Georgetown.

### Offensive Line

Four Red Foxes have started all six of the team's games: **Matt McKnelly (79)** at left tackle, **Jerry Prutos (60)** at left guard, **Darryl Sullivan (69)** at center, and **Ben Stoy (77)**, who has five starts at right tackle and one at right guard. ... **Luke Butera (71)** started at right guard against San Diego, and **Ben Johnson (72)** made his first career start at right tackle against Dartmouth. Butera was a starter in 2017 and 2018 before both seasons were cut short due to knee injuries. ... **Dan Wittekind (62)** started the first four games at right guard before missing the last two (knee). Wittekind had started all of Marist's 37 games in his career until sitting out at San Diego on Oct. 5. ... McKnelly started last year at right tackle. Prutos is a second-year starter at left guard. Sullivan and Stoy are first-year starters. ... Also having seen action up front and/or on special teams are **Ethan Parrish (64)**, **Anthony D'Urso (73)**, **Ian Grant (74)**, and **Casey Callahan (78)**. .... Grant is out after suffering a leg injury suffered against Drake on Sept. 28.

Acosta, who has missed two games due to injury, is tied for the team lead with four-and-a-half tackles for loss and has a sack in each of Marist's last two games.
