THE GAME

- Davidson opens up at home against Pioneer Football League newcomer Presbyterian.
- The 'Cats are 38-88 (.301) all-time in PFL contests and 10-7 under head coach Scott Abell.
- The Wildcats hold the slight edge over the Blue Hose, 14-13-2, dating back to the series inception in 1919. You read that right! The two sides tied on two occassions, the first meeting in 1919, 0-0; and again in 1963, 14-14.
- The road team has the edge in the series. Davidson is 10-7 all-time in Clinton, while Presby is 6-4-2 at Davidson.

A DAVIDSON WIN WOULD...

- Make the 'Cats 2-0 in PFL play to open the season;
- Snap a four-game losing skid to the Blue Hose;
- Be the fifth straight home opening victory.

QUICK HITS

- Davidson won it's second straight conference opener and second consecutive game over Stetson last Saturday. The 'Cats last two wins have come on the road against the Hatters, (11/16/19 and 3/13/21).
- The Wildcats were picked second in the PFL Preseason Coaches Poll behind reigning champs, San Diego, the unanimous favorite to win the league. Drake was third, while Stetson was fourth.
- Four 'Cats were named to the PFL Preseason Watch List: Tyler Phelps (QB), Eli Turner Jr. (All-Purpose Back), Jalen Staples (WR) and Dreylan Hines (S).
 - Davidson returned 10 starters from their last campaign, five on each side of the ball.
- Davidson welcomed 29 members to the Class of 2023 and a junior transfer; 13 are listed on offense, 12 on defense and 2 special teamers.

IN OTHER NEWS

LAST TIME OUT

- Davidson opened PFL play with a road win at Stetson, 26-20.
- Tyler Phelps orchestrated three straight scoring drives in the second half, completing TD passes to Eli Turner Jr. and Jalen Staples, and rushing for another. He led the team on the ground with 120 yards.
- The Davidson defense continued to impose their will, forcing a pair of Stetson turnovers. Freshman Jonathan Hammond was johnny-on-the-spot, intercepting a Hatter pass that caromed off a Stetson receiver's helmet.
- Junior linebackers Jalen Jefferson and Jake Alexander both recorded career-highs in tackles as both made 10 total stops. Alexander also forced a fumble, recovered by Cade Vela, that set up Davidson's first touchdown drive of the game in the early stages of the third quarter.

OH THE FAMILIAR PLACES

- Davidson sits atop the FCS in rushing yards per games (282.0) and second in 3rd down conversion (62.5%).
- They were the statistical champion in 3rd down conversion in 2019 and in rushing yards per game in 2018.

WHAT'S IN A NUMBER?

- A pair of number changes over the offseason have drawn some attention due to their nature.
- Wide receivers Jalen Staples (7) and Satchel Moore (11) changed their numbers to emulate the wide receiver room's mantra, "7-11, Always Open."
- Coach Abell has stated that slot receiver Eli Turner Jr. (1) and linebacker Jalen Jefferson (1), both junior captains, have taken on a lot of his personality. In the offseason the pair decided to make the bond perminent, each switching to the number one on their respective side of the ball.

GOING THE DISTANCE

Sophomore kicker Caden Bonoffski showed off his leg at Stetson, booting a career-long 48-yard field goal through the uprights. His previous best was a 43-yard kick against San Diego in 2019. The school record sits at 52, achieved by both Joe Duncan in 1975 and Chris Costello in 2003. Bonoffski's kick was the longest since 2015, a 47-yard kick at Stetson from Trevor Smith.

BREAKING FREE

Since Abell brought the triple-option to Davidson in 2018, the Wildcats have registered 62 touchdown runs of 30 yards or more. Junior Coy Williams and sophomore Dylan Sparks each broke one for over 30 yards in the opener at Elon.

WINNING BIG

Davidson's margin of victory in 2019 was 26.6 points, winning six of eight games by double digits.

IN EVERY GAME

Eight of the team's 10 losses under Coach Abell have been within one possession with tghe 'Cats having a chance to win every game. Three of the last five setbacks have come by a field goal or less.

GOING FOR IT

- The 'Cats went for it on fourth down 45 times in 2019, converting succesfully on 28 tries (62%), ranking 15th in the nation. Only Eastern Illinois attempted more fourth down tries (51).
- Davidson is 3-for-7 (43%) on foruth down attempts through the first two games.

SWITCHING SIDES

Switching sides of the ball is not uncommon, but for Davidson both tight ends listed at the top of the depth chart, Jackson Sherrard and Jake Stylski, swapped practice jersey colors in the last two years. The duo hopes to fill the void left by four-year starter Hunter Louthan '20.

HOME COOKING

The 'Cats are 9-5 under head coach Scott Abell at Richardson Stadium and have won all non-conference home games.

In just his second season at the helm, Abell led the Wildcats to its best season in nearly two decades, guiding the team to an 8-4 finish, recording the most FCS wins in program history along the way (6).

In his first season, 2018, Abell's offense ran away from the competition, but the 2019 'Cats featured a balanced attack, ranking among the top FCS programs nationally in rushing (2nd), total defense (4th), and led the nation in third down percentage.

In year two, Coach Abell's squad earned eight All-PFL selections, including three first team honorees. Among those first teamers was Davidson's all-time leading rusher, Wesley Dugger. Dugger reset the program's rushing benchmark in just his third season, another 1,000-yard season, his third in as many tries. He also set the single season touchdown record, rushing for 22 and led the nation in scoring (12.0 PPG).

Additionally, four 'Cats earned Academic All-PFL honors including Ethan Steinbacher, a National Football Foundation William V. Campbell Trophy semifinalist, making him one of the top seniors academically in all divisions of the NCAA (FBS, FCS, DII and DIII).

Another important piece of Coach Abell's culture is service and no one exemplified that more than 2020 Allstate AFCA Good Works Team honoree, George Hatalowich. Hatalowich, the fourth Wildcat to earn this honor and first under Abell, was honored at halftime of the Allstate Sugar Bowl in New Orleans. Hatalowich was instrumental in starting the Davidson chapter of Uplifting Athletes, work that will be carried on by future Wildcats for years to come.

In his first season at the helm, Abell led Davidson to its first winning record since 2007, directing the 'Cats to a 6-5 mark that concluded with a heroic goal-line stand on the final play of the season to secure the winning campaign.

Coach Abell helped lead the Wildcat offense to NCAA FCS statistical championships in total offense (561.9) and rushing offense (442.9), while directing the 'Cats to top-five statistical categories in third down conversion percentage, offensive red zone and scoring.

The 2018 Wildcats snapped a 17-game Pioneer Football League losing streak with a 40-35 road victory at Valparaiso and earned national attention for a 91-61 Thursday night shootout victory over Guilford.

Abell's squad rewrote the NCAA FCS history books with a trip west to PFL power San Diego, steering Davidson to a 789-yard rushing performance, shattering a 30-year record set by Missouri State in 1998 (681). Four Wildcats rushed for over 150 yards including Dugger's 231-yard output, the fifth-best single game rushing performance in Davidson football's 117-year history.

The Wildcats reset 10 program records including rushing yards in a season (4765), rushing touchdowns (55) and scoring (494 points).

Abell joined the Wildcats following a sixseason stint as head football coach at Division III Washington & Lee University. While leader of the Generals, Abell posted a 39-24 overall record and won the Old Dominion Athletic Conference Championship three times. His conference peers selected him ODAC Coach of the Year on three occasions and he was tabbed the Willy Lanier Virginia State Coach of the Year twice.

Abell served as the Washington & Lee offensive coordinator until 2012 when he was elevated to head coach. Under Abell, the Generals were transformed into a national rushing powerhouse, leading the NCAA Division III in rushing three of his final six seasons. His 2015 squad went undefeated in the regular season, the first to do so in program history, and set records in total yards (5,439), rushing offense (4,773) and points scored (417).

His head coaching career started uphill in 1997 at Liberty High School, near Lynchburg, Va., where he turned an 0-10 program into district champions in three years. He moved to nearby Amherst High School, which had not brought home a state championship in a dozen years, and led teams to back-to-back state titles.

Prior to landing his first head coaching gig, Abell served as an assistant at Altavista High (1996-97), West Albemarle High (1994-96) and Albemarle High (1993). His duties ranged from offensive coordinator to coaching the quarterbacks, defensive backs and linebackers.

Abell graduated with a bachelor's degree in education from Longwood College in 1992 where he played both football and baseball. A gifted baseball player, Abell was drafted by the Kansas City Royals and spent two years in the minor leagues, hitting a home run in his first at-bat.

Abell then turned his attention back to football and teaching, eventually earning his master's of administration/supervision at Lynchburg in 2007.

Abell and his wife, Crissie, have a son, Porter, who serves as the Wildcats wide receivers coach, and a daughter, Emily.
