LAST TIME OUT...

-Closing the 2019 season, Elon defeated its second nationally-ranked opponent with Skyler Davis hitting a 35-yard field goal with 41 seconds to play to help Elon defeat the Tigers 25-23 and

knock Towson out of the playoff picture.

-Greg Liggs, Jr. capped the day with his eighth interception, finishing his final regular season with the most in the nation.

WINNING BIG

-Each of Elon's three CAA Football wins last year rank Top 3 on the program's CAA margin of victory list.

- Sept. 14 at Richmond - W, 42-20 (+22)
- Oct. 12 vs. No. 15 Delaware - W, 42-7 (+35)
- Oct. 26 at Rhode Island - W, 38-13 (+25)

AGAINST THE BEST

-Elon has defeated a nationally-ranked team in each of the last four seasons with one in 2016, four in 2017, two in 2018 and two in 2019.

-Before the current run, Elon had not defeated a single ranked team since the 2011 campaign when it topped No. 17 Furman 41-34 on the road.

-Elon has also defeated a ranked team at home three years in a row in beating two in 2017, one in 2018 and one in 2019.

-Before the current streak, Elon last beat a ranked team at Rhodes Stadium on Oct. 4, 2008, when it took down No. 15 Furman 31-10.

-Overall going back to the start of the 2017 season, Elon is 8-8 against nationally-ranked FCS teams. Breaking the mark down, Elon is 4-4 at home and 4-4 on the road.

TAKE THE BALL WALL

-New in 2019, Elon implemented the "Get The Ball Wall." Designed to inspire the defensive unit, anyone that forces a turnover takes a picture with the ball on the sidelines to have their picture go up in

MEDIA INTERVIEWS

Depending upon schedules and other time considerations, interviews will be scheduled after practice sessions. During game weeks, in-person interviews will be conducted following Tuesday's practice. Player phone numbers will not be released to media members.

-Elon football practices are NOT open to the media during the spring 2021 season. Any interviews with Coach Trisciani or any student-athletes will be made via Zoom. GAME CREDENTIALS

You will receive an email confirmation of your request and a further email approving or denying your request. Elon Athletics has sole discretion on the approval of credential requests.

There is very limited space inside the Press Box due to social distancing guidelines. Credentials will be approved and issued on a game-by-game basis. There is no guarantee of a credential. Credentials may be picked up on gameday at the Ticket Gates starting two hours before kick. No passes will be mailed this year.

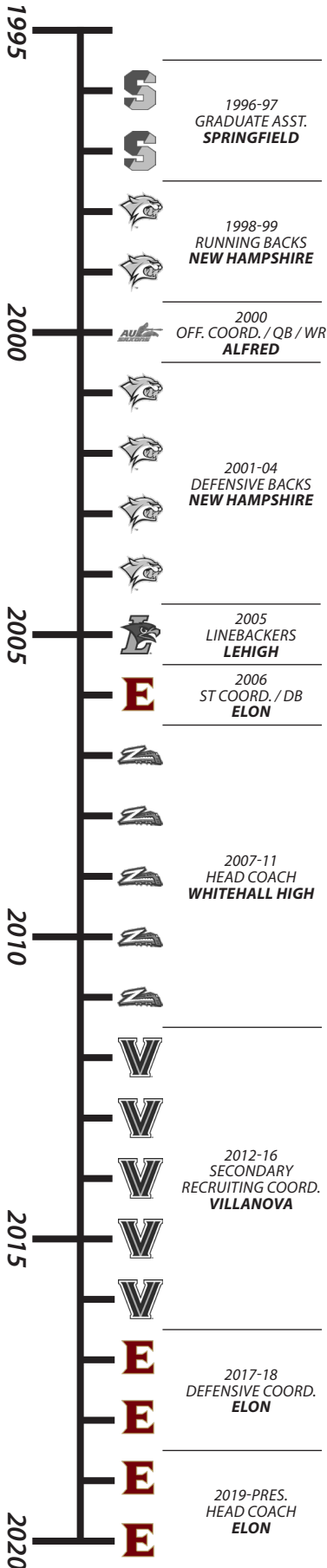

-Elon forced 21 turnovers in 2019, finishing with a plus-nine turnover margin. Seventeen of those 21 turnovers came in the last six games of the year.

TAKEAWAYS GALORE!

-With at least three takeaways in each of Elon's three October games and another to close the season against Towson, it has forced three or more turnovers in a game eight times since the start of the 2018 campaign.

-Elon has recorded 11 three-plus turnover game since Trisciani arrived on campus as the defensive coordinator ahead of the 2017 campaign.

DIALING LONG DISTANCE

-Elon put together 42 offensive scoring drives in 2019. Twenty-two of the 42 drives have gone at least 69 yards with 18 of the 42 going for 75 yards or more.

-Against The Citadel, Elon drove 94 yards for its longest drive of the year. It also pushed a drive 93 yards at Richmond to open CAA Football action.

-To start November against William & Mary, marching down the field was a trend with all five scoring drives in regulation going at least nine plays. Of those five drives, four went for 12 plays or more with two taking more than six minutes of game time off the clock.

ROAD WARRIORS

-In 16 of Elon's last 17 road games, Elon has trailed at some point in the second half. In those games, Elon has won nine of them.

-Opening 2019 CAA Football action at Richmond on Sept. 14 marked the first time since Sept. 24, 2016, at No. 8 William & Mary Elon did not trail in the second half.

-Last year, Elon trailed at Rhode Island 13-10 in the third before rattling off 28-straight points to win 38-13.

-At No. 19 Towson, Elon trailed 23-19 in the fourth quarter before coming back to win 25-23.

A LIKING TO VIRGINIA

-Elon has won four of its last five games played in the Commonwealth dating back to Sept. 24, 2016, at No. 8 William & Mary.

-During that stretch, Elon has won three games against Top 10 teams in the state of Virginia in beating No. 8 William & Mary 27-10 in 2016, No. 6 Richmond 36-33 in 2017 and No. 2 James Madison 27-24 in 2018.

EARLY CAA FOOTBALL SUCCESS

-Elon has won five consecutive CAA Football openers and is 5-1 in CAA openers in six years in the conference entering 2020.

-Before its Sept. 28, 2019 loss to JMU, Elon was 6-0 in CAA Football games played in the month of September. With the loss, it's now 6-1.

-In contrast, Elon is 6-13 in October conference games since joining the league. But its fortune has turned since the start of the 2017 season, posting a 6-2 record in October CAA Football games since the start of that campaign.

BRINGING THE BOOT

-Skyler Davis connected on a 50-yard field goal against James Madison last season to mark the longest field goal made by a Phoenix kicker since Adam Shreiner hit from 50 at Samford during the 2011 season.

-Against William & Mary in overtime on Nov. 2, Davis hit what would have been a program-record 53-yard field goal, but the Tribe had called timeout to negate the kick. Minutes later, he hit the right upright with the game continuing five OTs.

CONQUERING THE CAA

-By beating Delaware on Oct. 12, 2019 Elon has defeated every CAA Football opponent at least once since joining the league ahead of 2014.

MORE HEADLINES**NOTES FROM 2019****WILLIAM & MARY - Nov. 2**

-Elon and William & Mary went five overtimes, marking one of two games in the nation at any level that's been to five overtime sessions.

-The other five-overtime game also pitted the state North Carolina vs. the state of Virginia with UNC going to Virginia Tech and falling 43-41.

RHODE ISLAND - Oct. 26

-Each of Elon's longest two runs of the last two seasons came against Rhode Island. In 2019, Joey Baughman rushed 67 yards for a touchdown. It followed Jaylan Thomas's 86-yard touchdown run in 2018 at Rhodes Stadium.

DELAWARE - Oct. 12

-Elon's 42 points against No. 15 Delaware matched the Richmond game on Sept. 14 for the most points in a CAA Football game for the Phoenix.

-The 35-point victory is the largest margin of victory in a CAA Football game for the Phoenix to date. It also matched Elon's largest conference win margin at the Division I level going back to when Elon beat Chattanooga by 35 in 2009.

-Davis Cheek connected on 22-of-25 passes, setting a new Division I program record for best completion percentage (88 percent) in a game. The junior went 13-for-13 in Elon's 35-point second half.

RICHMOND - Sept. 14

-Sept. 14 was the first time since Sept. 24, 2016, at No. 8 William & Mary that Elon didn't trail in the second half of a road game. In that stretch, Elon came from behind in six of 12 games to win.

-Davis Cheek's five touchdown passes in a game marked the first time that's happened for an Elon quarterback since Nov. 20, 2010, when Scott Riddle (inducted into the Elon Sports Hall of Fame on Sept. 7, 2019) did so against Western Carolina.

THE CITADEL - Sept. 7

-Defensively, Elon held The Citadel to 156 rushing yards. It marked Elon's fewest rush yards allowed to an option-based team in seven games since the start of the 2017 season. It was also The Citadel's lowest rushing output since Nov. 2017 at Clemson.

-One week later, The Citadel ran for 320 yards in a road win at Georgia Tech.

LEGEND OF THE PHOENIX

-Throughout history there is told the legend of the rare and remarkable Phoenix, a crimson and gold bird that lived 500 years. It was sleek, swift and strong – the most marvelous bird ever created by human imagination. At the end of its life, with death approaching, it built a nest in an oak tree and was consumed in flames ignited by the sun. From the ashes emerged the next Phoenix – reborn and renewed, with strength forged in fire.

-Fire, too, has shaped the history of Elon University. The disastrous fire of 1923 all but destroyed Elon. Gone were college records, classrooms, the library and the chapel. Within days of the fire, trustees set in motion the plan for Elon to rise from the ashes, stronger than ever.

-The Phoenix is a powerful leader and an emblem of immortality. It is a perfect symbol for a school that is constantly renewing and recreating itself.
