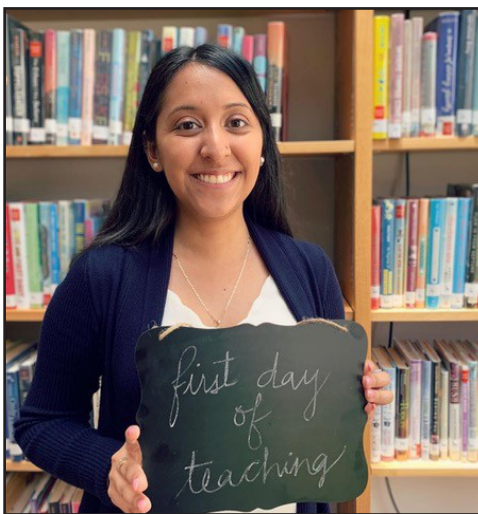


SUMMER INTERNSHIP GRANTS

Davidson College awards grants to select students participating in unpaid or low-paying summer internships (those with an income equivalent to less than \$3,000).

2019 Grant Statistics:

- 98 students received grants
 - * (90%+ applicants approved)
- \$275,000+ total dollars allotted
- No limits on industry/location
- Grants range from \$1,000-\$5,000
 - * Awards based on budgets submitted by students



DAVIDSON RESEARCH INITIATIVE

The Davidson Research Initiative (DRI) offers a wide range of opportunities for collaborative research and in-depth study between students and faculty during the summer. From the health effects of e-cigarettes to modeling economic growth in developing countries, students contribute to the creation of knowledge through the Davidson Research Initiative.

Summer Research Options:

- Eligible for returning students
- Flexible 10-week options:
 - * 10 weeks on-campus,
 - * 10 week remote with faculty, or
 - * 10 week split remote/on-campus
- \$480/week stipend
- Housing/travel provided

The Sustainability Scholars program places each student with a private, public, or nonprofit community institution to focus on a discrete project during the summer, and meets as a group to discuss how individuals and institutions can move the needle at the community-scale on environmental issues, with a particular emphasis on climate change.
