SERIES NOTES

All-Time Series: GW leads, 4-1 • Series Streak: Won 1

- This is the sixth meeting between both school's women's basketball programs.
- Davidson won its first game in the series last year on the road, 62-42, during GW's Education Day.
- Justine Lyon led eight scorers with 20 points and the Wildcats shot 48.1 percent from the floor.

QUICK HITS ...

- Davidson is in its 41st season and has collected 461 wins in program history.
- The 'Cats are in their sixth year in the Atlantic 10 after a 21-year run in the SoCon.
- Sarah Donovan (1st) and Katie Turner (2nd) were named to the league's all-preseason teams.
- Davidson was picked fifth in the A-10 preseason poll after a tie for fourth place last year.

LAST TIME OUT AT GEORGE MASON, JAN. 15 ...

- Adelaide Fuller and Ally Welling combined for 29 points and Davidson weathered a sluggish fourth quarter to win its season-best fourth straight game with a 76-69 victory Wednesday.
- Fuller finished with a team-high 18 points, the third game in a row with that point total, and five rebounds, while Welling dropped in 11 to go with four rebounds with a block.
- Katie Turner (11 points, five assists) and Cassidy Gould (10) also scored in double figures.
- Davidson was up by 17 (68-51) a minute into the fourth quarter, but went scoreless until the 1:31 mark as Mason got within six (68-63). The 'Cats defense then stepped up and forced a pair of turnovers, while they swished home five free throws in the final 38 seconds to seal up the win.
- The 'Cats had a season-high 26 points off of 16 Patriot turnovers.

ALL-TIME RECORD WATCH LIST ...

- Katie Turner continues to climb up in the Wildcats' all-time records, with Turner closing in on 1,000 career points (911) while sitting in fifth in threes (169) and 10th in assists (310). Sarah Donovan crossed the 500-rebound mark (531) and is 13 away from reaching 15th all-time.
- Ally Welling is 10th in career blocks with 80 and is four away from moving up a spot.

A-10 RANKINGS ...

- The 'Cats rank in the top five in- scoring (2nd), shooting percentage (2nd / .425), made field goals (1st/448), assists (4th/14.06). Suzi-Rose Deegan is 2nd in made field goals (105), 5th in scoring and 6th in rebounding (7.6), Fuller is 4th in field goal percentage (.521) and Turner has 36 threes (4th).

RANDOM NOTES ...

- Davidson is 4-0 in A-10 play for the second straight season after finishing a program-best 10-6 last year.
- The Wildcats sit at 5-1 on the season at home and are riding a two-game winning streak.
- Davidson finished non-conference play 7-6, its most wins since collecting nine during the 2006-07 season.
- Three 'Cats are scoring in double figures- Suzi-Rose Deegan (16.0 ppg/7.6 rpg), Sarah Donovan (11.4/8.6) and Katie Turner (10.5/3.8 apg), while the team overall is averaging 70.2 points per game.
- When Davidson scores 70 or more points, it is 9-0 on the season, with a season-best 101 points vs. WCU.
- Davidson has put at least three players in doubles digits in 10 of the 17 games this year.
- The 'Cats have shot better than 41 percent in 10 of the 16 games, with a season-best 53.7 percent vs. WCU.
- Deegan had a nine-game double-digit scoring streak halted at Mason Wednesday (12 of 14 overall).
- During the nine-game stretch, she averaged 19.0 ppg/9.0 rpg and shot 48 percent from the field.
- Deegan had three 20-point games, a 30-point game vs. Charlotte and three double-doubles during the stretch.
- The Wildcats set a single-game school record for three-pointers (14) vs. Western Carolina, Nov. 20.
- Deegan (4) and Adelaide Fuller have a combined five A-10 Rookie of the Week awards this year.
- Deegan twice has gone for 30 points (31 vs. Kansas City and 30 vs. Charlotte), four 20-point outings and three double-doubles on the year.
- Fuller is averaging 18 points and shooting 65.7 percent in the last three games.
- Davidson has won at least 11 games now for the third straight season.

In the Last Meeting ... (Full Game Story)

WASHINGTON, D.C. — Davidson saw eight players score on the day, paced by Justine Lyon's 20 points, and it rolled to its sixth Atlantic 10 victory in a 62-42 road win at George Washington on the Colonials' Education Day game Wednesday inside Charles E. Smith Center.

The Wildcats (12-8, 6-1 A-10) scored their first win in the series vs. the Colonials, while pushing their road win streaks to five in A-10 play and four all together. The 'Cats are off to their best start since joining the A-10 and their best league start since a 6-1 mark in their final season in the SoCon (2013-14).

Lyon hit 7-of-12 field goals, including three shots from downtown, and swished home all three free throws. Her three-point play at the end of the third quarter made it 48-33 and pretty much put the game out of reach.

Katie Turner filled the box score with 13 points, five assists and four dimes, while Sarah Donovan just missed a double-double on 10 points and nine rebounds. Kyla Roland came off the bench for six rebounds, three points and a block.

GW (8-13, 5-3 A-10) had one lone double-digit scorer, led by Maddie Loder with 14 points. The Colonials were held to 18-of-52 shooting on the day.

Davidson shot just under 50 percent at .481 (25-52) and went 8-for-23 from behind the arc. It also had a 28-18 advantage on points in the paint and dished out 16 assists.

Trailing 8-6 early in the second quarter, the Wildcats went on an 11-0 run to close the quarter for a 17-8 lead and never looked back.

The second quarter saw the 'Cats lead reach double-digits, 27-16, on a triple from Cassidy Gould at the 3:41 mark and shortly after a Lyon layup made it 29-16. The Wildcats took a 29-20 lead into the locker room.

George Washington got within 34-28 in the third quarter, but the Wildcats would close the quarter on a 14-5 run capped off Lyon's and-one play to take control. They shot 7-of-13 overall in the quarter, including nailing four of their five three-point attempts.

Lyon ended her scoring day with a three-ball at the 3:49 mark in the fourth quarter for the Wildcats' largest lead at 60-38.

GAME NOTES: This was the fifth meeting all-time between both team's women's basketball programs, as the series started when the 'Cats joined the A-10 in 2014-15 ... the Wildcats are 1-4 all-time vs. GW ... Lyon has 14 career 20-point games ... Davidson is 12-1 when leading with five minutes left ... in 17 of the 20 games this year the Wildcats have had at least three double-digit scorers ... the win today was the program's 445th ... Davidson's five-game A-10 road win streak dating back to end of last season is a program-best during its time in the league.

On May 10, 2017, Davidson College Athletic Director Jim Murphy announced the hiring of Gayle Coats Fulks as the head coach for the Wildcat women's basketball program. She is the 12th head coach in the program's 38-year history.

Quick Highlights...

- In second year, went 17-15 for the most wins since 2012-13 and had best finish to date in the Atlantic 10 with a 10-6 mark for fourth place.
- Guided Davidson to its first postseason appearance since 2012-13 with an invite to the WBI, hosting Marshall, in 2018-19. It also won the program's first A-10 Tournament game with a first-round victory against St. Bonaventure.
- During second season, helped the Wildcats set three program A-10 records with a six-game overall win streak, a five-game road win streak and a three-game home win streak.
- Also set a program single-season record for made and attempted threes by going 216-for-713 to break the previous record of 180-of-542 set in 2007-08.
- Sarah Donovan and Justine Lyon earned the Most Improved Player and Sixth Woman of the Year awards in 2018-19.
- Doubled Davidson's win total from previous season in first year as a head coach, going 12-18 in 2017-18.
- Earned first career coaching victory with a 70-57 triumph at Western Carolina, Nov. 10.
- Was recognized as one of WBCA's Thirty Under 30 honorees after fourth season at Wake Forest in 2015-16. The award is given annually to up-and-coming coaches 30 years old and younger, to recognize their involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others' professional manner and attitude as well as association involvement.
- During tenure at Wake Forest, the

Demon Deacons earned back-to-back postseason bids to the Women's NIT in 2016 and 2017, reaching the second round both seasons.

- Graduated from Fairleigh Dickinson in 2007, where she was a four-year letterwinner for the Knights.

Coach History...

Davidson (17-15) made great strides during Fulks' second year, finishing tied for fourth in the A-10 standings after being picked to finish 11th in the preseason poll. The Wildcats went a program-best 10-6 in league play and won the program's first game in the A-10 Championship with a first-round victory against St. Bonaventure.

The Wildcats' 17 wins were the most since the 2012-13 season, with 10 of those wins coming at home. They led the A-10 in scoring (66.0 per game), turnover margin (+2.8) and offensive rebounds (13.9 per game). The 'Cats invite into the WBI was its fourth postseason appearance in program history.

Other stellar team highlights included setting a program single-season record for made and attempted threes by going 216-for-713 to break the previous record of 180-of-542 set in 2007-08, had four players average in double figures in points for the first time since 2001-02 and won the program's 450th win the first-round victory vs. St. Bonaventure.

Under Fulks' guidance, Sarah Donovan (second team), Justine Lyon (third team) and Katie Turner (third team) each earned a spot on the A-10 All-Conference teams,

while Donovan was tabbed the Most Improved Player of the Year and Lyon was named the league's Sixth Woman of the Year.

It was a solid first year for Fulks as a head coach at Davidson during the 2017-18 season. The Wildcats doubled their win total from the previous season by going 12-18 overall and a program-best 7-9 in Atlantic 10 play. Fulks earned her first career coaching victory with a 70-57 triumph at Western Carolina, Nov. 10. She became the third Wildcat head coach in the program's 39-year history to start a career with a win. It was also Davidson's 10th straight win in the series vs. the Catamounts.

Along the way, other highlights included a home opening win vs. UNC Asheville, a thrilling win at High Point by overcoming a 19-point third-quarter deficit and a victory against cross-county rival Charlotte that snapped an eight-game losing streak in the series. Davidson set a new road winning streak mark in A-10 games, running off a three-game streak with wins at Richmond, St. Bonaventure and Rhode Island.

During Fulks first season, she saw senior Mackenzie Latt go over 1,500 career points and end her career third all-time in scoring to go with a second place finish in rebounds and made field goals. Latt was named to the A-10 All-Third Team, while Katie Turner earned a spot on the league's all-rookie team. Turner also set the single season record for made three-pointers with 75. Justine Lyon became the 20th Wildcat to reach 1,000 career points during Coats Fulks first season as well.

Fulks came to Davidson from Wake Forest University, where she spent the five years as an assistant coach under Jen Hoover. The

mic squad. She graduated in 2007 with a Bachelor of Science degree in business management.

last two years (2015-16 & 2016-17) Wake Forest earned at-large bids to the Women's NIT, reaching the second round both seasons during Coats Fulks tenure.

During the 2016-17 season, the Demon Deacons went 17-16 overall and earned a win over Bethune-Cookman in the first round of the WNIT before falling to Middle Tennessee State to end their season. Guard Alex Sharp became the second student-athlete under Fulks to be named to the Atlantic Coast Conference All-Freshman Team, joining fellow teammate Ariel Stephenson who garnered the award a year ago from the Blue Ribbon Panel and the league's coaches.

In addition to helping the Demon Deacons to consecutive NIT appearances the last two seasons, Fulks was recognized during the 2015-16 campaign as one of the Women's Basketball Coaches Association's (WBCA) Thirty Under 30 honorees. The award is given annually to up-and-coming coaches 30 years old and younger, to recognize their involvement in community service, mentorship and impact on others' professional manner and attitude as well as association involvement.

While on the bench for head coach Hoover for five seasons, Fulks assisted in all aspects of the program, from academics to recruiting, where she served as an integral part to the Demon Deacons putting together ranked recruiting classes each year on staff.

In her first season with the Deacs, she helped guide one of the top-scoring backcourts in the Atlantic Coast Conference. Point guard Chelsea Douglas led the team in scoring at 14.6 points per game, while Lakevia Boykin was right behind her at 14.4 points. The two combined to make 134 three-pointers on the season, with Douglas' 72 ranking as the third-most for a single-season in school history.

Fulks joined the Wake Forest staff after one season as an assistant coach at UNC Greensboro in 2011-12.

Fulks broke into the coaching ranks at Longwood University, where she was on staff from 2007-11. In her first season with the Lancers, they went 16-13, notching the program's best win total in its Division I era at the time.

Prior to her first collegiate job, Fulks served as the Assistant Video Coordinator during the 2007 season for the WNBA's New York Liberty, where she assisted with scouting reports and film exchange.

A four-year letterwinner at Fairleigh Dickinson, Fulks was a co-captain and member of the Northeast Conference All-Acade-

WIN STREAK REACHES SEASON-BEST FOUR IN A ROW

Davidson pushed its season-best winning streak to four in a row after scoring a 76-69 road win at George Mason, Jan. 15. It topped the previous high of three this season, which the 'Cats did twice.

All four wins have come against Atlantic 10 opponents, two at home and two on the road. In three of the four wins, the 'Cats have had at least four double-digit scorers. They are averaging 73.5 points per game during the streak and holding opponents to 64 points, while shooting 43.9 percent. Suzi-Rose Deegan is averaging a double-double (16.8 ppg/10.5 rpg) in the four wins, while four others are also averaging in double figures. Adelaide Fuller (14 ppg) is shooting a team-best 63.2 percent from the field.

DAVIDSON OPENS LEAGUE PLAY 4-0 FOR SECOND STRAIGHT SEASON

For the second straight season Davidson began Atlantic 10 play by winning its first four games after scoring a 76-69 win at George Mason, Jan. 15. Led by Adelaide Fuller's 18 points, the Wildcats put four scorers in double figures.

During its time in the Southern Conference, the 'Cats started 4-0 in league play four times.

DOUBLE DIGITS IN THE BOOKS

For the 10th time this year, Davidson put at least three double-digit scorers in the scorer's book with four players hitting the mark at George Mason, Jan. 15.

Adelaide Fuller came off the bench to score 18 points for the third game in a row. Ally Welling and Katie Turner finished with 11 points apiece, while Cassidy Gould rounded it out with 10 points.

The other games the 'Cats have accomplished the feat were against Georgetown (4 scorers), Drexel, UC Irvine, Western Carolina, ETSU, High Point, Newberry (5 scorers), Fordham (4 scorers) and Rhode Island (5 scorers). In the Western Carolina game, the 'Cats had six scorers in double figures.

DOUBLE FIGURE STREAK HALTED AT NINE STRAIGHT FOR DEEGAN

Freshman Suzi-Rose Deegan saw her season-best nine-game double-figure scoring streak come to an end at George Mason, Jan. 15, when she scored nine points. In one stretch, Deegan hit the double-figure mark in 12 of 13 games.

During her nine-game stretch, Deegan poured in 19.2 points and 8.9 rebounds per game, shooting 47.9 percent from the floor including 32.5 percent from behind the arc. She had 19 assists and pocketed 12 steals (1.3 per game). The freshman had four games of 20 points, a 30-point outing against Charlotte and three double-doubles during the stretch.

FULLER BRINGS HOME FIFTH A-10 WEEKLY AWARD FOR 'CATS

Adelaide Fuller joined Suzi-Rose Deegan as the latest Wildcat to earn A-10 Rookie of the Week after picking up the weekly honor, Jan. 12.

The freshman from Brisbane, Australia, en-

joyed a stellar two games last week in wins at home against Fordham and Rhode Island by averaging 18.0 points and 4.5 rebounds a game, while shooting a blistering 68.2 percent from the floor (15-of-22) and swishing home 4-of-5 free throws. She had a pair of 18-point games off the bench in the wins, which was one point off her career high.

2-0 A-10 START, 'CATS DOWN FORDHAM ON EDUCATION DAY

Davidson opened Atlantic 10 play 2-0 for the second straight season when it claimed a 74-62 home win vs. Fordham, Jan. 8, in front of nearly 1,500 local elementary students as part of the Education Day game.

Suzi-Rose Deegan had her third straight double-double (12 points/13 rebounds) and four Wildcats in all scored in double figures. Adelaide Fuller scored 18 points off the bench in just 18 minutes of action, while Chloe Welch netted a career-high 17 points and Katie Turner added 11.

Davidson used a 12-3 run, sparked by Fuller's seven points, in the first quarter to turn a 6-4 deficit into a 16-9 lead. It went on to lead by as many as 13 in the second quarter and later 16 points in the fourth quarter.

Deegan went for 14 points and a season-best 13 rebounds, hauling in six on offense and seven on defense, both season highs. In addition, the freshman pocketed a season-high four steals, setting a new team season best, while dishing out three assists.

DEEGAN CLAIMS 2ND A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK AWARD

Freshman Suzi-Rose Deegan collected her second weekly award this season, Dec. 23, when she was named the A-10 Rookie of the Week for games played from Dec. 16-22.

Deegan shined in the Wildcats' lone game of the week against Charlotte last Saturday. The freshman scored 30 points, her second 30-point game of the season, vs. the 49ers. The shooting guard hit 12-of-21 (.571) shots with one 3-pointer and five free throws. Deegan scored 18 of those points in the first half. In addition, Deegan added nine rebounds, while pocketing three steals.

Deegan becomes the third player since Davidson joined the A-10 in 2014-15 to win the rookie of the week twice, joining Mackenzie Latt '18 and Katie Turner.

DAVIDSON FALLS TO 49ERS IN ANNUAL CROSS-COUNTY BATTLE, 3-GAME HOME WIN STREAK SNAPPED

Suzi-Rose Deegan had her second 30-point game of the season, but Charlotte used a pair of second-half runs to pull away as Davidson fell to its cross-county rival 75-64 on its home-court, Dec. 21. The setback snapped the Wildcats' a season-best three-game home win streak.

The Wildcats led at halftime 35-33, but the 49ers ran off a 12-4 run to open the third quarter to take back the lead and then went up by 13 (64-51) on a 13-2 run to begin the fourth quarter. The 'Cats were never able to recover. Davidson did get within three points (47-44, 49-46 and 51-48) in the third quarter three times, but Charlotte answered each time.

This was the 30th meeting all-time between both team's women's basketball programs. Charlotte now holds a 19-11 record in the series, having won 10 of the last 11 meetings dating back to 2007.

She registered her second double-double in a row to help the Wildcats open league play with a 65-58 road win. Deegan poured in a game-high 25 points and set a new season high with 14 rebounds, nine of which came on defense (season best). She added three assists and two steals in the win. Deegan scored 16 points in the second half, 11 of which came in the third quarter when Davidson took the lead for good.

DEEGAN, WILDCATS OPEN A-10 PLAY WITH WIN AT SAINT LOUIS

Suzi-Rose Deegan registered her second straight double-double (25 points/14 rebounds) and Davidson overcame a sluggish first quarter to secure a 65-58 win on the road at Saint Louis, Jan. 4.

Falling behind 10-0 to open the game and 19-7 after the first quarter, Davidson rattled off a 40-16 spurt that started in the second quarter and finished up at the end of the third. It turned a 21-9 deficit into a 49-37 advantage. Saint Louis got within three, 61-58, with 28 seconds in the fourth quarter, but the 'Cats sealed the win by hitting four free throws in the closing seconds.

A-10 OPENERS

Davidson improved to 2-4 in Atlantic 10 openers after scoring a 65-58 road win vs. Saint Louis, Jan. 4. Suzi-Rose Deegan led the way with 25 points and 14 rebounds.

Overall, the Wildcats are 14-13 in league openers, with a 12-9 mark during their time in the Southern Conference. They have now gone 5-7 when opening league play on the road.

SUCCESSFUL NON-CONFERENCE CAMPAIGN

Davidson closed out its non-conference play with a 7-6 record, the most wins since the 2006-07 season won nine games. The Wildcats faced

four first-time opponents during non-conference play (Georgetown, UC Irvine, Kansas City and Florida) and won three of the meetings. Some other highlights included: a 2-1 record in the Preseason WNIT, 101 points scored in a win vs. Western Carolina as well as a new single-game school record 14 three-pointers in the win and running off a pair of three-game winning streaks. Individually, freshman Suzi-Rose Deegan had a stellar start to the season with two 30-point outings and picking up the A-10 Rookie of the Week honor three times.

'CATS CAP NON-CONFERENCE WITH FOURTH FIRST-TIME OPPONENT, THE FLORIDA GATORS

Davidson closed out its non-conference play with its fourth time facing a first-time foe, taking on Florida, Dec. 29. It held the Gators to 34.5 percent shooting, but a last minute push in the fourth quarter fell short in a 55-50 setback. Three times the Wildcats had a chance to take the lead or tie the game, but missed out on each opportunity.

Sarah Konstans had a career-high 17 points on 6-of-7 shooting, including 5-for-5 from behind the arc. Suzi-Rose Deegan had her first career double-double on 14 points and a season-best 13 rebounds.

Davidson was facing its first SEC opponent since traveling to Tennessee to face the Lady Vols during the 2012-13 season.

ANOTHER A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK AWARD FOR DEEGAN

For the second week in a row and third time overall, freshman Suzi-Rose Deegan took home the Atlantic 10 Rookie of the Week for games played from Dec. 23-29.

Deegan is the first Wildcat to take home three rookie of the week honors in a season since Davidson joined the league in 2014-15.

3-GAME WIN STREAK SNAPPED AT COLUMBIA

Despite another 20-point outing from freshman Suzi-Rose Deegan (21) and a double-double from junior Sarah Donovan (13 points/11 rebounds), Davidson came up short at Columbia, 63-60, Monday, Dec. 9.

The Wildcats had their season-high three-game winning streak halted after their seven-point second-half lead (44-37) was erased in the fourth quarter and they were unable to overcome a poor shooting second half (11-of-31, 2-for-14 on threes and 2-of-6 at the charity stripe).

Columbia broke up a 53-all tie at the 6:05 mark on a layup and added another bucket a few minutes later to make it 57-53. Davidson got within two, 59-57, on a pair of Chloe Welch free throws with 59 ticks left. Then after four straight points by the Lion, Deegan hit a three-ball with four seconds remaining to make it 63-60.

After a Columbia timeout, the Wildcats scooped up a loose ball and got off a last-second shot to try and force overtime, but the shot just past midcourt hit the side of the rim and fell short to end the game.

DAVIDSON WINS THIRD STRAIGHT AT HOME, SCORES 75-46 WIN VS. NEWBERRY

Five players scored in double figures led by Suzi-Rose Deegan's 17 points (eight rebounds) and Davidson won its third straight game at home with a 75-46 home win vs. Newberry College, Dec. 5.

Davidson took control by using a pair of 12-4 runs in the first and second quarters, respectively, to erase a 7-6 deficit to start the game and doubled up Newberry 30-15 with 3:55 left before halftime. The Wildcats went into the break up 34-18 and lead by as many as 29 points (73-44) in the final two quarters.

Joining her in double-digits was Ally Welling with 12 points, 10 in the first half, to go with seven rebounds, and Chloe Welch, Cameron Tabor and Adelaide Fuller were tied with 10 points each. Cassidy Gould dished out five assists for the third time this year.

DAVIDSON CAPS 4-GAME ROAD TRIP WITH SIXTH STRAIGHT WIN VS. HIGH POINT

Davidson closed out a busy four-game road swing in a nine-day span with a 73-63 victory at High Point, Dec. 2. It was the Wildcats sixth straight win in the series, improving to 9-5.

Leading the charge on the night was the post duo of freshman Adelaide Fuller, who scored a season-high 19 points on 9-of-14 shooting, and junior Sarah Donovan, who registered her third double-double of the season with 12 points and a new career-high 20 rebounds. Freshman Suzi-Rose Deegan also helped out, scoring a game-high tying 20 points with 12 of those coming in the second half.

Davidson opened the game up with a 19-2 run between the first and start of the second quarters to go up 32-21. It pushed the lead to as many as 25 points (58-33) in the third quarter before HPU closed to within 11 in the fourth. The trio of Fuller, Donovan and Deegan scored the final 11 points for the 'Cats to seal up the

win.

CRASHING THE GLASS TO A NEW CAREER HIGH

Junior Sarah Donovan was on a rebounding mission, Dec. 2, at High Point. The starting forward crashed the glass for a new career-high 20 rebounds, 11 of which came on the offensive side which was a personal-best as well. The last time a Wildcat hauled in that many was Jan. 15, 2012 at Appalachian State when Sophia Aleksandravicius had an even 20 rebounds.

SUCCESSFUL FIRST MONTH

Davidson got off to a great start to the 2019-20 season with a successful November by going 5-3. The five wins is the most to start the month of November since the 2006-07 season when the Wildcats went 5-2.

Some highlights in the first month for the 'Cats: going 2-1 in the Preseason WNIT with first-time wins against UC Irvine and Kansas City, scoring 101 points vs. Western Carolina which was the most since dropping in a school-record 103 against East Tennessee State, Jan. 22, 2002, setting a new school record vs. WCU with 14 three-pointers while also winning their 11th straight in the series vs. the Catamounts, recording their sixth straight win in the series vs. High Point and picking up a first-time win against Georgetown to start the season.

Individually, Suzi-Rose Deegan won the A-10 Rookie of the Week, Sarah Donovan tallied three double-doubles, including a 12-point, career-high 20 rebounds effort at High Point and Katie Turner swished home a career-high tying six three-pointers in a win at ETSU. Cassidy Gould dished out a career-best 10 assists at Drexel, which the most by a Wildcat since 2016-2017.

TURNER DRILLS 6 TREYS, WILDCATS BACK IN WIN COLUMN

Junior Katie Turner tied a career-high with six three-pointers and Davidson forced East Tennessee State into 32.1 percent shooting to snap a two-game losing streak with a dominating 75-60 road win to close out November.

Turner finished with 18 points on 6-of-8 shooting, all from long range, and sparked a 21-11 first quarter lead with two of those threes. Her fifth three-pointer to open the third quarter started a 14-5 run that opened the game up and got the Wildcats (5-3) back in the win column.

Sarah Donovan had 20 points on 9-of-13 shooting and Suzi-Rose Deegan scored 13 points. Chloe Welch filled the box score with eight points, seven rebounds and two assists, while Adelaide Fuller had six points and six rebounds.

11 STRAIGHT VS. CATAMOUNTS, DAVIDSON REACHES CENTURY MARK

Six different players scored in double figures and Davidson as a team set a new single-game record for three-pointers on its way to hitting the century mark in a 101-51 victory vs. Western Carolina, Nov. 20.

The Wildcats, who won their 11th consecutive game in the series, drilled a new school record 14 threes on 25 attempts to break the old mark of 13. The 101 points were the most scored since dropping in a school-record 103

Davidson hit several season highs that will be hard to top during its impressive 101-51 home win, Nov. 20, vs. Western Carolina. In addition to the 101 points, the Wildcats shot a season-best 53.7 percent from the floor and hit 36-for-67 field goals. They also set team highs in bench points (70) and points in the paint (38), while their 31 and 28 points in the first and fourth quarters, respectively, were season bests, as was the 23 assists and five blocks.

SIX IN DOUBLE-DIGITS

For just the second time since the 2008-09 season, Davidson put six scorers in double figures during its 101-51 win at home vs. Western Carolina, Nov. 20. Suzi-Rose Deegan led all scorers with 16 points, followed by Konstans and Cameron Tabor with 14 points each. Tabor also dished out a season-high six dimes and swished home all four of her three-point tries. Sarah Donovan, in just 12 minutes, had 12 points, while Chloe Welch and Abdul-Aziz chipped in with 10 points apiece.

Last year, the Wildcats accomplished the feat against Presbyterian in an 83-56 triumph at home, Dec. 18, 2018. Prior to that, the last time a Wildcat team accomplished the feat was vs. Chattanooga at home, Feb. 14, 2009.

SWISHING HOME A SCHOOL-RECORD FROM LONG-RANGE

Part of Davidson's impressive 101-51 win vs. Western Carolina, Nov. 20, was their stellar three-point shooting and it was on full display to the tune of a school-record 14 three-balls on just 25 attempts. Saeeda Abdul-Aziz tied the record late in the fourth quarter and then Sarah Konstans broke it, as well as helped the 'Cats hit the century mark, with a triple from the wing and just 51 ticks left.

It was the first game this year Davidson has reached the double-digit mark in three pointers. It accomplished the feat five times last year, hitting 11 in a game four of those times.

A-10 ROOKIE OF THE WEEK

After helping lead Davidson to a 2-0 weekend in Kansas City, Mo., freshman Suzi-Rose Deegan was honored by the Atlantic 10 by being named the Rookie of the Week for games played from Nov. 11-17.

The shooting guard was named the MVP for the weekend vs. UC Irvine and Kansas City and earned a spot on the all-tournament team with Katie Turner after she averaged 19.5 points and 6.0 rebounds per game, while shooting 55 percent from the field (16-of-29) including 5-of-10 from behind the arc.

The freshman from Australia had a breakout game vs. the KC Roos, scoring a season-high 31 points on 13-of-19 shooting and 4-for-8 from three-land. Deegan came up big in the fourth quarter with 13 points, including eight straight points on a pair of three-pointers and a layup to help the Wildcats pull away.

Davidson finished up its run in the Preseason WNIT with a pair of first-time wins against UC Irvine and Kansas City, Nov. 15-16, in its final two consolation games. The Wildcats battled down to the wire against UCI, taking a 78-72 behind Katie Turner's 20 points. Then Saturday, the 'Cats captured a 74-64 win against the Roos led by Suzi-Rose Deegan's team season-best 31 points. The freshman scored 13 points in the fourth quarter, including eight straight in the final two minutes to turn a 60-59 lead into a 68-59 advantage with 40 seconds to go.

DOUBLE-DIGIT ASSIST MARK HIT BY GOULD

Sophomore Cassidy Gould was an assist machine in Davidson's first round Preseason WNIT game at Drexel, Nov. 9. The shooting guard dished out a career-best 10 dimes, which were the most since Chloe Johnson had that many vs. Rhode Island, Feb. 11, 2017. Prior to that, the last time a 'Cat reached double-digits in assists came back on Dec. 29, 2010 by Barbara Sittou (11 vs. Princeton).

DAVIDSON FALLS IN FIRST ROUND OF PRESEASON WNIT

Junior Katie Turner scored a career-high 25 points and Davidson shot 47.7 percent from the field, but it was unable to overcome a big run by Drexel in falling 74-63 in the first round of the Preseason Women's Basketball Invitational Tournament Saturday, Nov. 9.

Drexel used a 21-7 run that spanned the final few minutes of the first quarter and went halfway through the second quarter to turn a 13-12 deficit into a double-digit lead at 33-20. The Wildcats had to play catchup the rest of the way.

Turner paced the 'Cats by hitting 6-of-8 shots, including 5-for-7 on threes, and a perfect 8-of-8 at the charity stripe. Sarah Donovan reached double figures with 14 points, while Chloe Welch dropped in 11 points. Cassidy Gould had a career-high 10 assists.

4TH PRESEASON WNIT INVITE

This will be the Wildcats' fourth appearance in the preseason tournament, with their most recent invite coming during the 2012-13 season in which they played at North Carolina (L, 59-70), and then against Northern Illinois (L, 61-64) and Kennesaw State (W, 64-54).

The other two seasons were in 1999-00 and 2004-05 when the Wildcats fell in the first round at SW Missouri St. and at Duke.

figures, led by Sarah Donovan's double-double, and it held Georgetown to 30.8 percent shooting in securing a season and home-opening win, 66-52, Nov. 5 inside John M. Belk Arena.

The Wildcats (1-0) opened up a 22-10 lead after the first quarter and never looked back in earning their third consecutive season opening win, all under head coach Gayle Fulks.

Donovan hauled in a career-high 16 rebounds (11 on defense) and dropped in 12 points. The Australian trio of Suzi-Rose Deegan, Adelaide Fuller and Cassidy Gould all hit for double digits. In her collegiate debut, Deegan came off the bench to pace the 'Cats with 16 points and pulled in eight rebounds to go with two assists and two steals.

Fuller also enjoyed a strong debut game, scoring 10 points and adding three rebounds along with her first career block. The sophomore Gould rounded out the trio with 10 points and tied Katie Turner (9 points, 6 rebounds, 5 assists) with five dimes.

HOME OPENERS

In the program's 40-year history, the Wildcats are now 20-19 overall in home openers (two of the year's results are incomplete) after scoring a 66-52 win vs. Georgetown, Nov. 5. Davidson improved to 10-4 the last 14 years in home openers.

SEASON OPENERS

During the Wildcats' 41-year history, they have gone 13-28 in season-openers after opening the 2019-20 campaign at home vs. Georgetown, Nov. 5. The Wildcats rolled to an 66-52 win behind Sarah Donovan's double-double (12 pts, 16 rebs).

Since the program was restarted in 1992-93, they have gone 11-17 and played some pretty tough competition. The 'Cats have faced the likes of top programs in North Carolina (three

times), Duke, Vanderbilt, Nebraska, Michigan State (twice), Boston College, Arkansas-Little Rock and Clemson (twice).

During that time period ('92-93), Davidson has opened on the road or at a neutral site 23 times with a 8-15 record in those games.

A-10 PRESEASON HONORS

The Atlantic 10 Conference released its annual women's basketball preseason rankings as well as all-conference and defensive teams, Oct. 29 & 31. For the fourth year in a row, the Wildcats placed at least one player on the preseason team, as the junior duo of Sarah Donovan and Katie Turner garnered honored. Donovan, the reigning A-10 Most Improved Player and all-second teamer, was named to the league's preseason first team, while Turner earned a spot on the preseason all-second team after she earned a spot on the third team as a sophomore last year. Davidson was picked fifth in the preseason poll after finishing in a tie for fourth place last year.

MOST WIN SINCE '12-13

Davidson finished 17-15 last year, which was the most wins since the 2012-13 season and 10 of those wins came at home.

4TH POSTSEASON TRIP

After a successful regular season and run in the A-10 Tournament, the Wildcats earned an invite into the Women's Basketball Invitational for the first time. They faced off against Marshall in the first round in a home game, but the 'Cats fell in a down to the wire finish, 67-64.

It was Davidson's fourth all-time postseason appearance, with the other three appearances coming in the Women's National Invitational (WNIT). The 2012-13 season was Davidson's last postseason appearance.

SETTING A NEW MARK FROM 3-POINT RANGE

Davidson set a new single-season mark during the 2018-19 season for made and attempted threes. It set the mark by going 6-of-16 from behind the arc vs. Saint Louis, Feb. 23. The six threes gave the Wildcats 185 for the season, five more than the previous record set during the 2007-08 campaign.

The attempts mark of 601 broke the 542 set also during the 2007-08 season. The 'Cats went on to hit 216-for-713 for the season.
